**Muggers make away
with Tk 52,000
at Farmgate**

Muggers snatched Tk sixty
thousand in cash after stabbing
an employee of a private firm at
city's Farmgate area in the af-
ternoon yesterday.
The injured was identified as
Abu Syed, the employee of Del-
war and Brothers of Green
Road. Syed was released after
taking first aid from a local
clinic, police said.

Local people caught and beat
up one of the alleged muggers —
identified as Harun soon after
the incident and Tk eight thou-
sand in cash was recovered
from him, police added.
According to Tejoan police,
the incident took place when
Syed was walking to a nearby
bank in the area to deposit the
cash at about 2 pm.
A gang of three captioned
him wielding knives and asked
him to hand over the money to
them. The gang stabbed him on
his cheek and forcibly took
away the money.
A section of local people
chased the three as Syed cried
out for help. Harun was caught
while his accomplices managed
to flee.
The locals beat up Harun until
police arrived on the spot
and rescued him. Harun was
taken to Tejoan thana custody
after treatment at the Dhaka
Medical College Hospital.

**Port facilities to Nepal will
continue: Shahabuddin**

The visiting Foreign Minis-
ter of Nepal Dr. Ram Sharan
Mahat, made a courtesy call on
President Shahabuddin Ahmed
at Bangabhaban yesterday, re-
ports BSS.
Welcoming Dr Mahat, Presi-
dent Shahabuddin recalled the
support and sympathy of the
people of Nepal during the
Bangladesh's War of Liberation
in 1971 and mentioned that the
traditional bonds of friendship
between Bangladesh and Nepal
have been strengthened over the
years. He expressed satisfaction
over the existing good relations
and cooperation between the two
countries.
President Shahabuddin said
that Bangladesh would continue
to offer her ports and infra-
structural facilities for external
trade of Nepal. He added that
the operation of the Bangabandhu Bridge and pro-
posed construction of the Rupsa
Bridge in Khulna would offer
greater opportunity to enhance
cooperation between the two
friendly South Asian countries.
He said that Bangladesh and
Nepal may explore the possibili-
ties of cooperation in the area
of water resources. The presi-
dent appreciated Nepal's contri-
bution to the SAARC process
to ensure peace and security and
promote economic prosperity of
the member states.
Dr Mahat thanked the presi-
dent for receiving him and said
that Nepal will be benefited
through utilising the ports of
Bangladesh in her external
trade. He stressed the need for
more operational and infra-
structural facilities in this field
and said that relations between
the two countries are cordial
and friendly.
Among others, Madam
Roshana Mahat, Madhu Raman
Acharya, Ambassador of Nepal
to Bangladesh and senior offi-
cials of the president's office
and the foreign ministry were
present on the occasion.

**Over Tk 2.63 lakh looted in cash, valuables
Two robberies in Khulna**

KHULNA, Sept 5: A daring
armed robbers was committed
early this morning at the 20,
Babu Khan road residence of M
Nurul Islam, president of
Khulna City BNP and a former
member of parliament.
According to an FIR recorded
with Khulna thana, a gang of
eight masked robbers entered
the house by breaking the lock
of the gate.
They confined all the resi-
dents in a separate room and
asked them not to make any
noise.
The robbers then ransacked
all the rooms and looted a sum
of Taka 63,000 in cash, gold or-
naments worth over Taka one
lakh, a brand new two-two bore
rifle and two wrist watches
worth Tk 3,000.
On Friday last, a similar
armed robbery was committed
in the residence of Eskendarul
Islam of 22, Babu Khan road
who is a renowned business-
man. The robbers allegedly

**Hasina greeted
Robbery in Shyampur:
Tk 2.26 lakhs
worth looted**

Robbers looted Tk 2.26 lakhs
worth in cash and gold orna-
ments from a residence at Mu-
radpur in the city's Shyampur
area in the yearly hours yester-
day.
According to police a gang of
robbers entered the house of one
Sarif Ahmed at Muradpur by
breaking open the window of a
toilet at about 4 am. The gang
then tied up the couple with a
rope at gun point.
They then looted Tk 60
thousand in cash and 17.5 to-
tals of gold ornaments worth
about Tk 1.55 lakh.
A case was lodged with
Shyampur thana in this con-
nection but none was arrested
or stolen goods recovered till
last light.
President of the organisa-
tion Bahadur Bapary and Gen-
eral Secretary Ajoy Kr Khokon
in a joint statement expressed
the hope that the newly
launched association would
play a vital role in establishing
and restoring peace and stabili-
ty in different trouble-torn
countries in the region.
The BCL leaders also urged
its workers to participate in the
rally and procession, scheduled
to be held today on the Dhaka
University campus, to celebrate
the election.

**Slum dwellers'
council declare
set 10-point
demand**

The Basti Olkya Sangram
Parishad, a council of slum-
dwellers, yesterday set a ten-
point demand and announced a
13-day programme to resist the
government move to evict them.
The announcement, made at
a press conference held at the
Photo Journalists' Association
auditorium, said that the coun-
cil would hold a rally at Muk-
tangan on September 8 and be-
tween September 9 and 20 ral-
lies would be held at different
slum areas to protest the govern-
ment move.
The ten-point demand in-
clude setting up of proper and
permanent housings for the
dwellers, recovery of all lands
from civil and military offi-
cials and turning them into
housing for the poor on priority
basis. They also demanded the
removal of the Home Minister
and police officials who al-
legedly destroyed the home-
steads of the slum dwellers.
The convener of the council,
Zafar Hossain said the slum
dwellers and the poor com-
prised about 80 per cent of the
total city population but the
city's 70 per cent land and
wealth belong to less than one
per cent of the city population.

**Bus conductor
beaten up on
