\$9m project to protect ecosystem

Bangladesh is launching a nine million US dollars Coastal and Wetland Bio-diversity Management Project to set up an innovative system for preserving four ecologically critical areas (ECAs) — Hakaluki Haor (in Moulvibazar), Teknaf Peninsula Beach, St Martin's Island and Sonadia Island.

Environment and Forest Secretary Syed Marghubur Murshed yesterday told BSS that this unique project, to be funded by the Global Environment Facility (GEF), would have a significant positive impact on the long-term viability of the country's important bio-diversity resources.

The bio-diversity conservation is very critical. Syed Murshed said, adding that Bangladesh has already declared six ECAs, including Tangar Haor (in Sylhet) and Majat Haor, to be under threat.

In recent years, Bangladesh has demonstrated increased determination and commitment to address the challenges to ensure sustainable use and conservation of its natural resources, including its bio-diversity, he said.

The Department of Environment has initiated the crucial step of selecting first six

ECAs, all within the country's highly significant coastal, marine and freshwater wetland ecosystems.

Syed Murshed said Bangladesh is also considering to set up a Marine Park and Bay Park across the coast to protect her fragile ecosystems.

Echoing the Environment Secretary's contention, GEF-UNDP Consultant Christopher E. Cosslett said the project would support DOE efforts to operationalise the ECA concept at two main sites — one site includes three ECAs within the country's long and bio-diversity-rich coastal zone, and the second at one of the largest and most important of the country's many inland freshwater wetlands.

Dr Cosslett said that through a combination of GEF incremental cost-financing, baseline and co-financing, conservation and sustainable use of these sites would be demonstrated.

This demonstration, he said, would create important opportunities for replication in coastal, freshwater wetland and other ecosystems throughout the country, including other sites recently declared as ECAs.

"We expect Bangladesh to benefit from the project. We expect the world would benefit

from the project," Dr Cosslett added.

A donors' consultative meeting on the project was held at the Ministry of Environment and Forest with the Environment Secretary in the chair where all gave a go-ahead signal to the project.

Representatives of various development partner organisations led by UNDP, World Bank, Asian Development Bank, FAO and national bodies led by DOE, IUCN and FEJIB, endorsed the project proposals citing some of the threats facing sustainable use and bio-diversity conservation at the project sites.

They said excessive cutting of mangrove at Sonadia Island, sand dune vegetation for fuel in all ECAs, illegal harvesting of threatened turtles and turtle eggs in all ECAs, removal of corals for sale as curios at St Martin's Island, destructive fishing methods and hunting of shore-birds, are some of the major threats.

BUET symposium

A two-day 2nd Petroleum Engineering Symposium titled Gas Fields of Bangladesh: Reserves and Potential Growth through Technology Advances begins at Hotel Sonargaon at 9 am today, reports UNB.

The Department of Petroleum and Mineral Resources Engineering of Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUET) organises the symposium.

Energy and Mineral Resources Secretary Dr Towfiq-e-Elahi Chowdhury and Petrobangla Chairman Mosharraf Hossain are expected to present at the inaugural session as chief guest and special guest respectively, said a press release.

Vice Chancellor of BUET and Chairman of the symposium organizing committee Prof. Nooruddin Ahmed will preside the session.

Workshop on CHT crisis concludes

A two-day workshop on 'Chittagong Hill Tracts Crisis' ended yesterday with a call from participants to ensure the constitutional rights of the ethnic minorities by amending the Constitution.

The workshop was arranged by the Research and Development Collective (RDC) at CIR-DAP auditorium. Among others CPB President Manzurul Ahsan Khan, Workers Party leader Haider Akbar Khan Rono, Mostafa Faruq of BSD, Rabindranath Soren addressed the concluding session.

Dr Ahmed Kamal of Dhaka University, a Vice Chairman of RDC trustee board chaired the session. Dr Swapan Adnan summed up the discussions in which Rupayan Dewan, Gautam Chakma, Professor Maniruz-zaman Mia also took part.

The participants said that the CHT agreement is a definite progress towards peace and development in the hills. But there should have been more transparency in talks preceding the treaty and development strategies should be taken up considering the real needs and culture and tradition of the ethnic people in the hills.

They also called for ensuring land rights of the tribal people and resettlement of the ethnics living at cluster villages.

Bus fare on Joydevpur-BB route reduced

Bangladesh Road Transport Corporation (BRTC) has reduced its bus fare at Joydevpur-Bangladesh Bank route, a BRTC press release said yesterday, reports BSS.

According to the revised rate the present fare from Shibbari and Chowrasta (Joydevpur) to Bangladesh Bank will be Tk 18 instead of Tk 20 and from Boardbazar (Joydevpur) to Bangladesh Bank will be Tk 15 instead of Tk 20. From Tongi station road and Cherag Ali, Mohakhali and Nabisco stoppage to Bangladesh Bank fare has been re-fixed at Tk 14, Tk 8 and Tk 7 respectively instead of Tk 15, Tk 9 and Tk 8.

Govt to procure addl 50,000 tonnes of wheat

The government has decided to procure an additional 50,000 tons of wheat in the current fiscal, an official handout said yesterday, reports BSS.

It is in addition to already decided government's target of procurement of two lakh tons of wheat. Besides, the government has decided to procure four lakh tons of boro rice during the current season.

It was revealed at a meeting held at Agriculture Ministry Conference room with Food and Agriculture Minister Begum Motia Chowdhury in the chair.

Finance Minister Shah AMS Kibria, State Minister For Disaster Management Talukder Abdul Khaleque and Deputy Minister for Food Dhirendra Debnath Shambhu attended the meeting.

It was informed at the meeting that a total of 1,97,000 metric tons of wheat and 1,19,000 metric tons of rice have already been procured for the current season. The stock and price situation of food-grain, is satisfactory in all places of the country.

Ensuring fair prices for the peasants also came up for discussion in the meeting.

Concerned secretaries and officials were present in the meeting.

Cairo+5 Media Seminar begins today

A three-day Cairo+5 Media Seminar of South Asia Region begins here today to follow up the five years activities of Cairo International Conference on Population and Development, reports UNB.

Twenty-five media people from seven countries will take part in the seminar jointly organised by International Planned Parenthood Federation (IPPF) and Family Planning Association of Bangladesh (FPAB).

The participating countries are Bangladesh, India, Pakistan, Nepal, Sri Lanka, the Maldives and Iran.
