Attack on former state minister's house

A gang of unidentified miscreants yesterday attacked the residence of a former state minister and threatened death to her.

According to police, the gang of about 20 youths appeared at the Malibagh Bazar residence of Jahannara Begum, former state minister, at about 1 am yesterday and rang the calling bell.

As the former state minister refused to open the door, the gang waited there for some time. They also hurled crackers in front of the house and threatened death to her, police said.

The gang came again to the same residence at about 2 PM yesterday and rang the calling bell. This time also Jahannara Begum did not open the door. The gang hurled abuse at her and lit a fire after spraying petrol in front of the house, police added.

Later, local people rushed to the spot and extinguished the fire.

A general diary was lodged with Motijheel thana in this connection, but police failed to arrest any of the attackers.

Motijheel police, however, said that they have taken security measures in this connection and police have been deployed in front of the residence.

UNB adds: BNP vice-president Prof Jahannara Begum has denied that she had glorified the role of Col (ret) Syed Farooq Rahman, one of the accused sentenced to death for killing Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman.

"I did never say there is necessity of people like Col Farooq in the current situation of the country. Rather, I always condemn all political killings," she told UNB yesterday referring to her speech on August 2.

The denial came after unidentified people threatened Jahannara Begum over telephone and exploded bombs at her residence for her alleged
