Housewife shot dead

COMILLA. June 15: Unidentified assailants shot dead a young housewife of Rampur village in Chouddogram thana on Wednesday night, reports UNB.

Police arrested two people, including the husband of the victim in this connection. Police said Renu Begum, 27, wife of Moulana Rahmatullah Bhuiyan received a bullet in her chest from outside the house at about 8 pm when she was doing her household works. She died on the spot. Hearing the sound of gun shot and hue and cry of Renu, other members of the family rushed to the spot and found her dead on the floor. The motive behind the killing could not be known immediately. Police arrested her husband Rahmatullah and another person named Obaidur Rahman Hasan in this connection.

Chairman of Chittagong Hill Tracts Development Board, Bir Bahadur, MP and President of Bandarbun District Awami League Prasunya Kanti Tanchangya in separate messages condoled the death of the mother of Kalpa Ranjan Chakma, Chandramukhi Dewan and conveyed heart-felt sympathy to the members of the breaved family. Chandramukhi Dewan, 100, died on Wednesday at her Khagrachhari residence due to old-age ailments. The body of Chandramukhi Dewan was cremated on Saturday at her husband's house at Babupara in Dighinala thana of Khagrachhari Hill district.

Proposed budget hailed

MADARIPUR, June 15; Bangladesh Awami League, Madaripur district unit and its front organisations and Bangladesh Human Rights Commission, Madaripur hailed the proposed national budget for the financial year 1999-2000, describing it as an exceptional budget with a clear direction for development, reports BSS.

In a statement President of Madaripur District Awami League has said that this year's budget has been formulated for ensuring rapid development of the country facilitating the poverty alleviation programme and creating employment opportunities. The proposed budget, he said, reflected the rationalisation of duty rates and income tax structure and encouraged agriculture and education sectors. Bangladesh Chhatra League district unit President said that the government has given top priority to education and due importance to preservation and development of environment by making adequate budgetary allocation.

Rivals clash leaves 8 hurt

NOAKHALI, June 15: At least eight people, two women of them seriously, were injured in a clash between two rival groups at Char Dhanershish village in sadar thana on Monday, reports

Witnesses and police said the clash ensued when a group of influential fish farmers tried to evict the land less people from the char areas to grab the government khas land. Of the injured, Nurunnahar and Kurphulernesa were sent to Noakhali sadar hospital in a critical condition. The landless people who had been living for the last 12 years in the area alleged that the influential fish farmers started threatening them to withdraw the case.

Bail prayer rejected

MANIKGANJ, June 15; A court here rejected the bail petition of a local businessman and sent him to jail on Thursday in connection with the sensational Rabiul murder case, reports

Ishak Mia was arrested on June 6 following the confessional statements of his son and six of his employees that he was involved in the killing of Rabiul. Rabiul Islam, a Class IX student of Shibalaya Government High School, was murdered in September last year. After the murder, police caught Mizan, son of Ishak and six employees of his Bidi factory on the basis of a case filed by victim's father Chan Mia. Later on, the plaintiff drew the attention of the Home Minister and following his directives the case was handed over to CID for proper investigation.

Open sale of rotten rice

BAGERHAT, June 15: The poor people of the district have been suffering from various diseases after consumption of unwholesome rice, reports UNB.

According of official sources, about 1,238 metric tons of rice worth Taka 1.24 crore, imported from India on January 16 this year, were dumped on May 9-11 under the ground at Joymoni area in the Sundarbans as it was found unfit for human consumption. But some dishonest traders lifting the rice from the ditch are selling to the poor people at nominal prices causing widespread outbreak of various stomach ailments.

Woman, cow killed by lightning

RANGAMATI, June 15: A woman and her cow were killed by lightning on Wednesday at Zarulbagan in Langadu thana when she was taking home her domestic animals from the nearby field, police sources said, reports BSS.

The victim was identified as Noyna Begum, 40.

Rehabilitation centre opens

JHALAKATHI, June 15: An Asrayan project (rehabilitation centre) was inaugurated at Subidput village in Nalchhati thana on Friday, reports APB.

Twenty destitute families have been rehabilitated in two barracks in the project, built by the Army. Awami League central leader Amir Hossain Amu inaugurated the project as the chief guest and distributed land documents to the rehabilitated families. They will also be given vocational training and loans for self-employment, official sources said.

Murderer suspect arrested

MANIKGANJ, June 15: One person has been arrested and sent to jail in connection with the killing of a school student last year, reports APB.

CID police on Thursday arrested Isak Mia, a wealthy person, in connection with the killing of Rabiul, 14, in September last year. He was produced before the court the same day. The magistrate rejected his bail prayer and sent him to jail, police and court sources said. Rabiul's father Chand Mia had filed a case with Shibalaya thana after his son's murder. But none was arrested long after the killing. Chand Mia appealed to The Home Minister who ordered transfer of the case to CID.

Gaibandha people deprived of healthcare facilities

GAIBANDHA, June 15: People are not receiving medicare service in all the thana health complexes here including Gaibandha Modernised Hospital following acute shortage of pysicians, essential drugs and consultants.

According to a statistical report of nine health complexes, one TB clinic and a rural health centre here rendered medicare services to a total of 3,75,028 patients during the last four months. Out of those, 25,095 patients were indoor and the remaining 3,49,033 were treated as outdoor patients.

In Gaibandha Modernised He ital all sorts of general, gy necological and surgical treatment remain suspended here for want of anesthesia consultant. So every day large number of patients needing

surgical treatment either take shelter at private clinics or rush to Rangpur Medical College Hospital (RMCH). Poor people remain helpless.

Meanwhile, all the health complexes are largely affected by environmental pollution. Garbages, odd-smell, power failure, flies and mosquito menace have gripped the hospital complexes. The condition of Gaibandha

Modernised Hospital is more pitiable. Its 50-bed capacity is not adequate to the requirement. Surgical treatment remains absent for a pretty long time on the plea of lack of consultant.

According to the local Member of Parliament (MP) who has been fighting for appointing a surgical consultant at Gaibandha hospital since three
