

## Attack on procession BCU demands punishment to police personnel

Bangladesh Chhatra Union (BCU) yesterday demanded immediate arrest and exemplary punishment to those police personnel responsible for Monday's attack on a procession of the left-leaning student organisation.

The demand came from a rally organised in protest of the police action which left at least eight ECU activists injured. Police also picked up nine activists of BCU who later were released.

The BCU brought out a procession on Dhaka University campus and held a rally in front of DUCS building yesterday morning to press home their demands.

Presided over by BCU DU unit of president Nadira Sultana, the rally was also addressed by Hasan, Tarik Chowdhury Sohel, Biswajit Das and Bakhtiar Ahmed Badal.

Addressing the rally, the BCU leaders also demanded fair enquiry into the incident.

BCU will also stage demonstrations and hold rallies across the country today to protest the police action.

Meanwhile, in separate statements yesterday, Bangladesh Chhatra Federation and Pahari Chhatra Parishad condemned the attack and demanded exemplary punishment to those responsible.

## Digit with no 8 may create problem

Bangladesh Telegraph and Telephone Board (BTTB) has started modernisation, expansion and software development of the digital exchanges started with number 8 in the capital city, a BTTB press release said yesterday, reports BSS.

During the work, the digital number which begin with the digit 8 might create temporary problem for the subscribers, the release added.

After completion of the modernisation, expansion and software introduction, the six-digit number beginning with 8 will be turned into seven digits.

Water Resources Minister Abdur Razzak yesterday directed the officials of Water Development Board (WDB) to expedite the work of 'Dhaka Coordinated Flood Control Project' to complete it as early as possible, reports BSS.

He was presiding over the 7th meeting of the steering committee of the project at the Ministry's conference room, an official handout said yesterday.

Minister for Civil Aviation, Tourism, Housing and Public Works Engr. Mosharraf, Alhaj Alhaj Rashed Mosharraf, Alhaj Moqbul Hussain MP, Water Resources Secretary Dr. ATM Shamsul Huda, WDB Chairman AKM Shamsul Huq and representatives of WASA, WDB, RAJUK, Roads and Highways Division, Dhaka City Corporation and Planning Commission were present at the meeting.

The physical and financial aspects of the work so far completed in the project came up for discussion at the meeting.

Besides, emphasis was given on early solution to the problems of water logging and waste disposal in various parts of the city.

The meeting was unanimous to take up necessary steps to weed out all illegal occupants from the river Buriganga, Sayeedabad Canal and the project embankment, the handout said.

## Chinese team calls on President

President Justice Shahabuddin Ahmed yesterday stressed the need for exchanging ideas in judicial matters between Bangladesh and China to enrich the judiciary of the friendly countries, reports UNB.

He was talking to a six-member delegation of the Supreme People's Court of China who called on him at Bangabhaban in the afternoon.

Vice President of Supreme People's Court of China Shen Devong led the delegation.

Welcoming the delegation members, President said the visit will help strengthen the existing friendly relations between China and Bangladesh, which developed over the years.

President mentioned the working judicial system in Bangladesh and said efforts are being made to reform the system for providing better legal service to the people.

He said he has already met the Chief Justice and other Judges of the Supreme Court Appellate Division and had fruitful exchange of ideas on legal matters.

He apprised the President of the judicial system of China, which consists of Supreme People's Court, Local Peoples' Court and Special Peoples' Court. Devong mentioned the similarity and diversity in the judicial system of both the countries.

Chinese Ambassador in Dhaka Wang Chungui, Secretary to President Muhammad Ismail Hossain and Registrar of Bangladesh Supreme Court Marjul Huq were present on the occasion.




