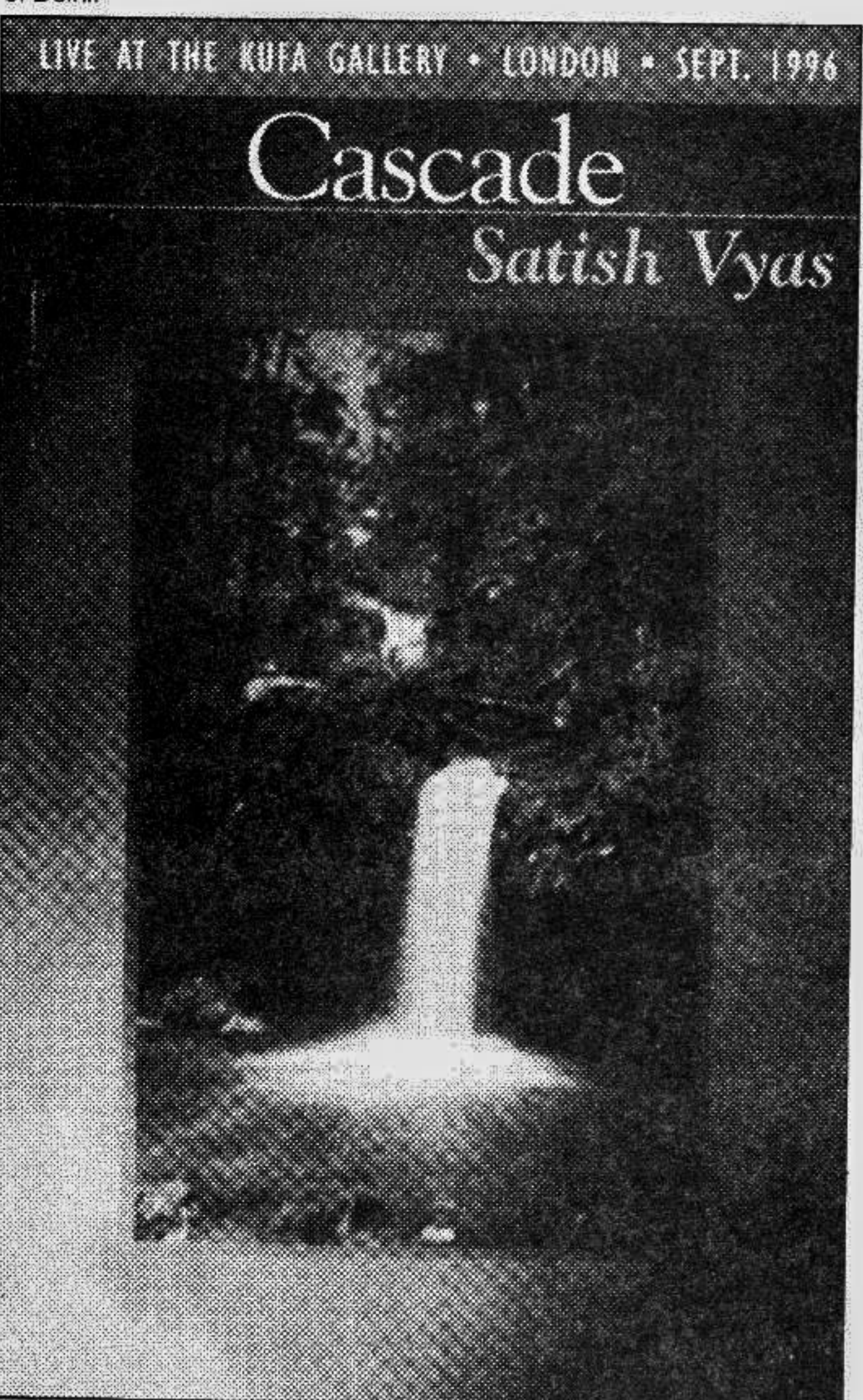

Ajoy Chakrabarty, one of the outstanding khyal singers of his generation, is a representative of the Patiala gharana, one of North India's most famous traditions of classical singing. This musical lineage was established in the second half of the nineteenth century in the former princely state of Patiala, now part of the Indian state of Punjab. It was founded by two eminent musicians, namely 'Jamail' (General) Ali Baksh and 'Kamail' (Colonel) Fateh Ali Khan, disciples of Tanras Khan of Delhi.

