Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL), student wing of the ruling party, brought out a procession in the city protesting yesterday's hartal.

Later, BCL held a rally at the Paltan Maidan at noon following the procession, brought out from the Dhaka University campus.

Addressing the rally, BCL leaders blamed the three party Opposition Alliance for creating anarchy in the society and intercepting the country's march towards twenty-first century.

They also urged the opposition to practice fair politics for the sake of democracy and development of the country.

Presided over by Bahadur Bepary, the rally was addressed, among others, by Ajay Kar Khokan, Gazi Mesbaul Hossain Sachchu, Asrafullah Azim Rubin, Rafiqul Islam, Nazma Alam Biplobi, Sajjad Hossain, A K M Azim and Gias Uddin Palash.

Meanwhile, BCL has accused the "terrorists" of opposition BNP for Wednesday's bomb attack on a police constable who later succumbed to his injuries.

A BCL statement, signed by its president and general secretary demanded immediate arrest and exemplary punishment to those responsible for the killing.

BCL will also stage demonstration on the Dhaka University campus tomorrow protesting the killing.

Production in
JFF suspended
for 10 days

Jamuna Fertiliser Factory (JFF) will temporarily suspend its production for 10 days from July 10 as there will be no power in the factory, reports BSS.

The factory will resume normal production as soon as the power connection is restored.

Power Development Board (PDB) will not be able to provide electricity to the factory for maintenance work on the Jamalpur-Tarakandi line for the period.

There will be no problem in supplying required quantity of fertiliser to the command area of the factory as it has 33,000 metric tons of stock at godowns.
