Veyret said she was going back home with sweet memories and warm hospitality of the people of Bangladesh.
Director General of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Iftikharul Karim was present during the meeting.

BCU to lay siege to Home Ministry July 26

The leaders of Bangladesh Chhatra Union (BCU) yesterday announced that they would lay siege to the Home Ministry and submit a memorandum to the minister on July 26, demanding immediate arrest and trial of the killers of Proton Kumar Dasgupta and release of BCU Khulna BL College unit president Sekander Hayat.
The BCU will also hold a countrywide demonstration on July 26 to press home their demands.
The announcement was made at a rally held in front of the DUCSU building on Dhaka University campus yesterday noon. The rally was organised to protest killing of BCU Jatiya Parishad member and Habiganj district leader, Proton. Proton was allegedly killed by pro-Awami League armed men recently.
Addressing the rally, BCU leaders said that terrorists backed by pro-government student organisation Bangladesh Chhatra League had killed Proton recently. "Proton was killed as he was trying to mobilise public opinion against the terrorists at Lakhai thana in Habiganj," the BCU leaders said.
They also condemned the role of the local administration and police as they failed to take any steps against the killers.
They also urged the Home Minister to look into the matter and demanded exemplary punishment of the killers.
Presided over by Monjur-e-Khoda Torik, the rally was addressed, among others, by Hasan Tarik Chowdhury Soheli, Nadira Sultana Nodi and Mahabubur Rahman Shipon.
Earlier, the BCU brought out a procession and paraded on the Dhaka University campus in support of their demand.

Jamaat expresses concern over devaluation of Taka

Jamaat-e-Islami has expressed deep concern at the devaluation of Taka saying it will adversely affect the country's economy, reports UNB.
Jamaat secretary general Maulana Matiuur Rahman Nizami in a statement yesterday said the currency was devalued 15 times to the extent of 17.13 per cent since the Awami League came to power in 1996, at the behest of the donors and a certain sector of industry.
The measure has failed to increase export earning, rather it had been declining. The remittance from the wage earners abroad has not also increased. On the other hand, import bills of industrial raw materials and spares are going up. Devaluation has given to alarming inflation hitting hard the common man.
The Jamaat leader demanded immediate withdrawal of the decision for the sake of healthy growth of economy and protecting the people from the curse of inflation.

Nat'l fish week begins July 25

The National Fish Week will begin from July 25 at the Institution of Engineers auditorium, an official press release said yesterday, reports BSS.
Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina will inaugurate the National Fish Week. She will also release fish fry and distribute prizes among the persons and organisations for their contribution in fisheries sector.
The main objective of the Fish Week is to motivate the people on fish culture and involve the unemployed youths towards fish farming to remove unemployment.

Tk 3.65 cr agri loan disbursed in Narsingdi

NARSINGDI, July 19: Sonali Bank, Narsingdi Region disbursed a total of Taka 3.65,86,000 as special agriculture loan in the six thanas of the district during 1998-99 fiscal year, reports BSS.
A Bank source said, over 4,427 farmers received the loan through 13 branches of the bank under Narsingdi region.
The loan was given out to buy seed, seedlings, fertilisers, insecticides and other agri-inputs.
Sonali Bank also recovered Taka 1.12,93,000 loan in 1998-99 from the farmers of the district, the source added.

Yusuf seeks help to fight AIDS

Health and Family Welfare Minister Salah Uddin Yusuf yesterday called upon the scientists, health researchers and donor agencies to help fight the deadly AIDS, reports BSS.
Addressing a seminar at a city hotel the Health Minister said the AIDS is major health problem in the world and Bangladesh is no exception, a press release said.
He said considering the risk involved with the fatal disease and ignorance about it, the government has already formulated a national policy to create awareness.
Presided over by the Director General of Health Prof A K M Nurul Anwar, the seminar was addressed, among others, by State Minister for Health and Family Welfare Prof M Amanullah, Health Secretary M M Reza, acting director of ICDDR,B Prof V J Mathan and Dr. Carl Jenkins of CARE Bangladesh.

IPPF meet begins today in city

A four-day meeting of South Asia Regional Council of International Planned Parenthood Federation (IPPF) begins today at Hotel Sheraton in the city, reports UNB.
Health and Family Welfare Minister Salahuddin Yusuf will inaugurate the programme while Neelima Ibrahim, President of Family Planning Association of Bangladesh (FPAB) will preside over the meeting, said a press release.
President of IPPF and delegates from FPA of India, Pakistan, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Iran, Maldives and host Bangladesh will take part in the meeting.

Two killed in accident on Dhaka-Ctg highway

MUNSHIGANJ, July 19: A businessman and his driver were killed on the spot this morning when their car skidded off the road and fell into a ditch near Hash point in Gazaria thana of the district on the Dhaka-Chittagong highway, reports BSS.

Police and witnesses said Haji Abdul Huq, 58, a businessman of Dhaka city, along with his driver Mansur Mia, 19, was going to his native village at Chandpur from Dhaka when the accident occurred.
A natural death case was filed with the Gazaria thana in this connection.
