A housewife sustained critical burn injuries as a gang of unidentified miscreants threw acid on her at Gaforgaon thana in Mymensingh district Monday night.

Hospital sources identified the injured as Shirin Akhter, a resident of Chakoa in Gaforgaon. In a critical condition she was admitted to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital yesterday.

Hospital sources said the incident took place when Shirin, who got married ten months ago, was sleeping at her house about 11 pm Monday. The gang threw acid on Shirin's body through window of her room and fled the scene.


