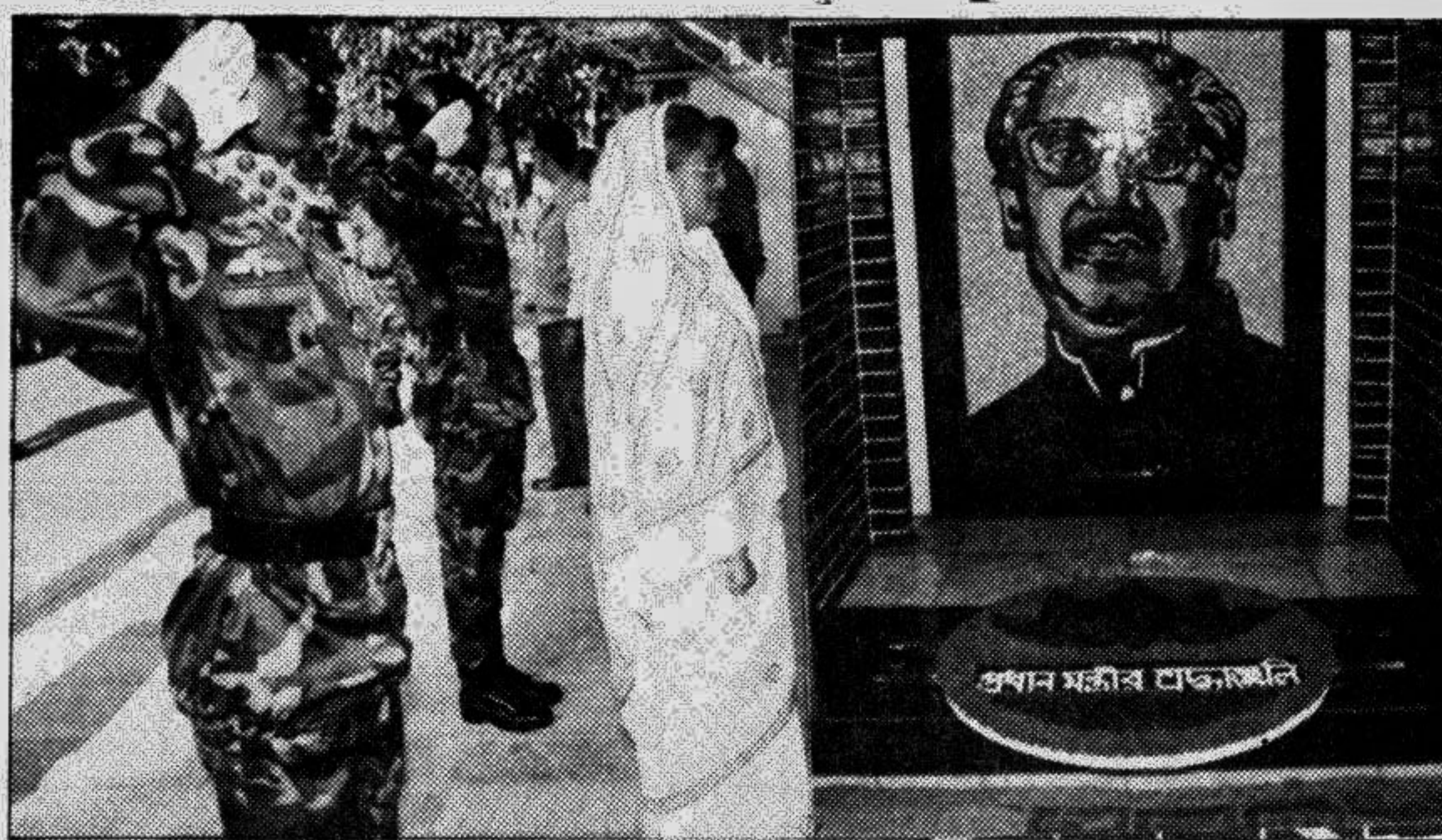

## City AL June 7 rally

# Increase production in mills, PM asks workers

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday called upon the workers to work hard with courage and to increase production in mills and fields, reports BSS.

"Bangalees can make impossible possible," she said adding that the nation which attained its independence by waging a sanguinary war cannot remain poor.

Addressing a mammoth workers' rally on the occasion of the historic June 7 the Prime Minister said, the principal objective of her government is to ameliorate the sufferings of the people and enhancing the living standard of the common masses.

The Prime Minister said, her government has taken massive programmes for turning the country's huge population into potential human resources. "We have made separate allocation in the budget for training workers," she said adding that in the meantime her government has sent over 7.5 lakh workers abroad with employment.

