Flood may engulf north central dists in mid-Aug

Floods will engulf the central and northern districts of the country in mid-August if monsoon visits Bangladesh with heavy showers, experts said yesterday. A panel of experts on weather and flood which includes representatives from Bangladesh Meteorological Department (BMD), Bangladesh Space Research and Remote Sensing Organization (SPARRSO) and Flood Forecasting and Warning Centre (FFWC) of Bangladesh Water Development Board (BWDB) reviewed patterns of rainfall using weather data, charts, satellite images and regression and analogue (weather) models at Storm Warning Centre at Agargaon in the city.
