Atiqur Rahman Atiq, JCD unit president at Kabi Jasimuddin Hall of the university, was assaulted allegedly by the BCL activists at the Teachers and Students Centre (TSC) on June 17 during the counting of votes of the elections of the registered graduate representatives at the DU Senate.

Later, at a rally held at the main gate of Arts Building, the JCD leaders demanded arrest and exemplary punishment of those responsible for the attack.

Presided over by Manir Hossain, the rally was addressed, among others, by Monjur Elahi, ABM Mosharraf Hossain and Mostafizul Islam Mamun.

Samad Azad greets FM of S Africa

Foreign Minister Abdus Samad Azad has felicitated Dr Nkosazana Dlamini-Zuma on his appointment as Foreign Minister of South Africa, reports UNB.

In a message yesterday, Azad recalled his presence in the inaugural ceremony of the second democratically elected President of South Africa, Thabo Mbeki, last week.

He said Bangladesh deeply value the excellent relations with South Africa which, he hoped, would expand and consolidate under the new leadership.

Azad also hoped for sharing valuable experience of South Africa in hosting the next NAM summit in Dhaka in 2001.

JP international affairs secretary Golam Masih and private secretary Maj (rtd) Khaled Akhtar accompanied Ershad. He is likely to return in a week.

Orientation course on Integrated Nutrition held

A day-long orientation course on Integrated Nutrition jointly organised by Bangladesh Scouts and Bangladesh Integrated Nutrition Project was held yesterday at the National Headquarters, says a press release.

Manzoor Ul Karim, Chief National Commissioner, Bangladesh Scouts and Team Leader, BINP, inaugurated the course while M Fazlur Rahman, National Commissioner (Community Development and Health) and Secretary, Ministry of Science and Technology, presided.

A total of 60 scouts and professionals from all over the country attended the orientation course.

Tree plantation campaign in Chittagong

CHITTAGONG, June 21: Tree plantation campaign '99 was inaugurated at a simple ceremony held at the Circuit House premises here this morning, reports BSS.

Chittagong City Corporation Mayor ABM Mohiuddin Chowdhury inaugurated the campaign by planting a sapling in front of the Circuit House.

Presided over by the Deputy Commissioner of Chittagong Muhammad Hasan, the function was addressed by Divisional Commissioner ASM Mobaidul Islam, Conservator of Forest, Chittagong range M Rezaul Karim, Director of Forest Research Institute AKM Akhtaruzzaman and Chittagong Divisional Forest Officer Mosharraf Hossain.

Later, a colourful procession was brought out from the Circuit House premises. Schoolchildren, NGO workers and employees of different voluntary organisations joined the procession.

Speaking on the occasion, Mayor Mohiuddin Chowdhury said the city corporation would arrange "Green Fair (Sabuj Mela)" next month to encourage people to plant saplings. The Mayor also asked the students of schools and colleges run by city corporation to plant one sapling each during the current season.

PKSF implementing \$115m poverty alleviation project

Palli Karma Sahayak Foundation (PKSF), a government funded non-profit organisation, is implementing a nationwide poverty alleviation micro-finance project at a cost of US dollar 115 million, reports BSS.

The World Bank has identified the PKSF as a corporate model for the State Owned Enterprises, the Managing Director of PKSF, Dr Salehuddin Ahmed, said this while talking to BSS yesterday. Dr Ahmed said PKSF has already received US dollar 63.70 million till March this year out of the total US dollar 115 million funded by the International Development Agency (IDA) and the government.

Leading economist Dr Ahmed said PKSF would also implement the micro-credit component of ADB assisted approximately US dollars 18 million participatory livestock development project in the North-Western part of the country.

The PKSF has done well in alleviating poverty and improve quality of life of the poor, asset-less and land-less people, especially rural poor since its inception in May 1990, he said.

On the basis of PKSF's unique performance, he said, the World Bank has agreed in principle to provide US dollar 100 million more in the second phase of poverty alleviation micro finance project expected to begin in February 2000. He said the next project would provide loan to 2 million people, especially urban poor and micro enterprise project.

PKSF is well known abroad for its unique institutional set up and many countries like Uzbekistan, India, Maldives, Zambia and Burundi are interested to replicate the PKSF model in their respective countries, Dr Ahmed said and pointed out that Pakistan had

already set up such a foundation.

Dr Ahmed, former professor of Dhaka University, said PKSF follows the strategy of providing collateral free credit to its partner organisations (POs) the NGOs and other organisations at 3-5 per cent service charge, which in turn disburse loan among their members. Up to March this year, the foundation has enlisted 182 POs that cover 318 thanas of 60 districts of the country, he added.

Dr Ahmed said PKSF has so far disbursed about Taka 500 crore among 1.4 million poor people through its POs to create employment opportunities in rural Bangladesh.

PKSF disbursed around Tk

200 crore to its partner organizations from July 1998 to June this year, to expedite the poverty alleviation programme, he added.

He said it has been well recognised by development community as a successful example of government-NGO collaboration in the field of development activities.

Referring to a recent observation of the World Bank supervision mission, Dr Ahmed said there are significant improvements in social indicators like use of sanitary latrines, awareness regarding family planning, use of safe drinking water among the beneficiaries of PKSF assisted micro-credit programmes.

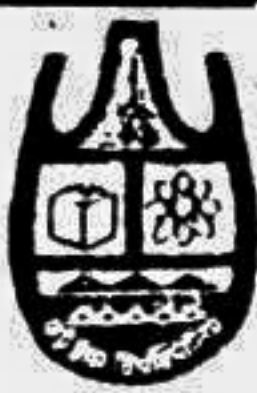
Moderately heavy falls is also likely at places over Rajshahi, Barisal and Chittagong divisions during the period, according to Met Office.
