Bill in US Senate to recognise Muslim contribution

US Senators Spencer Abraham and Larry Craig are sponsoring a legislation that would recognise the contributions of American Muslims and strongly condemn anti-Muslim intolerance and discrimination, reports UNB.

The bill, Senate Resolution 133, was introduced by Abraham, a republican from Michigan, July 2. It has been referred to the Senate Judiciary Committee for consideration. A similar bill is expected to be proposed in the House of Representatives.

It begins by noting that there are approximately six million Muslims and more than 1,500 mosques, Islamic schools and Islamic centres in the United States.

"Islam is one of the great Abrahamic faiths, whose significant contributions throughout history have advanced the fields of math, science, medicine, law, philosophy, art, and literature," the legislation notes.

While acknowledging that Muslims have, on occasion, been subjected to acts of discrimination and intolerance and been portrayed in a negative light, the proposed legislation condemns such actions "as wholly inconsistent with the American values of religious tolerance and pluralism."

"This resolution sends an important message to America's growing Muslim community that we in Congress oppose religious discrimination in any form," Senator Craig, a Republican from Idaho said in a statement he released July 8.

"We also recognise the contributions of over 6 million American Muslims in countless communities across the nation, religious tolerance is one of the principles by which our nation is guided and this resolution is in keeping with this important American ideal."

The purpose behind the legislation is essentially to raise people's consciousness and sensitise them to issues of concern to the American Muslim community, Randa Fahmy Hudome, an aide to Senator Abraham, said in a July 8 telephone interview.

One of the most active Muslim groups in the US, the American Muslim Council, is urging its members throughout the country to contact their senators and ask that they co-sponsor the resolution.

Discussion on LBW held

A discussion on the alarmingly high percentage of low birth weight babies born in Bangladesh was held recently in a local hotel, says a press release.

Renowned gynecologists Prof Firoza Begum and obstetrician Prof TA Chowdhury conducted the programme. The programme was attended by the prominent obstetricians, gynecologists and pediatricians of the country.

The discussion centred on Meternal Nutrition and Feeding of Low Birth Weight Babies (LBW). World renowned Professor of Paediatrics & Neonatology Dr Meharban Singh presented the keynote paper.

Dr Meharban Singh stressed on giving adequate and nutritious food to the girl child, even before and during pregnancy, and lactation to avoid LBW babies. He also mentioned that mothers should always be encouraged to breast feed her baby. The low birth weight babies should also be given mother's milk supplemented with additional nutrients.

MOU signed Joint venture university to be set up

A memorandum of understanding (MOU) was signed yesterday by Lotus-Kamal Group and Buckingham International Trading Co of the USA, Kensington Pacific University, Asia Pacific Welfare Foundation of Hawaii and TULIP of Japan to establish an American, Japanese and Bangladesh joint venture university at a cost of two million US dollars, reports BSS.

The joint venture will be headed by A H M Mustafa Kamal, MP of Lotus-Kamal Group and the Chancellor of the institution will be Dr Alfred Calabro — a leading criminal attorney in the USA and a Shakespearean scholar, a press release said.

Kensington Pacific University Dhaka Campus will offer programmes in BBA, MBA in traditional business disciplines as well as in international business with specialisation in American and Japanese Management.

It will also house a Japan Management Science centre, which will teach Japanese Management with extensive training in language both in Dhaka and Tokyo.

The university, which was a sister university relationship with University of Rome, will offer internship to all the qualified students either in the USA, Japan or Italy, and it will open placement offices in the USA, Japan and Italy to assist students in overseas job placement.

Asia Pacific Welfare Foundation of the USA will offer special scholarships to female students to encourage them to take leading roles in international business in the 21st century.

The university will be provided with state of art audio-visual equipment and computers.

The visiting faculty includes professors from the universities in Japan and the USA as well as from University of Rome.

The MOU also includes the establishment of the joint venture project to make pharmaceutical specialties with Japan for export to Eastern Europe.

LRC earned Tk 2cr from sale of vaccines last year

The Livestock Research Council (LRC) earned taka 2 crore from the sale of vaccines last year, reports BSS.

This was informed to the Fisheries and Livestock Minister ASM Abdur Rob when he visited the council on Monday, on official handout said.

The council produced 21 crore and 42 lakh doses of vaccines last year and distributed 20 crore doses among the farmers at a nominal price.
