### Freedom fighter

#### Abu Yusuf

Eminent freedom fighter Abu Yusuf Khan, Bir Bikram, died of cardiac arrest in the city yesterday. He was 63, reports BSS.

Khan, who is the elder brother of late Col. Abu Taher, Bir Uttam, Commander of the Sector 11 during the country's War of Liberation, died at the Bangladesh Medical College Hospital at Dhammandi, where he underwent a critical surgery three days ago. A few years ago he also underwent bypass surgery.

A former Air Force officer, Abu Yusuf Khan joined the Liberation War after fleeing from Saudi Arabia, where he was posted in 1971 as a trainer. He played a commendable role as an active fighter in the Sector 11 that comprised Mymensingh and part of greater Dhaka. He also played the historic role by accompanying the Maratha Regiment of the allied forces which, along with the Mukti Bahini, made their first advance inside Bangladesh territory through Sherpur and Jamalpur in the first week of December, 1971.

Khan, who left behind his wife and a son, was imprisoned for many years during late President Ziaur Rahman's tenure. He was also a contributor to various national dailies and fought relentlessly for the cause of restoring progressive outlook in society.

He will be buried at the Mukti Joddha graveyard at Mirpur after the *namaz-e-Janaza* at the Baitul Mukarram National Mosque after Zohr prayers.

### Oscar Film Week '99 begins today

## New cooperatives law awaits passage in JS: Zillur

LGRD and Cooperative Minister Zillur Rahman yesterday said a new cooperative law is awaiting passage of parliament to bring massive changes in the existing one for accelerating cooperative movement, reports BSS.

The new law will play a significant role in achieving economic emancipation," he said, adding: "it will also provide legal coverage for fixation of five-year tenure of elected cooperative management committee like that of union council and parliament in line with the demands of the cooperators."

Addressing a discussion marking the 77th International Cooperatives Day at BCIC auditorium as the chief guest, the minister said Cittaranjan Cotton Mills and Samabaya Insurance Bhaban at Motijheel would be handed over soon to the Bangladesh Jatiya Samabaya Marketing Society.

He said the government has taken up massive steps through "Asrayan Programme" to rehabilitate the poor and landless people across the country under the personal initiative of Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina through cooperative system has been included.

This year's theme of the day is "government policy and cooperative laws."

He said the cooperative banks would be given the status of schedule banks for bringing dynamism in the activities of the cooperators including loan disbursement.

Besides, he said the government has been implementing a


project named "Fishermen Cooperative Project" under the Cooperative Directorate at a cost of Taka 110 crore for rehabilitating the fisherman cooperators affected by cyclone and tidal surge on April 29 in 1991 in the coastal areas.

A total of 600 boat with fishing nets is being distributed among the 7200 affected fisherman cooperators in 14 districts, he said.

President of Jatiya Samabaya Union, Habibur Rahman Mollah MP said the present government led by Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina has been relentlessly working to complete the programmes for the economic emancipation of the people which was initiated by father of the nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman.

## Call for trial of war criminals

Speakers at an open discussion yesterday called for trial of the war criminals in Bangladesh.

Expressing frustration over the commitment of the governments of major political parties over holding trial of the war criminals, they underscored the need for mobilising the new generation for implementing ideals of the Liberation War.

The open discussion on "Trial of War Criminals: This Generation's Thoughts" was held at the Muktijuddho Jatiya Auditorium (Liberation War Museum Auditorium) yesterday. The discussion was organised by Uttoradikhar, a new generation organisation, on the occasion of the fifth death anniversary of Shaheed Janani Jahanara Imam.

Speaking at the discussion, BSS MD and Chief Editor Haider Habib said as a nation we would be disgraced if we do not unite for the trial of the war criminals. He said Awami League could not come to power if the movement demanding trial of war criminals had not begun in 1992.

It seems that the "pro-liberation" government in power now, is hesitant to bring the war criminals into justice," some speakers said.

Elderly journalist Santosh Gupta said the general amnesty to war criminals was a mistake of the post-war leadership.

Criticising the role of intellectuals in liberated Bangladesh, Gupta said the concept of secularism fostered by the state is also wrong and it has led to a lot of confusion.

Police yet to rescue woman kidnapped in Chuadanga

CHUADANGA, July 3: Police are yet to rescue the wife of a local journalist even five days after the kidnapping, reports UNB.

Police said one Hiru kidnapped Jasmin Akther Mukti, 26, wife of weekly Chuadanga Zila Khabar editor Nurul Islam Ratan, from in front of Post office at gunpoint on June 29.

She was returning home after dropping off her daughter at her school at about 10 am.

A case was filed with police in this regard.

Tk 2.64 cr budget Daudkandi poura budget announced

COMILLA, July 3: Daudkandi Pourashava has announced a Taka 2,64,41,581 budget for 1999-2000 fiscal year, reports BSS.
