

HC discharges BNP lawmaker's writ petition

The High Court yesterday discharged a writ petition filed by Matibubur Rahman, a BNP Lawmaker, challenging the maintainability of the election tribunal case pending against him, reports BSS.

The division bench of the High Court comprising Justice Kazi Ebadul Huq and Justice Mohammad Mozammel Hossain discharged the rule and vacated the order of stay on the proceedings of the concerned election tribunal.

The Judges observed that the election case against the petitioner pending before the Election Tribunal was maintainable and the tribunal was competent to try the same.

Mahmudul Rahman Belayet, a defeated candidate of Awami League in Noakhali-3 constituency, had filed the case before the Election Tribunal claiming that Advocate Mabbubur Rahman could not be even eligible for MP candidate as he was a bank defaulter and so his election should be declared illegal.

Rukhsana Safa enthralls UK audience

Expatriate Bangladeshi singer Dr Rukhsana Safa, an ophthalmologist from Chittagong, enthralled the audience by her virtuoso performance in several languages of the sub-continent at a cultural evening in UK Saturday, reports UNB.


