Weather**Thundershowers likely**

Light to moderate rain or thundershowers accompanied by temporary gusty wind is likely at many places over Chittagong, Barisal and Sylhet divisions and at a few places over Dhaka, Khulna and Rajshahi divisions during the next 12 hours till 6 pm today, reports UNB.

Moderately heavy falls is expected at the places over Chittagong and Barisal divisions during the period.

Slight rise in day temperature is likely over the country. Met Office said.

Yesterday's highest temperature of 34.5 degree Celsius was recorded at Chuadanga and the lowest of 22.6 degrees at Kutubdia.

Rainfalls recorded in the last 24 hours till 6 am yesterday are: 46 mm in Cox's Bazar, 42 mm in Sylhet, 35 mm in Chittagong, 29 mm in Faridpur, 24 mm in Rajshahi and 16 mm in Rangpur.

The sun sets today at 6:50 pm and rises tomorrow at 5:14 am.

'Family Welfare Centre in each union by 2003'

Health and Family Welfare Minister Salah Uddin Yusuf informed the Jatiya Sangsad yesterday that the government has a plan to set up Family Welfare Centres (FWC) in each union in the country under Health and Population Section Programme (HPSP) by the year 2003, reports BSS.

Replying to a question from M Jalal Uddin Talukder (AL-Netrakona), he also said that the government has a plan to set up Family Welfare Centres in Gaonkanda, Bakaigarah and Nizampur unions under Durgapur and Kalmakanda thanas in the Netrakona district in the current (1999-2000) fiscal.

Replying to another question from M Mostafizur Rahman Fiza (AL-Dinajpur), the Health Minister said, the government has a plan to set up one community clinic for 6,000 persons in each ward and the process has already started under HPSP and the government has set a target to complete the work by the year 2003.

He, however, added that the government at present has no plan to set up one charitable dispensary in each ward in Dinajpur.

