Nasim asks Opposition to return to JS

Home Minister Mohammad Nasim yesterday urged the Opposition legislators to take part in the Jatiya Sangsad debate on the transhipment issue to be held on September 6, reports BSS.

"Instead of agitating on the streets or criticising the proposed transhipment facilities to India at meetings and rallies, the Opposition should make their views clear in the Jatiya Sangsad, the focal point of national politics and appropriate forum to discuss matters of national importance," Md Nasim told a group of journalists at his Secretariat office yesterday afternoon.

He invited the Leader of the Opposition and BNP chairperson Begum Khaleda Zia and the chief of Jatiya Party HM Ershad to attend the Jatiya Sangsad to discuss the transhipment issue.

Nasim, who also holds the telecommunications portfolio, said the government has decided to discuss the issue considering its importance on its own initiative. But the Opposition is frequently alleging that the government is planning to bypass this vital issue in the parliament.

The government has established precedents of discussing all major issues of national importance in the House, he said, adding the landmark peace accord on the Chittagong Hill Tracts, historic Ganges water sharing treaty with India and issues relating to law and order were debated in the Jatiya Sangsad.

The home minister categorically said no decision or agreement on the transhipment has been made so far. The cabinet only approved a study to find out the feasibility of the transhipment proposal.

"Since this is a matter between two countries, government approval is needed to carry out the study," he said.

He said the decision to discuss the matter in the House came at the directive of the Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina.

Nasim, who has been entrusted with the task of mediating contact with the Opposition by the ruling party, said instead of making irrational statements on the transhipment issue, they should attend the Sangsad and take part in the discussion.

If they are fair enough, they should come to parliament, the symbol of people's sovereignty, and voice their logic on transhipment and other issues," he opined.

The home minister said if the Opposition finally does not return to the Sangsad, as it seems now, despite our earnest request, it could be deducted that they are doing so to avoid some kind of embarrassment.

The home minister said besides transhipment, removal of slums, rehabilitation of squatters and measures for further improvement of law and order are some of the important issues likely to be taken up in the current session of parliament.

Attack on Janakantha condemned

The home minister yesterday questioned the opposition's love for the freedom of the press after their latest attack on the Dainik Janakantha.

Talking to a group of journalists at his Secretariat office Nasim said although the Leader of the Opposition and BNP chairperson is very vocal on the press freedom, a national daily which was attacked from a procession led by Begum Zia and senior leaders of BNP only a few days back.

The government has established precedents of discussing all major issues of national importance in the House, he said, adding the landmark peace accord on the Chittagong Hill Tracts, historic Ganges water sharing treaty with India and issues relating to law and order were debated in the Jatiya Sangsad.

The home minister categorically said no decision or agreement on the transhipment has been made so far. The cabinet only approved a study to find out the feasibility of the transhipment proposal.

"Since this is a matter between two countries, government approval is needed to carry out the study," he said.
