

Ginola's double distinction

LONDON, May 6: Tottenham Hotspur's French winger David Ginola on Thursday completed an awards double by being voted the English football writers' player-of-the-year, reports AFP.

Last month the former Newcastle star was voted player-of-the-year by his fellow professionals in the English Premier League.

Ginola beat Manchester United pair Dwight Yorke and David Beckham into second and third place respectively.

"I am absolutely thrilled," said the Frenchman, who has been consistently overlooked by the French national selectors.

The 32-year-old's dazzling wing play has been a major factor in Tottenham's revival under George Graham this season which culminated in victory over Leicester City in the League Cup final.

That earned an automatic place in the UEFA Cup next season and Ginola also steered the White Hart Lane club into the FA Cup semi-finals.

This is the fifth year running that the award - voted for by the press - has gone to a foreign player.

Ginola follows compatriot Eric Cantona (1995), German Juergen Klinsmann (1996), Italian Gianfranco Zola (1997) and Dutchman Dennis Bergkamp last year.

He also follows in the footsteps of Arsenal rival Bergkamp by winning both the Professional Footballers' Association (PFA) and Football Writers' Association (FWA) trophies in the same season.

Ginola will be presented with his prize at the FWA's annual dinner, which is due to be held on May 20 at London's Royal Lancaster Hotel.

Ince break's United's heart

LONDON, May 6: Liverpool captain Paul Ince struck a major blow to his former club by scoring a late equaliser Wednesday against Manchester United and providing Arsenal with an unexpected bonus in the process, reports AP.

United's treble title chase slumped as they gained just one point from the 2-2 tie, while defending titlists Arsenal grabbed maximum points with a 3-1 win over Tottenham to extend their lead in the league standings to three points.

Manchester United led 2-0 after an hour but Liverpool hit back with a penalty to Jamie Redknapp.

United were reduced to 10 men in the final 15 minutes after Dennis Irwin was sent off and Ince added the fairy-tale finish with his sliding goal two minutes from full time.

It was a reverse of fortunes for the England defender, who played for United in 1992 when Liverpool stopped them from winning the championship on the last day of the season at Anfield.

"I didn't think we could come back from 2-0 down," Ince said after the game.

"United is a world-class team and you don't expect to get two goals back... brilliant."

The Gunners now lead the standings with 75 points, followed by United with 72 and Chelsea on 71.

Arsenal, Chelsea and Leeds all have two games to play but Manchester United have three games remaining.

At Stamford Bridge, Chelsea retained third place and confirmed their place in the European top flight next season with a 1-0 win over Leeds in a No. 3 vs. No. 4 clash.

The Blues' Uruguayan international Gustavo Poyet scored the clincher with an unstoppable header in the 68th minute.

Until then, Leeds' keeper Nigel Martyn had kept his team in the game with a series of brilliant saves, including two against ace striker Tor Andre Flo.

At Anfield, Manchester United took a 2-0 lead after 56 minutes with a goal by Dwight Yorke and a Dennis Irwin penalty before Liverpool hit

back.

Yorke scored his 28th goal of the season in the 22nd minute when he headed a David Beckham cross past Reds' keeper Brad Friedel.

Irwin, who missed a penalty against Aston Villa on Saturday, had no trouble converting a spot kick in the 56th minute but turned villain 20 minutes later when he was red carded.

In the North London grudge match, the Gunners grabbed a 2-0 lead after the first half-hour and seemed to be coasting before Spurs closed the gap on halftime through a Darren Anderton penalty.

French pair Emmanuel Petit and Nicolas Anelka scored in the 17th and 33rd minutes before Anderton sent a curling penalty around a defensive wall and past England' keeper David Seaman in the 43rd minute.

After a tense second half, Nwankwo Kanu added another spectacular solo goal in the 85th minute to give Arsenal an unbeatable lead.

In Wednesday's other Premier League match, Derby defeated Leicester 2-1 with Mikkel Bech scoring the winner in the 60th minute.

The "Toto" Schillaci Testimonial Day on May 31 will feature the likes of Roberto Baggio, Franco Baresi, Giuseppe Bergomi and Walter Zenga, with former national coach Azzeglio Vicini in charge.

Facing them will be a team chosen by Udo Lattek, one of the most successful club coaches in Bundesliga history, and including Jurgen Klinsmann, Lothar Matthaus, Rudi Voller, Jurgen Kohler and Andreas Brehme.

Though sad that a career which took the 34-year-old across Italy and on to the Japanese J-League has been ended by injury, the Sicilian said: "That feeling is offset by all the success I've had."

"Now I want to play my last official match in my city with the lads from the national team, who shared those wonderful moments of Italia '90 with me."

Parma coach a relieved man

FLORENCE, Italy, May 6 (AFP): Parma's Alberto Malesani burst into floods of tears here after his team beat Fiorentina in the Italian Cup final and salvaged his job as team coach.

Malesani's future had been in doubt after their league title bid came to nothing. And he dashed onto the field at the final whistle, leaping into the air, hugging players and hauling the trophy before the away fans.

