Ahmed Hossain dead

Advocate Syed Ahmed Hossain, secretary general of the United Nations Association of Bangladesh (UNAB) and former Treasurer of the National University died of prolonged illness at the Holy Family Hospital in the city yesterday morning, family sources said. He was 64, reports BSS.

A life-long bachelor, Hossain left behind his brother, Defence Secretary Syed Yusuf Hossain, one sister and a host of relatives, friends to mourn his death.

His *namaz-e-janaza* will be held at Baitul Mukarram National Mosque today after Juma prayers and he will be buried at Shahid Intellectuals' Graveyard at Mirpur.

PM condoles

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday expressed deep shock at the death of secretary general of United Nations Association of Bangladesh (UNAB) Syed Ahmed Hossain, reports BSS.

In a condolence message the Prime Minister recalled the contribution of Hossain during all democratic movements in the country.

She also recalled the contribution of Hossain towards the development of National University during his tenure as treasurer of the university from September 1996 to September 1998.

The Prime Minister said the country lost a dedicated social worker in his death.

The programme was followed by a cultural show.

250-seat new hostel for SSMC opens

Health and Family Welfare Minister Salahuddin Yusuf said the government has taken up schemes to modernise medical college hospitals and district sadar hospitals to improve the healthcare facilities in the country, reports UNB.

The minister was inaugurating the newly built 250-seat hostel for the students of Sir Salimullah Medical College (SSMC) in the city yesterday.

The Alauddin Hostel has been built at the old town in the capital at a cost of Tk 1.70 crore.

Mentioning various steps taken up by the present government, he said 2,000 nurses were recruited in the last fiscal year and process of recruiting another 2,000 nurses would be completed by this month.

The inaugurations function was addressed, among others, by Principal of SMC Prof Mizanur Rahman, Secretary of Health and Environment Affairs of Awami League, Secretary General of BMA Dr Mostafa Jalal Mohiuddin and General Secretary of students' union of SMC Salim Shahi.

FM leaves for Brunei, Vietnam today

Foreign Minister Abdus Samad Azad leaves the city this morning on a six-day official visit to Brunei, Darussalam and Vietnam, reports APB.

On the first leg of his trip Azad will go to Brunei where he will stay from May 8-10. The Foreign Minister will hold official talks with his Brunei counterpart.

The talks will cover the entire gamut of bilateral relations as well as regional and international issues of common concern.

Possibility of further expanding Bangladeshi manpower export to the oil-rich ASEAN country is likely to figure prominently in the discussion.

They are also expected to discuss possibility of Brunei's investment in Bangladesh.

On May 10 Azad will fly to Vietnam where he will have official talks with the Deputy Prime Minister of that country.