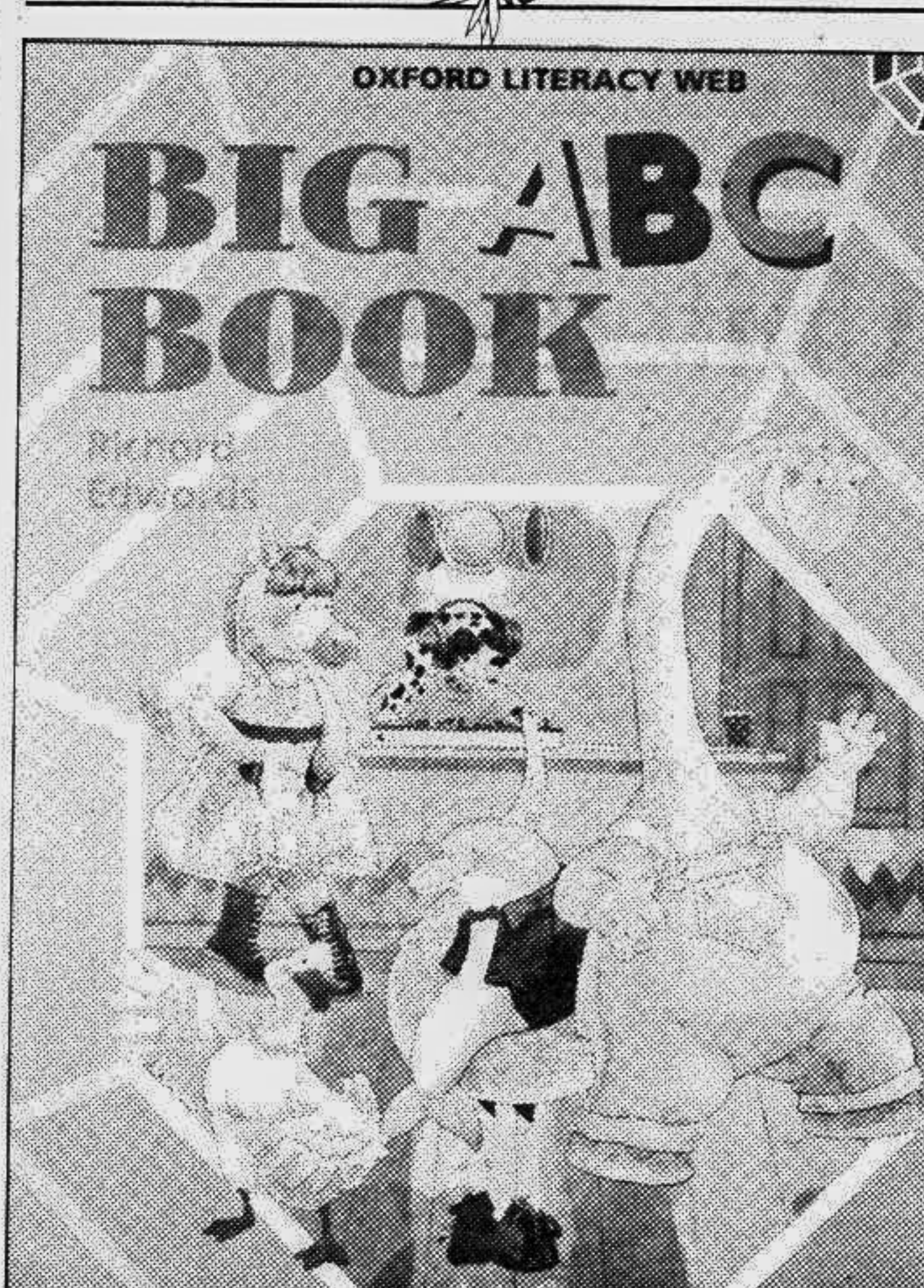

In instrumental Indian classical music, the *bansuri* (bamboo flute), *shehnai* (oboe) and *santoor* share a common feature. All these instruments originate in the folk music tradition of the land intertwined with devotional music. Ustad Bismillah Khan is associated with the development and acceptance of the shehnai as a classical instrument and likewise (late) Pandit Pannalal Ghosh and Pandit Hariprasad Chaurasia for flute, and Pandit Shivkumar Sharma for the santoor.
