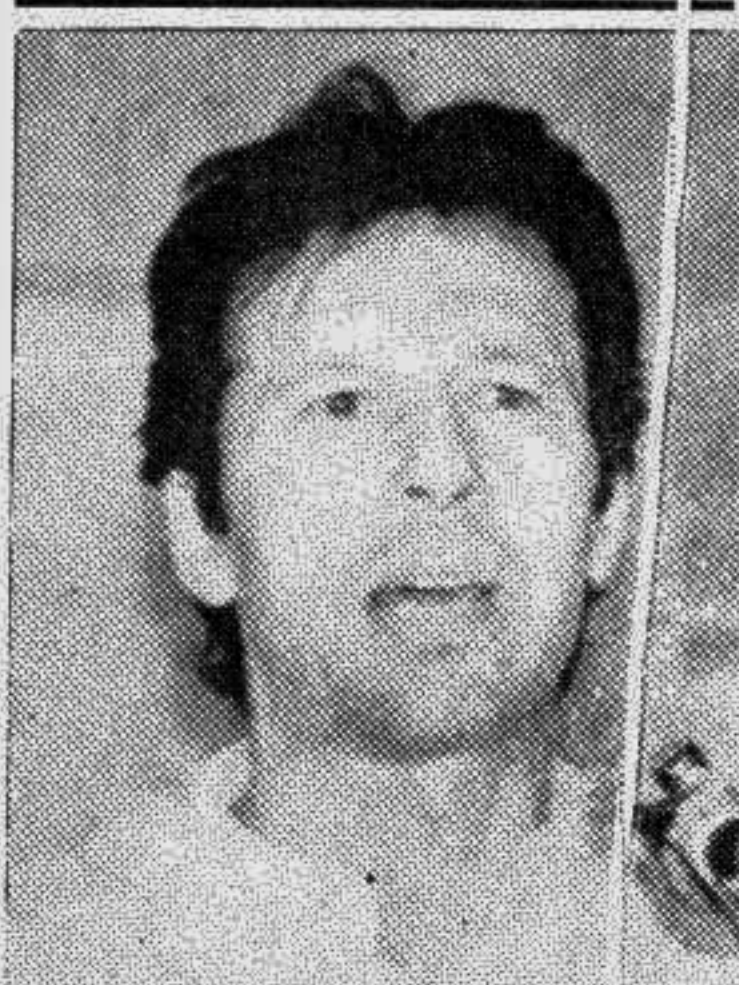

Dream final today



BARCELONA, Spain, May 25: Manchester United and Bayern Munich will both be hoping to re-live past glories when the two legendary clubs meet for Wednesday's European Cup final here, reports AFP.

United and Bayern, two of the sport's greatest names, have both waited decades to return to the summit of European football. Now they will get the chance in front of 90,000 screaming fans at the Nou Camp.

United's challenge is to complete a unique Treble by adding the European Cup to the FA Cup and the Premiership crown, and to reach back to 1968, when Bobby Charlton's side won this competition for Matt Busby.

Alex Ferguson has clearly established the present club as England's best of the 1990s — with a record three League and Cup doubles in 1994, 1996 and 1999, among a total of five Premiership titles.

His team have been outstanding this season, losing just five of their 62 matches in all competitions, averaging three goals a game and remaining unbeaten since November 1998.

And in strikers Dwight Yorke and Andy Cole, supported by Ryan Giggs and David Beckham, United have the most dangerous, and most entertaining, attacking line-up in European football.

But it still may not be enough. For if United have

dominated the relatively modest opposition of the English Premiership, they have always failed at the highest level in Europe. Before Wednesday, the club had never reached a final since the Champions League format was introduced in 1992.

United believed they are world-beaters, but now they must prove it against Bayern, and do so without two key midfielders, Irish captain Roy Keane and England's Paul Scholes, who are both suspended.

Keane was injured after just eight minutes in Saturday's 2-0 FA Cup win over Newcastle, prompting Ferguson to move Beckham into the middle and throw on Teddy Sheringham, who promptly scored one goal and made the other.

Keane's place here is likely to go to Nicky Butt, with defender Ronny Johnsen moving up to replace Scholes and Sheringham watching from the bench.

Win or lose, goalkeeper Peter Schmeichel will be playing his last match for United, the great Dane having decided to wear out. He will, however, wear Keane's armband as captain.

