Bangladesh supports WHO projects

Bangladesh yesterday expressed its full support to the World Health Organisation's (WHO) Cabinet projects on "Roll Back Malaria" and "Tobacco Free Initiative", reports BSS.

"We appreciate the gravity of malaria situation in Africa and WHO's response thereto. At the same time, we draw the attention of WHO to the deteriorating Malaria situation in South East Asia," Health and Family Welfare Minister Salah Uddin Yusuf said at the 52nd session of the World Health Assembly in Geneva.

He said political, socio-economic and demographic transition and epidemiological changes now taking place in the region were posing unprecedented challenges to health, according to a message received here tonight from Geneva.

The health minister said the region's population continues to grow rapidly and it now harbours half of the poor population of the world. "They are disadvantaged in many ways and have limited capacities to cope with health related risks and vulnerabilities," he added.

He said many of the communicable diseases like malaria and tuberculosis were now re-emerging and new scourge like HIV/AIDS and STDs were coming as major threat to public health.

Yusuf said the government of Bangladesh has been pursuing a policy of health development that ensured provision of basic services to the entire population of the country, particularly in the rural areas.

BCL countrywide demonstration May 20

Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL), student wing of the ruling party, yesterday announced that they will bring out processions and hold rallies across the country on May 20, in protest of killing of a BCL leader and terrorist activities of Islami Chhatra Shibir.

The announcement was made in a rally in front of DUCSU building on the Dhaka University campus at noon, organised to protest the killing of Sohel in Mymensingh.

Sohel, general secretary of BCL Ishwarganj thana unit, was killed on Monday and many others were injured when activists of Shibir allegedly opened fire on them.

Addressing the rally, the BCL leaders condemned the attack and blamed Shibir activists for the incident. They also demanded immediate arrest and exemplary punishment to those involved.

"Otherwise, we will launch a movement to drive out the religious fanatics from the country," Ajay Kar Khokan, BCL general secretary said.

Among others, Shahjahan Alam, Sajju, Balorom Podder, Ashraf Alam Ruben, Abdul Matin and Beg Shahin Jahan addressed the rally.

Fly-overs at Jatrabari, Mohakhali likely

The first meeting of the Greater Dhaka Transport Planning and Coordination Board (GDTPCB) yesterday discussed the proposal to construct fly-overs at Jatrabari and Mohakhali to ease the traffic congestion in the city, reports BSS.

Mayor Mohammad Hamif presided over the meeting held at Nagar Bhaban. Construction of three bus and truck terminals near Dhaka city was also discussed in the meeting.

Besides, ban on rickshaws without licenses, earmarking some roads as one-way, improvement of signal lamps, parking charge of buses, trucks and rickshaws, storing construction materials alongside different roads without permission and fixing time for movement of goods trucks also came up for discussion in the meeting.

Director General of the Department of Environment, Chairman of RAJUK, Divisional Commissioner of Dhaka, Chairman of BRTA, Chief Executive Officer of Dhaka City Corporation, Additional Director General of Bangladesh Railway, Chairman of Tongi Pourasabha and the concerned officials from the ministries of Communications and LGED and, IWTB, Dhaka Chamber of Commerce and Industry and DC Traffic (North) joined the meeting.

Evicted N'ganj businessman yet to be rehabilitated

Despite orders from the Home Minister, the evicted businessman of Narayanganj, Bashudev Banik, is yet to be rehabilitated in his 130-year-old ancestral business.

Since March 16, Bashudev has been in hiding fearing reprisal from the same quarter that demolished his shop and looted his godown in the Kalirabbar area of the town in broad daylight.

Although Narayanganj police first refused to help the businessman, they eventually accepted a case on March 28. Bashudev filed the case accusing nine persons including a Juba League leader of the town, Golam Sarwar, of extortion, illegal eviction, theft and looting. The rest are Robin, Fazlu, Helal, Pronob Chakrabarty, Tapan Chakrabarty, Pappu Chakrabarty and Tipu Chakrabarty.

While Narayanganj police said that they were still investigating the matter, the accused are moving freely. One police official, requesting anonymity, said some of these accused are notorious criminals and are backed by ruling partymen.

There are instructions on us not to go ahead with any arrest in the Banik case," said the police officer. He suggested that the Banik should first go through proper channel to seek justice.

It is also alleged that despite precise information that the accused were hiding the looted goods, worth about Tk 15 lakh, nothing has been done.

Following the eviction, a grateful Pronob hung two large signboards in front of the premises giving credit to Golam Sarwar for helping the recovery process.

After reports published in the press, the Home Minister ordered concerned authorities to take measures to rehabilitate the businessman in his shop and let the course of law prevail.

But till date nothing has been done.

The Speaker stressed building trained manpower

Free access to information a constitutional right : Sayeed

State Minister for Information professor Abu Sayeed said yesterday that free access to information was a constitutional right of the citizens of the country, reports BSS.

"Traditional outlook must be changed to face the challenges of the new millennium by ensuring citizens' free access to information," he told the installation ceremony of the welfare association of employees of the Press Information Department.

The minister said the government has taken initiative to set up a media centre that would work round the clock in the PID office.

He said Bangladesh Sangbad Sangstha (BSS) has been modernised, and it would launch photo service.

The association president photographer Iqbal Chowdhury presided over the function, which was also addressed by Principal Information Officer (PIO) Haroonur Rashid, association vice presidents Ruhul Ann and Abdul Awal and general secretary Rafiqullah Chowdhury.

Professor Sayeed said, "In a democratic society there would be differences of ideals and opinions, but consensus should prevail on issues like removal of illiteracy and unemployment, increase in production, erasing of terrorism and checking the culture of distortion.

Speaker stresses building trained manpower

Speaker Humayun Rashid Chowdhury yesterday stressed building trained manpower in all sectors to face the challenges of the new millennium, reports UNB.

"There is no alternative to training," he said while addressing the concluding session of a training course on "Introducing Parliamentary System and Office Management."

The 45-day course was arranged for 48 newly appointed class three employees of the parliament secretariat.

The Speaker said trained manpower is essential to maintain competence and dynamism in the parliamentary activities as "Parliament is the focal point of all activities of the country". To this end in view, the Institute of Parliamentary Studies (IPS) has been established, he said.

He asked the parliament secretariat to furnish all logistic support for providing training to the officers and employees.

Earlier, the Speaker distributed certificates among the trainees. Whip Vice-principal Mohammad Abdus Shahid and Whip Prof Khaleeda Khanam were also spoke on the occasion.

More bodies slate move to build NAM confce centre at Osmani Uddyan

More organisations yesterday criticised selection of Osmani Uddyan for construction of the international conference centre for NAM summit despite the availability of alternate space, reports UNB.

BCAS, BELA, CAMPE, CEN, FDA, FEJB and National Committee of IUCN, Bangladesh, in a joint statement, said such construction is bound to add to the scarcity of open space in the city and the alarming state of air pollution of the surrounding vicinity.
