## Thundershowers likely

Light to moderate rain or thundershowers accompanied by temporary gusty wind is likely at many places over the country with moderately heavy falls at one or two places over Chittagong, Khulna and Barisal divisions till 6 pm today, reports UNB.

Day temperature may rise by 1-3 degree Celsius over the country during the period, Met Office said.

The country's highest temperature 31.7 degree Celsius was recorded yesterday at Sylhet and the lowest 23.7 degrees at Satkhira.

The sun sets today at 6:47 pm and rises tomorrow at 5:23 am. Meanwhile, Rajshahi experienced the country's highest 73 mm rainfall during the last 24 hours till 6 am yesterday followed by Cox's Bazar 68 mm, Chittagong 49 mm, Faridpur 44 mm, Rangpur 37 mm, Sylhet 32 mm and Dhaka 28 mm.

## Proposal to increase Hajj quota to 40000

A high-level meeting of the Hajj management committee held yesterday proposed to raise the number of Hajj pilgrimages to 40 thousand under the government management for the year 2000, an official handout said, reports BSS.

Last year (1999) the Hajj quota was fixed at 35 thousand. The meeting held with State Minister for Religious Affairs Moulana Nurul Islam in the Chair decided to keep unchanged the last year's fixation of Taka one thousand six hundred as house rent for the next Hajj season.

During the last Hajj season, houses were hired for accommodation within a distance of about 800 metre from the holy Kaaba. Decision was taken to hire standard houses nearer the Kaaba this Hajj season.

The meeting also discussed the appointment of doctors, paramedics and Hajj volunteers and sending of adequate medicines for the treatment of Hajj pilgrimages.

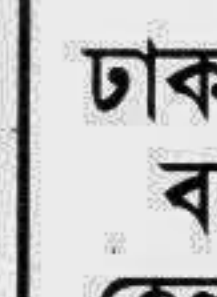