Schmeichel said: "I think it was inevitable we were going to reach a European Cup final one way or another, but I'm very happy it has happened in my time. We've been so close and yet so far away as well."

But if today's United are hoping to write their names alongside Charlton's team of George Best, Pat Crerand, Brian Kidd and Nobby Stiles in European history books, the desire is no less great at Bayern.

The mighty German club

won this competition in three consecutive seasons under Franz Beckenbauer from 1974 to 1976, including a 1975 win over another northern English club, Leeds United.

But that team, with Sepp Maier, Beckenbauer (now club president), Uli Hoenes (now club manager) and Gerd Muller, has never been equalled. Finals against Aston Villa in 1982 and FC Porto in 1987 both ended in defeat.

Now they are back, with the Bundesliga title in the bag, and the prospect of a treble of their own if they can beat United here and Werder Bremen in next month's German Cup final.

Bayern drew both matches with United earlier this season in Group D and believe they have little to fear.

"We performed well against Manchester United in our two group games, and even though they are a very good side, I am confident we will perform well against them in Barcelona," said midfielder Stefan Effenburg.

Team coach Ottmar Hitzfeld added: "United are a very compact team, strong going forward and dangerous at free kicks but vulnerable at the back. We must push them into making mistakes."

Beckenbauer was similarly upbeat, saying: "The English game suits us better than an Italian team."

Hitzfeld will be without two men on the long-term injured list, France's World Cup winning defender Bixente Lizarazu and talented Brazilian striker Giovane Elber.

Ticket alert

LONDON, May 25: Samples of forged tickets for Wednesday's European Cup final between Manchester United and Bayern Munich in Barcelona have been submitted to the European Football Union, UEFA said on Monday, reports Reuters.

A UEFA statement said the counterfeit tickets were poorly printed and contained spelling errors as well as readily recognisable visual differences from genuine tickets.

"Supporters should easily be able to recognise that the tickets are not genuine," UEFA said.

Red fans in Spain

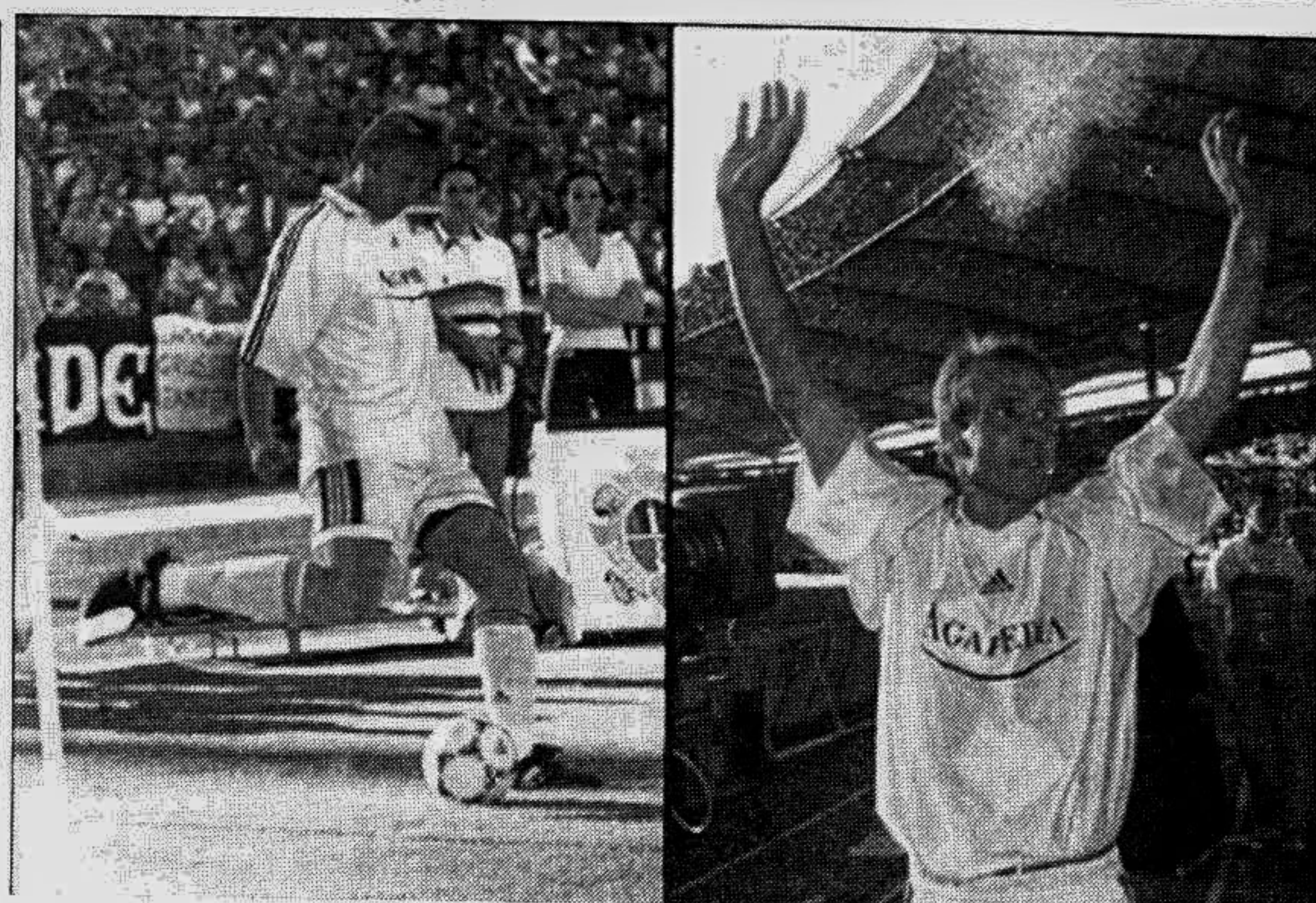
SITGES, Spain, May 25: Manchester United's army of supporters began to arrive in the Spanish resort of Sitges ahead of their team on Monday as local Catalan fans celebrated their own club's Spanish title success, reports Reuters.