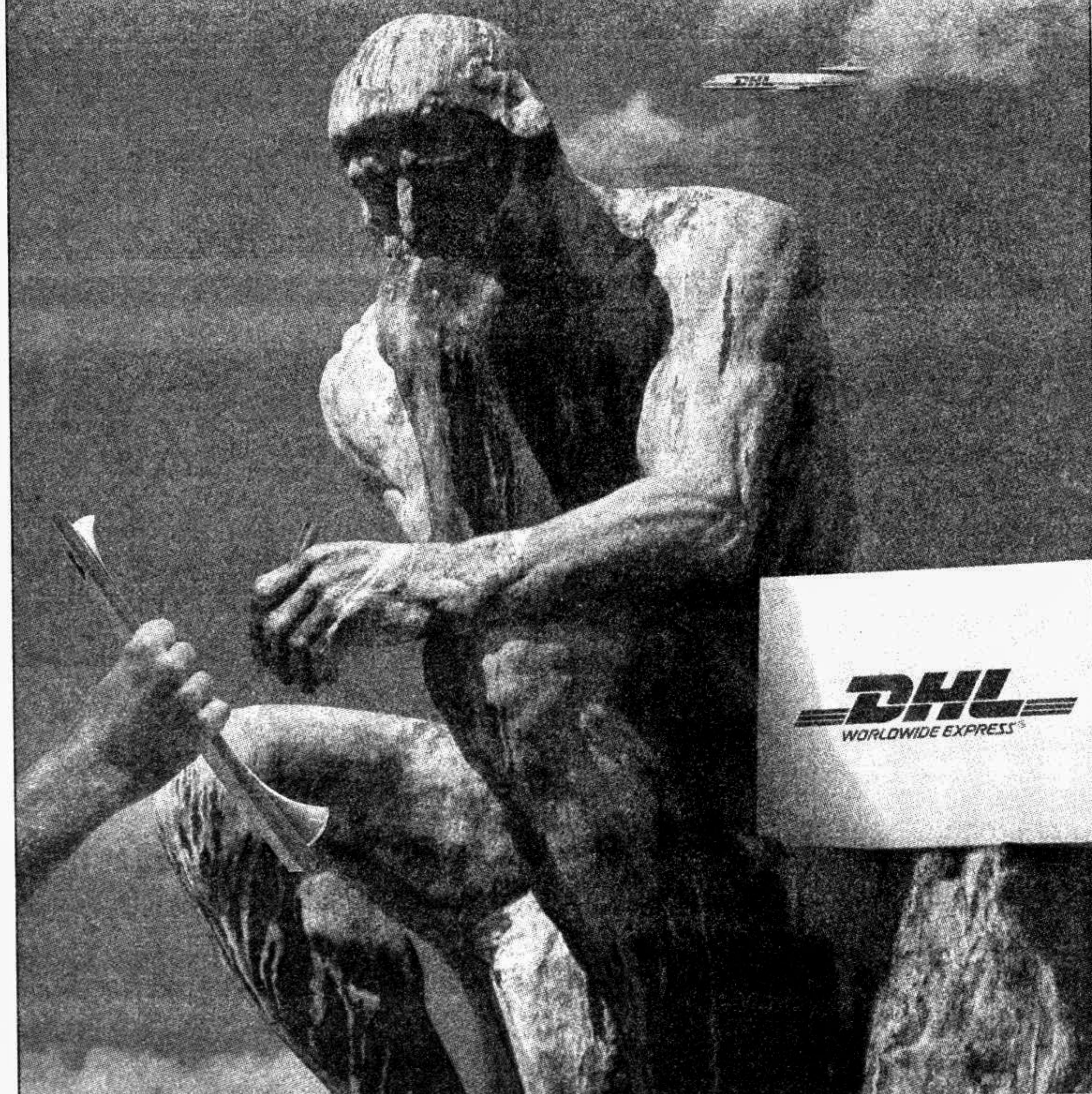

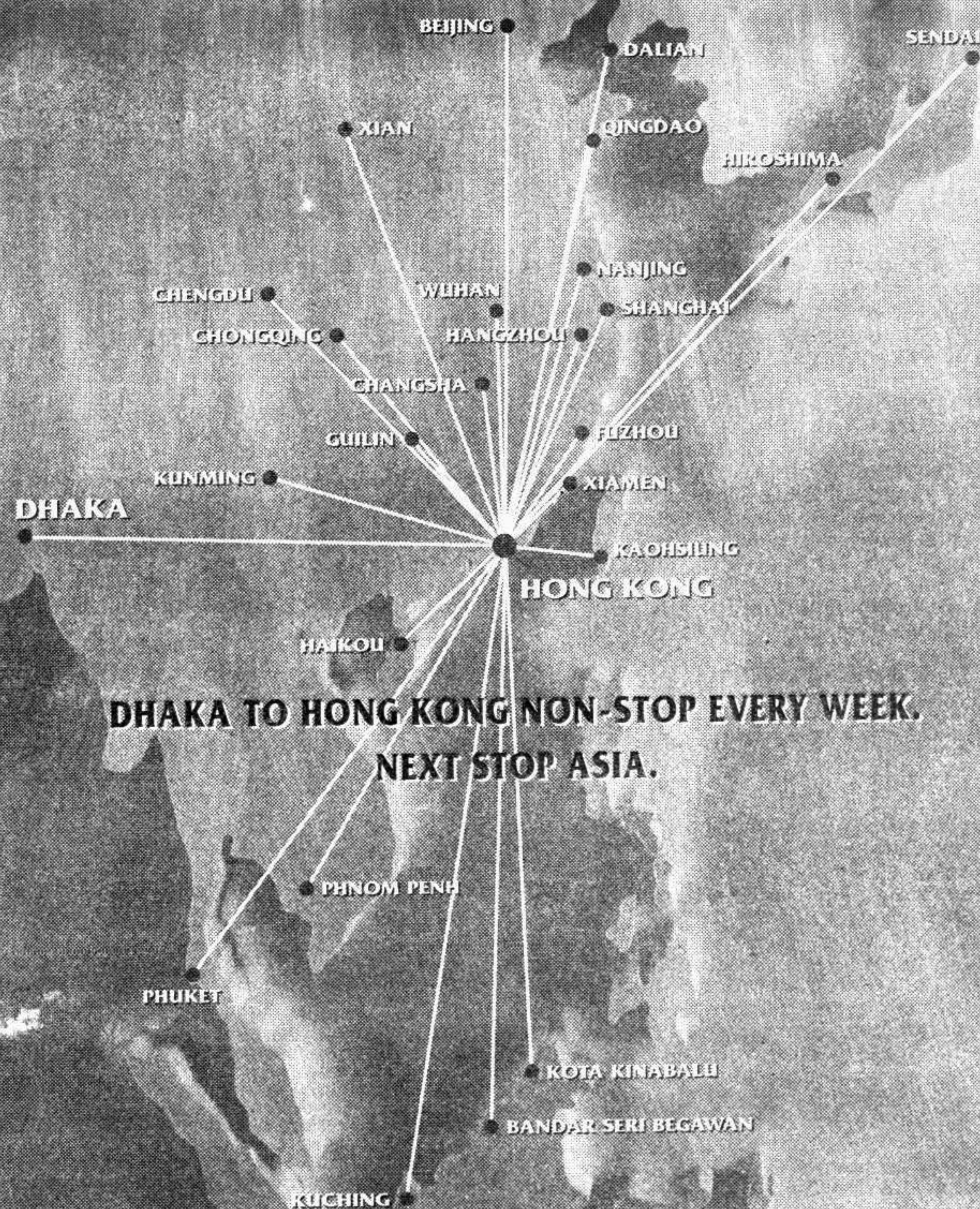
