Meanwhile, the time limit for withdrawing salaries and allowances of teachers and staffers who could not withdraw money for June 1998-May 1999 has been extended up to August 12.

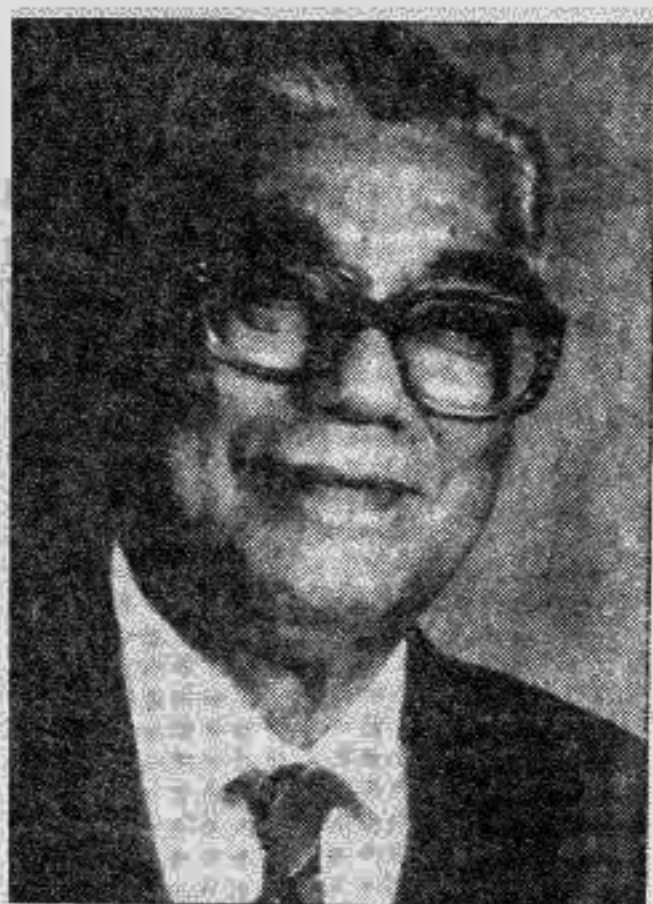