Hundreds of English fans, bedecked in flags, red shirts and scarves, flew in to Barcelona international airport to a warm welcome before heading down the coast to relax.

There were many large groups of supporters and families in the streets of old Sitges and on the sea front, enjoying a warm sunny day without any signs of trouble. There are also many German families and fans holidaying in the same resort.

The Manchester United squad, fresh from winning the FA Cup on Saturday and completing their third English double in six seasons, arrived in a British Airways Concorde, a gesture of appreciation and gratitude from the national airline for the club's outstanding feats this season.

The squad is staying in a modern luxury hotel development on the northern fringes of this old resort town, a former fishing port south of Barcelona. "They have arrived safely and they are in their rooms resting," a hotel receptionist said.

Juergen goes out smiling

STUTTGART, May 25: Former Germany captain Juergen Klinsmann bid farewell to football with a star-studded testimonial match between his hand-picked world XI and a selection of friends from his first professional club VfB Stuttgart here on Monday, reports AFP.

The Swabian city on the River Neckar showed just how much its loves its best known footballing son by packing out the 53,000 seat Gottlieb Daimler stadium.

The 34-year-old ran and dived like teenager and scored in the 33rd, 55th, 60th, 71st, 73rd and 85th minutes helping Juergen's Dream Team make it

a 8-6 win.

Rudi Voeller, his striker partner from the 1990 World Cup win in Rome, also hit the back of the net with two second half goals.

These days Voeller is visibly greyer, heavier and strictly a suit-and-the-man at Bayer Leverkusen where he is team manager, but he still showed flashes of his old self.

Berti Vogts, Germany's former national coach, had a secret weapon in store for the second half. He substituted Juergen Kohler with tennis champion Boris Becker for 25 minutes.

"Boris said in the rooms, 'Ok has everyone got their rackets with them? I was bit surprised but apart from that everything went fine,' Kohler quipped.

Becker had the crowd chanting his name at the second half kick-off before retiring to the bench for a chat with Dutch star and Newcastle United manager Ruud Gullit who had time to forget Saturday's FA Cup final disaster against Manchester United.

In a playful look back at Klinsmann's most infamous on-field incident Vogts substituted Klinsmann with a few minutes left.

Two seasons ago Bayern Munich coach Giovanni Trapattoni did the same thing and Klinsmann hit the headlines when he slammed his boot through an advertising hoarding in the shape of a battery.

This time though, in a well choreographed piece of pantomime, he gave the battery hoarding a light tap and fired woops exploded.

"I am incredibly proud tonight that this football festival didn't end the way most testimonials do — you get subbed and don't come back on."

"I wanted to do things differently and have everyone go home with a smile on their faces, having fun."

