Dhaka to receive Tk 1204cr Danish grant in 5 yrs

Bangladesh will receive a grant of about Tk 1204 crore from Denmark in the next five years (1999-2003), reports APB.

An agreed minutes to this effect was signed in the city yesterday.

Denmark will provide 265 million Danish kroner, equivalent to about Tk 185 crore, for 1999.

The agreement was reached on conclusion of the Annual Consultations on Bangladesh-Denmark Development Cooperation held at ERD in the afternoon.

Besides, Denmark will also extend financial support to the tune of 60 million Danish Kroner (about Tk 42 crore) per year for technical assistance, scholarship mixed credit and Danish NGOs through local non-government organisations.

The money will be provided outside the framework of bilateral development cooperation.

Carsten Nilauz Pedersen, Head of Asia and Pacific Division, Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Denmark, and A K M Khairul Alam, Joint Chief of ERD, Ministry of Finance, signed the agreed minutes on behalf of their respective governments.

Irish envoy calls on Samad Azad

Irish Ambassador to Bangladesh Jim Flavin made a courtesy call on Foreign Minister Abdus Samad Azad at his office yesterday and discussed the bilateral relations, reports UNB.

Samad Azad told the outgoing Irish envoy that Bangladesh wants to closely work with Ireland in promoting international peace, security and development.

Resident in Delhi, Flavin is the first Irish Ambassador to Bangladesh since the establishment of diplomatic relations between the two countries in 1996.

Director General of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Iftekharul Karim was also present on the occasion.
