

The government has decided to increase allowances for government servants in coming 1999-2000 fiscal in the fulfillment of its previous decision, reports BSS.

Finance Minister Shah AMS Kibria in his budget speech in the Jatiya Sangsad yesterday said an additional Taka 680 crore will be required in revenue budget (excluding development project) for this purpose.

He also said the expenditure on pension will increase by Taka 384 crore.

DU faces acute water scarcity

Teachers, students and the staff of the Dhaka University who reside in the vicinity of the campus faced serious problem yesterday because of acute scarcity of water.

The crisis has been persisting for the past few months, but it was worst yesterday as power cut kept the water pumps inoperative for long eight hours.

The water crisis was really dreadful for us. It was the worst day in my university life," said a female student of Rokeya Hall.

Student who remained confined at their halls till noon, expressed resentment over the worst-ever situation caused by the water crisis.

When contacted, a university official said the situation has turned worse only for the prolonged power cut. He also described the situation as a rare incident in the university.

NSU seminar

North South University (NSU) held a seminar on Religion, Ethics and Environment on Monday, says a press release.

Earth Club, a student activity club, in observance of the World Environment Day organised the seminar.

Participants in the seminar were Father James Fannan, a teacher of Philosophy at National Major Seminary.

Ananda Chandra Baul, Assistant Secretary of Pali and Sanskrit Education Board, Suman Barua, a representative from Buddhism and Khalilullah, a prominent writer on religion and environment. Dr Islam M Faisal, Chairman of the Department of Environmental Studies, NSU inaugurated the seminar.

A cultural programme followed the seminar where a local band called "Bangla" performed traditional folks songs.

He said both surface and ground waters are being polluted in many places while polluted air is a major threat to public health in the metropolitan areas.

He said a survey on arsenic poisoning in ground water is in progress.

Referring to environmental degradation in Bangladesh, Kibria said it is a stark reality in day to day life that various species of animals and plants are disappearing fast.

He said poverty has further compounded the environmental problems.

Referring to the Sundarbans, he said it has already been declared a world heritage site and a Taka 382.29 crore project has been undertaken with the assistance of Asian Development Bank (ADB) for preservation of bio-diversity in the forests.
