bank in the area to deposit the cash at about 2 pm A gang of three confronted him wielding knives and asked him to hand over the money to them. The gang stabbed him on

his cheek and forcibly took away the money. section of local people chased the three as Syed cried out for help. Harun was caught while his accomplices managed

Over Tk 2.63 lakh looted in cash, valuables

Two robberies in Khulna

KHULNA, Sept 5: A daring armed robbers was committed early this morning at the 20, Babu Khan road residence of M Nurul Islam, president of Khulna City BNP and a former member of parliament.

According to an FIR recorded eight masked robbers entered the house by breaking the lock of the gate. They confined all the resi-

dents in a separate room and asked them not to make any

The robbers then ransacked all the rooms and looted a sum of Taka 63,000 in cash, gold ornaments worth over Taka one lakh, a brand new two-two bore rifle and two wrist watches worth Tk 3,000.

On Friday last, a similar armed robbery was committed in the residence of Eskendarul Islam of 22, Babu Khan road who is a renowned businessman. The robbers allegedly

looted money, gold ornaments, a motorcycle and other valuables worth over taka one lakh. Armed robberies have in-

creased alarmingly in the metropolitan city. According to reliable sources, 13 armed robbers were committed in differwith Khulna thana, a gang of neentrareas under south zone of KMP during last three weeks. Besides, 34 muggings were also committed during the same pe-

Some of the victims have alleged in separate press statements that the concerned OCs refused to record their complaints as regular cases on different pretexts.

BNP has strongly condemned the recent rise in robberies and muggings. Leaders of district and city units of the party have demanded arrest of robbers and recovery of all ornaments, money and other things so far looted from several houses including those of the BNP president.

Robbers looted Tk 2.26 lakhs worth in cash and gold ornaments from a residence at Muradpur in the city's Shyampur area in the yearly hours yester-

According to police a gang of robbers entered the house of one Sarif Ahmed at Muradpur by breaking open the window of a toilet at about 4 am. The gang then tied up the couple with a rope at gun point.

Slum dwellers' council declare set 10-point demand

By Staff Correspondent The Basti Oikya Sangram Parishad, a council of slumdwellers, yesterday set a tenpoint demand and announced a 13-day programme to resist the government move to evict them

The announcement, made at a press conference held at the Photo Journalists' Association auditorium, said that the council would hold a rally at Muktangan on September 8 and between September 9 and 20 rallies would be held at different slum areas to protest the government move.

The ten-point demand include setting up of proper and permanent housings for the dwellers, recovery of all lands from civil and military officials and turning them into housing for the poor on priority basis. They also demanded the removal of the Home Minister and police officials who allegedly destroyed the home-steads of the slum dwellers.

The convenor of the council, Zafar Hossain said the slum dwellers and the poor comprised about 80 per cent of the total city population but the city's 70 per cent land and wealth belong to less than one per cent of the city population.




