In a separate statement, they demanded relocation of the portrait of the Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman at the main chamber of the Jatiya Sangsad.

They also demanded investigation for punishing those who put down the portrait after August 15, 1975 violating the Constitution.