"We've done it lads, we've done it," he blubbed. "We knew it would be a battle of nerves and that we'd have to be patient and wait for our chance. And we did that well."

Overcome by the emotion of his first triumph as a football coach, the 34-year-old thanked the players, the fans and even Parma's opponents, who he coached last season in his first year in the top-flight.

"If I've won this Italian Cup, some of the merit is also Fiorentina's," he said. "They were the team who launched my career in the world of football."

Italian Cup Parma's

FLORENCE, Italy, May 6: Parma lifted the Italian Cup on the away goals rule here on Wednesday night after snatching a 2-2 draw with Fiorentina in a pulsating final, reports AFP.

Victory was sealed after Parma had drawn 1-1 in the home leg and showed their fighting spirit to come back from a 2-1 deficit here.

Parma, who are on course for a trophy double this season in next Wednesday's UEFA Cup final against Olympique Marseille, took a 43rd minute lead through Argentinian Hernan Crespo.

But Czech defender Tomas Repka snatched one back two minutes after the break and Sandro Cois made it 2-1 to the hosts in the 61st minute, as Fiorentina looked destined for success.

But Paolo Vanoli shattered those hopes in the 70th minute when he rose to head in

the decisive equaliser and seal Parma's second Italian Cup title since 1992.

Both sides fought hard, and there were no shortage of rough tackles, but Parma had the edge from start to finish while Gabriel Batistuta's Fiorentina could only rue the missed chances.

Parma's Juan Sebastian Veron fired an early warning shot but a better chance fell to Batistuta in the 12th minute, when he collected Moreno Torricelli's through-ball but failed to beat Gianluigi Buffon from a dozen metres.

Enrico Chiesa sent a stinging shot over the bar for Parma but Fiorentina's German defender Jorg Heinrich replied by rifling a low shot just wide of the left hand post.

Crespo made his mark just before the break, meeting Diego Fuser's low ball across the box with an elegant backheel past the flailing hands of Francesco Toldo and into the far corner.

It was the Argentinian's

third backheel goal this season and brought his total all competitions to 27.

However, the match swung completely Fiorentina's way within 20 minutes of the restart.

Batistuta sent a probing ball forward to Edmundo and the Brazilian, with his back to goal, knocked it back for Repka to steer a reflex shot into the top right hand corner.

Soon after, Portuguese playmaker Manuel Rui Costa curled over a free-kick which Cois rose to head past Buffon.

But a similar goal minutes later, when Chiesa sent over a swirling cross from the right and Vanoli nodded it powerfully into the right-hand corner, put Parma firmly back in charge.

Fiorentina piled forward in search of a late winner but the best efforts of Batistuta and a missed chance for Belgian international Luis Oliveira sealed their fate before the distraught home fans.

L'kusen delay Bayern's party

BERLIN, May 6: Brazilian international Emerson's 85th minute goal lifted Bayer Leverkusen to a Bayern Munich triumph, keeping their 15th Bundesliga title until the weekend, reports AP.

But the 2-2 outcome against FC Nuremberg left Leverkusen all but mathematically eliminated. They are exactly 12 points back with four rounds to play and trail the Bavarians by 16 in goal differential.

The jockeying for international play also continued with third-place Hertha Berlin emerging big gainer after a 2-0 victory against VfL Wolfsburg, who began in fourth.

With 55,000 watching at Olympiastadium, Michael Preetz fired a league-best 18th goal, then headed in a 19th to lead Berlin. The side has lost just once in 1999.

Borussia Dortmund again failed to secure a European

berth for next season by struggling to a 1-1 draw against Schalke in the Ruhr Valley Derby. Seventh-place MSV Duisburg, one place below UEFA Cup range, kept heat on the teams above by sweeping past Bochum 2-0.

Munich, eager to turn their attention to winning the Champions Cup and German Cup for a historic treble, closed in on the title with a 2-0 victory Moenchengladbach Tuesday.

"Congratulations on the title — it's well-deserved," said Leverkusen coach Christoph Daum, even before the match.

Carsten Ramelow, Leverkusen's young national team player, put his team up in the second minute, but Sascha Ciric in the 24th and Jochem Weigel in the 74th staked Nuremberg to a 2-1 lead.

Emerson's equaliser spoiled both Munich's chance to open the champagne early and match the feat of its legendary predecessors — the Franz Beckenbauer-led Munich team of 1972-73 remains the only side to

clinch the title after 30 rounds. As often, Leverkusen's of Brazilian and young German internationals dominated the match without emerging with three points.

"Hats off to Munich's championship — but Leverkusen plays more attractive soccer," said Nuremberg coach Friedel Rausch.

Lyon on course for Champs' League berth

PARIS, May 6: Lyon closed in on a place in next season's European Champions' League with a 2-1 victory against Bastia on Wednesday, reports AP.

With just two matches to play, Lyon are in third place and now four points clear of Rennes, who saw their five-game winning streak end with a 2-1 defeat at Nantes.

Lyon suffered an early setback when Pierre Laurent scored for Bastia.
