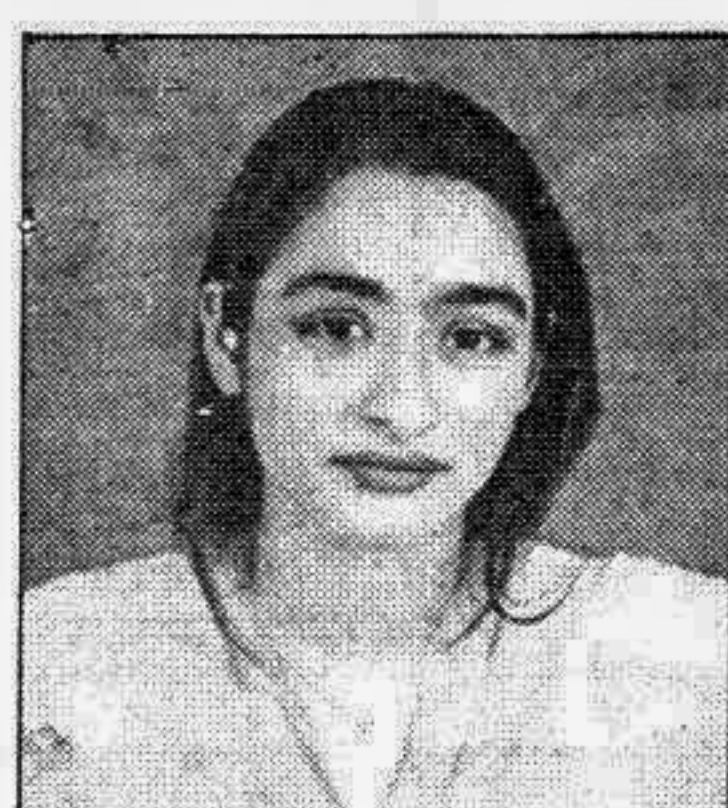

## Balaka Express reintroduced

Bangladesh Railway yesterday reintroduced Balaka Express train on Dhaka-Mymensingh route under a private management, reports UNB.

A private firm, JS Engineering Works, will operate the train's commercial activities, including ticket selling and checking, and ensure cleanliness and safety of its coaches. General Manager of Bangladesh Railway's Eastern Zone Farhad Reza opened the train service at a simple ceremony at Kamalapur Station.

Chief Traffic Manager (Eastern Zone) S A Talukder, Divisional Railway Manager of Dhaka M Rafiquzzaman and owner of the firm M Jasimuddin were present on the occasion. The Balaka Express with nine coaches, including seven second-class compartments, will leave Dhaka at 9.10 am and reach Mymensingh at 1.10 pm, and depart Mymensingh at 1.50 pm to reach Dhaka at 6.10 pm everyday.

The fare for Dhaka-Mymensingh has been fixed at Tk 30. Arrangement has also been made in the train for carrying parcels, said a BR railway press release.

As its commercial activities have been placed under private management, an additional amount of Tk 30 lakh is expected to be earned annually from this train.

## Janakantha incident BCL demands punishment

Condemning the attack, BCL also held a rally in front of the DUCSU building on the campus at noon.

Addressing the rally, BCL leaders blamed BNP and its student wing for the attack and said, "it proves their fascist characteristics."

Among others, Ajay Kar Khokan and Ashraf Al Azim Rubon addressed the rally.
