Missions abroad observe Nat'l Mourning Day

The National Mourning Day commemorating the 24th martyrdom anniversary of Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman was observed in Bangladesh missions across the globe with due respect and solemnity, according to messages received in Dhaka yesterday, reports BSS.

The missions in London, Rome, Kuala Lumpur, Kathmandu, Kuwait, Tokyo, Ottawa, Hanoi, Stockholm, Bahrain, Tehran, Colombo, Brussels, Moscow, Rabat, Paris, Brunei, Bangkok, Delhi, Doha, Riyadh, Nairobi, Tashkent, Canberra, Beijing, Ankara, Manama, Yangon, Bahrain, Geneva and Bangladesh Permanent Mission in the United Nations, hoisted the national flags at half-mast and put up black flags to show respect to the memory of the country's founding father who was assassinated with most of his family members on the fateful night of August 15, 1975.

All the missions observed a one-minute silence to pay homage to the Bangabandhu, who led the country's independence from Pakistani rule in 1971.

Members of the high commissions and embassies, Bangladesh nationals living in those cities gathered at the missions to pay respect to Bangabandhu and participate in a range of functions including discussion, blood donation, photo exhibition and screening of documentary films on the Bangabandhu and offering special prayers for the peace of the departed souls.

Rendering of patriotic songs and music and feeding of the destitute were the highlights of some of the missions.

Speakers at the discussion paid glowing tribute to Bangabandhu, with some reminiscing the life, career and leadership of the architect of the country's independence.

The discussants felt that all citizens of the country should devote themselves to materialise "Sonar Bangla" the dreams of Bangabandhu.

Messages of President Justice Shahabuddin Ahmed and Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina issued on the day were read out at the gatherings in observance of the day.

Zillur accuses Khaleda Zia of leading anti-liberation forces

LGRD Minister Zillur Rahman yesterday said BNP chief Begum Khaleda Zia was leading a band of anti-liberation forces to implement their blueprint to revert the country to post-1975 era, reports UNB.

"The opposition leader is out to create law-and-order situation by destabilising the country to protect the killers of Bangabandhu as well as grab state power through conspiracy," Zillur, the Awami League general secretary, said this at a discussion organised by Sonali Bank Employees Union in observance of the 24th anniversary of assassination of Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman.

Presided over by union president Aminul Haq Faruk, the meeting was also addressed by Chairman of Sonali Bank Board of Directors DR AI Aminul Islam, Managing Director Mahbubur Rahman and CBA general secretary Jamaluddin Ahmed.

Zillur said the anti-liberation forces became active again like 1971 and 1975 and engaged in variegated conspiracies in their bid to thwart execution of the verdict of Bangabandhu Murder Case.

"But the entire nation is united on the demand for immediate execution of the verdict," he said.

The ruling party leader blasted Begum Zia saying that she emerged as a fascist celebrating her "false" birthday on August 15, the National Mourning Day.

"The entire nation hates and condemns her heinous motives," said Zillur.

"When the entire nation is aggrieved at Bangabandhu's August 15, 1975 brutal killing, Khaleda Zia took on the role of a fascist in the name of celebrating pseudo birthday on the day," he told the meeting.

A lawyer challenged observance of Begum Zia's birthday on August 15 that coincides with the anniversary of assassination of Bangabandhu. On August 11, a court rejected his prayer for restraining the BNP chief from observing her birthday on August 15.

9 killed, 43 injured in road accidents

At least nine people were killed and 43 injured in road accidents in Narayanganj, Dhaka city, Fenyl and Sirajganj.

Four people, two of a family, were killed in a road accident on Dhaka-Sylhet highway at Khadun in Ruppang thana at about 12:30 pm yesterday.

The dead were identified as Beauty, 22, her brother Russel, 20, and Mahmuda, 8, of Barpa, Ruppang and unidentified autorickshaw driver, aged about 26.

Police said the accident occurred when a Sylhet bound truck from Dhaka collided with an autorickshaw coming from opposite direction.

All died on the spot. Two of the injured were rushed to Dhaka Medical College Hospital.

Our Feni Correspondent adds : Three people were killed and 25 injured in a bus accident on Dhaka-Chittagong highway yesterday.

Police said the Chittagong-bound bus from Chapainpur tumbled into a ditch at Debipur at 1 pm killing two passengers on the spot.

Another succumbed to his injuries on way to Feni Sadar Hospital. The identity of the deceased could not be known immediately.

The injured were rushed to the Sadar Hospital. The driver of the bus managed to escape.

A seven-year-old girl was killed while her two brothers and one infant sister were injured when a truck ramed five roadside shanties near Krishi Market in the city's Mohamadpur area yesterday morning.

Shahani, 7, Chadni, 1, Imran, 5, and Arman, 9, children of Mohammad Shahid — a resident of the Relief Camp on Humayun Road, were sleeping when the tragic incident took place at about 5 am.

The four children of Shahid were injured, of them Shahani fatally.

The injured four children were rushed to Suhrawardi Hospital where the attending doctors declared Shahani dead, police said.

UNB adds, one person was killed and 15 others were injured when a bus overturned at the west side of the Bangabandhu Jamuna Bridge yesterday.

The dead was identified as Towhidul Islam, 30, son of Anwar Hossain of Panchagarh district.
