- The Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh has decided to implement 109 MW Haripur Power Station Extension Project (Combined Cycle) within the existing Haripur Power Station premises under financing from OECF, Japan on turnkey basis against Loan No. BD-P30.
- The Bangladesh Power Development Board (BPDB) hereby invites sealed tenders from internationally reputed firms or consortium for complete design manufacturing, inspection, testing, supply, delivery of the equipment & materials to the site, installation, testing & commissioning, performance testing, guarantee and construction of related civil and building work on a turnkey work basis of the expansion of Haripur existing 3 x 33 MW Gas Turbine Power Station by 109 MW (1 x 33MW GT+2x38MW ST) combined cycle power plant at site conditions of 35°C, 1.013 bar, 98% RH including necessary auxiliaries and ancillaries within the existing Haripur 100MW Gas Turbine Power Station premises in the district of Narayanganj, Bangladesh.
- All works under the turnkey contract shall be completed within a time period of 720 days from effective date of contract.
- All main equipment shall be from internationally reputed manufacturers having at least five years of manufacturing experience with similar or higher capacity equipment in service with proven performance in overseas for at least three years under similar climatic conditions to that in Bangladesh.

He was buried at the Banani graveyard yesterday. His *namaj-e-janaza* was held at Wari Mosque after Zohr prayers.

Rahman, hailed from Shariatpur district, was elected BMA president three times. He was also a life member of the association.

His *kulhwani* will be held at his Wari residence after Asr prayers on Friday.

Body of youngman found in jheel near Ashulia bridge

Body of a youngman was found floating in the jheel water near Ashulia bridge in the afternoon yesterday.

Police and hospital sources identified the dead as Shamsul Alam, 20, son of Siddikullah, a resident of Roads and Highways Staffquarter in Mohakhali area.

The motive behind the murder could not be known immediately. Police arrested one person — identified a Fazle Babbi — as a suspect in the killing of Shamsul.

According to police and hospital sources Rubel and Awal, two local youths, called Shamsul out of his residence Friday and since then Shamsul did not return home. Following this father of the dead filed a case accusing Rubel and Awal on charges of abducting his son on Saturday.

Quoting family sources of the dead, police said, a number of boatmen of Ashulia saw Shamsul with a number of young men on a boat at the jheels on Friday. Shamsul's body was seen floating in the jheel at the north end of Ashulia bridge at about 1.45 pm.

There were injury marks at the forehead of the body, police said, adding, the body was sent to Dhaka Medical College Hospital morgue for autopsy.

Police failed to arrested Awal and Rubel till filing of this report last night.
