**BARISAL.** July 1: Terrorist activities are on rise alarmingly in Barisal towns and its adjoining areas in recent days.

Three persons including a child were killed and at least seven people were injured during the last two weeks.

Saonamuddin Gazi of Hanua village of Uzirpur was chopped to death by his younger brother on June 21.

On the same day, the Chhatri of Seraik, son of the same thana was critically injured. A gang of armed people shot at him. Four people were injured during that time.

Abdus Salam, a businessman was abducted by two ter-

rorists with more than three lakh taka on way to Barisal from Swarupkathi riding a motorcycle on June 21 in broad daylight.