Held at the BG Press Ground, the rally was organised by the Dhaka Mohanagari Awami League to commemorate the killing of several workers including Manu Mia in police firing during anti-Ayub movement for realisation of historic 6 point demands placed by the father of the nation Banga-

bandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman. Mohanagar Awami League president and Mayor of Dhaka Mohammad Hanif presided over the rally while general secretary of the Mohanagar Awami League and state minister of LGRD Mofazzel Hossain Chowdhury Maya Bir Bikram conducted.

Party central leaders and members of the council of ministers including Amir Hossain Anu, Abdur Razzak, Toifail Ahmed, Abdul Jalil, Mozaffar Hossain Paltu, Begum Motia Chowdhury, Prof Abu Sayeed, Rahmat Ali, MP Abdul Mannan, Mukul Bose, Siddique Rauf Khan, Sultan Mohammad Mansur, MP, Nurul Fazal Bulbul, Prof Fazlul Haq, Dr HBM Iqbal MP, addressed the rally.

Leaders of front organizations including Abdus Salam Khan, Roy Ramesh Chandra, Fazlur Rahman Pantomas, Dr Iskander Mirza, Adv Kamrul Islam, Fazlul Haq Mantu, Fayezuddin Mia, Habibur Rahman Akhand, Bahadur Bepari, Ajoy Kar Khokan, AK Azad and Nasibun Ahmed spoke on the occasion.

Referring to denationalisation programme of her government the Prime Minister said, nine industries were earmarked for the workers. "The respective workers of these enterprises

will be able to become owners of these mills in proper process," she added.

Despite century's worst ever flood her government achieved 5.2 per cent GDP, the Prime Minister said. Making an oblique reference to those who termed this GDP growth as something "miracle," Sheikh Hasina said, the Bengali nation made such miracle in a number of crucial national juncture like defeating the most modern Pakistani occupation forces, tackling worst ever flood without allowing a single soul to die of starvation and lastly defeating the cricket giant Pakistan in the ongoing World Cup encounter. Besides, she said, Bangladesh created miracle signing 30-year Ganges water sharing treaty with India and signing peace accord on Chittagong Hill tracts which many quarters in home and abroad thought impossible.

The Prime Minister said, those who captured powers through illegal means after the assassination of father of the nation did not look into the welfare of the poor. Rather those regimes patronised the upper class of people and fortunate section of the society. She referred to a number of steps her government had taken including old age allowance, lump sum grants for distressed and abandoned women, employment bank, *oshkharan prokapa*, housing fund for the river eroded or otherwise homeless people. "Back home programme of Bangladesh Krishi Bank, distribution of VGF cards had positive impact in poverty alleviation and enhancing the living standard of the poor people.

Paying glowing tributes to Manu Mia and others who embraced death in the movement for realisation of six-point demands enunciated by Bangabandhu for attaining self-determination of the Bengali nation, the Prime Minister also gave a vivid account of various movements including 11-point movement and mass upsurge of '69, general election in '70 and war of liberation in 1971. She said, independence was not attained overnight.

## CCC announces budget for over Tk 333 crore

CHITTAGONG, June 7: Chittagong City Corporation (CCC) today announced a balanced budget of Taka 333 crore 12 lakh 33 thousand eight hundred ninety six for the year 1999-2000, reports BSS.

CCC Mayor ABM Mohiuddin Chowdhury announced the budget at a meeting held at CCC conference hall and attended by ward commissioners and local journalists.

Mayor Mohiuddin also presented a revised budget of Taka 169 crore 81 lakh 83 thousand eight hundred ninety six for the year 1998-99.

The main sources of income shown in the budget 1999-2000 are: Taka 110 crore seventeen lakh fifty thousand from Corporation tax, fees, fines, interest from deposit, house and shop rents etc. Taka 205 crore seventy five lakh as government development grant, subsidy and relief, and Taka ten crore from earlier bank deposit.

The main heads of expenditure proposed in the budget are: salary and allowances of CCC employees — Tk 32 crore, purchase of permanent property Taka 55 crore 80 lakh, expenditure for welfare activities — Taka seven crore 44 lakh, cost of electricity, water and energy — Taka four crore 25 lakh, maintenance and repair of CCC property — Taka 24 crore 10 lakh, entertainment and festival — Taka 50 lakh, advertisement and publicity — Taka one crore, relief works — Taka one crore, purchase of goods etc. for CCC — Taka 6 crore fifty eight lakh 25 thousand, payment of arrears — Taka three crore and development works — Taka 173 crore.