"So I invited my friend Brian Adams to play a send-off song, 'My favourite, Summer of '69', it's an important year because that's when my wife was born who I owe so much to."

Entertainment was the

name of the game Monday evening and the crowd got plenty of it.

A brass band played from the sidelines and Charlie Chaplin impersonator with two sparsely clad young nurses was on hand to 'treat' players mid pitch who felt overwhelmed by the stress of the occasion.

All proceeds from the testimonial match, which Klinsmann organised himself, will go to children in need.

Klinsmann, who appeared 108 times for his country, scoring 47 goals, retired after Germany was knocked out of last year's World Cup quarter-finals by Croatia.

His finest moments came in 1990 and 1996, when he helped Germany to respective triumphs in the World Cup final in Italy and the European championship final in England.

He also enjoyed success at club level with prestigious clubs such as Inter Milan, Monaco, Bayern Munich and Tottenham Hotspur.

Muktis beat Badda

Muktijoddha Sangsad KC defeated Badda Jagarani Sangsad 2-0 in a round robin league match of the Pedrollo Pumps 15th Federation Cup football tournament at the Bangabandhu National Stadium yesterday, reports UNB.

League champions Muktijoddha Sangsad led the first half 1-0 with a Liton goal from a Masud Rana minus early in the 4th minute.

Badda Jagarani tried their utmost in the second half for an equaliser with Tanveer, Khokon and Riad combining in the attack. But all their efforts were thwarted by Muktijoddha defense.

Nakib doubled the winners' margin with a spectacular header in the 83rd minute from a cross by playmaker Masud Rana.

Earlier, in the day's first match, Brothers Union and Arambagh KS shared points in a goalless encounter.

Graf sails, Coetzer fails

PARIS, May 25 (AFP/AP): Five-time champion Steffi Graf of Germany moved briskly into the

second round of the French Open women's singles when she beat Maggie Maleeva of Bulgaria 6-2, 6-0 at Roland Garros today.

Graf, the winner here in 1987, 1988, 1993, 1995 and 1998, missed last year's tournament through injury but is playing at Roland Garros for the 16th time at the age of 29.

Seeded sixth this year, the German lost in the quarters when she last played here in 1997. She took just 49 minutes to beat Maleeva.

Graf was not at her best as she continues her comeback from a foot injury, but did hit several flowing groundstrokes, frequently leaving Maleeva flat-footed.

Graf next plays either Argentine Ines Gorricategui or Dutch player Seda Noorlander but admitted: "I'm not really thinking about winning titles right now."

While Graf progressed, 14th-seeded South African Amanda Coetzer, a semifinalist two years ago was beaten in straight sets by Ai Sugiyama of Japan. Sugiyama won 7-5, 6-1 as Coetzer joined Dominique Van Roost of Belgium on the list of women's seeds to lose in the first round.

Hludard-Decugis, seeded 16th, rallied to defeat Karina Habsudova of Slovakia 1-6, 6-4.

Also advancing early on the second day was Cristina Torrens-Valero of Spain, who beat Sophie Georges of France 6-2, 6-2.

There was an early upset in the men's singles with Magnus Larsson of Sweden defeating 11th-seeded Karol Kucera of Slovakia 6-2, 6-3, 6-2.

Larsson's 16th-seeded compatriot Thomas Enqvist, an Australian Open finalist earlier this year, also advanced with a 4-6, 6-0, 6-4, 6-2 triumph over Argentine qualifier Hector Moretti.

Brazilian clay court specialist Fernando Meligeni progressed with a 6-3, 6-3, 6-3 win over American Justin Gimelstob, while Norway's Christian Ruud beat Spaniard Carlos Costa 6-3, 6-4, 6-4.

Later Tuesday, another champion starts his quest for glory in Paris. Unlike Graf, though, Pete Sampras has never won the French Open. He was facing the Costa Rican Juan Antonio Marin.

On Monday, fans were treated to a trip down memory lane with matches featuring two longtime favourites in Paris: Andre Agassi and Michael Chang.

On Monday, he said he wasn't greatly bothered by the injury. But he still showed little in his 3-6, 7-5, 7-5, 6-3 victory to indicate he could win seven matches against younger players who specialise on the red clay in Paris.

In a match between former French Open champions, Kafelnikov edged Chang 6-2, 5-7, 6-0, 7-6 (10-8).
