Brahmanbaria incident '98

Probe body questions role of govt

The role of the ruling party during the December 1998 incidents at Brahmanbaria has been questioned by a ten-member 'independent enquiry committee' which produced its report yesterday at a press conference at the Jatiya Press Club.

Presenting the report, the convenor of the committee, Advocate Aksir M Chowdhury said during the incidents between December 7 and 8, where a function to enhance the spirit of War of Liberation was marred by agitating mullahs, the government did not know which way to go. "The govern-

ment's role, in fact was to recognise the acts of the mullahs," he alleged.

The controversial function was organised by the Trinomol Jano Shanghathan, Brahmanbaria in collaboration with the Proshikha Manobik Unnayan Sangstha.

The report named 12 Maulanas and religious leaders for having masterminded the attack on men, women and children. There is no evidence that the Maulanas or others led by Syed Mohammad Ahmed had ever organised any religious function honouring the martyrs of the Liberation War," the report said.

Although the police knew of the tense situation, they did not take measures to deploy adequate number of policemen or

BDR, the report said. The Maulanas had earlier threatened to burn down everything to stop the function.

The report said that most of the teachers in madrassahs and imams of mosques possess vague knowledge about religion. "In these circumstances the government should take legal measures to stop harassment of innocent religion loving people".

The members of the committee belong to five different organisations of Brahmanbaria which include, Jatiya Ahsan Shaya-Parishad, Brahmanbaria branch, Brahmanbaria Manobhadrak Kendra, Bangladesh Mohila Parishad District Branch, Shahitya Academy and Brahmanbaria District Lawyers' Association.

'Old age pension recognises dignity of the elderly'

State Minister for Social Welfare Dr Mozammel Hossain yesterday said that the government was implementing old age pension scheme in the country in recognition of the social dignity of elderly people.

Taka 50 crore is being allocated each year for 90 aged of every union of the country.

The minister was addressing a seminar on "International Year of the Aged 1999 and Bangladesh Perspective" held at Old Age Bhaban at Agargaon here.

President of old age philanthropic organisation Dr M A Wahed presided over the seminar while secretary general Dr Mahabubur Rahman, Secretary, Ministry of Social Welfare Dr Khanada Mohan Das, Director General Mir Shahabuddin, Dr K M Rashid and A S M Atiqur Rahman spoke on the occasion.

Prof Habibur Rahman presented the keynote paper at the seminar.

The speakers said the "Old Age Pension Scheme" is an epoch-making step of the pre-

sent government for the welfare of the distressed people of the country.

Of the total population in the country only six per cent are aged. The speakers urged the government to take a national work plan for aged people to implement the planned programme for their welfare.

The minister said the government has started setting up six rehabilitation centres at every divisional headquarters to rehabilitate the elderly people at a cost of Taka 12 crore.

Mozammel said Taka 25 crore had already been distributed among women abandoned by their husbands as lump-sum grant. Beside the government has allocated Taka 15 crore to establish a National Handicapped Foundation for the welfare of the physically disabled people of the country.

The minister advised the members of the organisation to expand their activities in rural area and assured them of all-out cooperation from the government.

Three children were injured when a cracker was exploded at Sahidnagar area under Lalbagh thana in the city yesterday.

The injured were identified as Nur Islam, 7, Salam, 8, and Anwar, 10. They were admitted to Dhaka Medical College Hospital with burn injuries.
