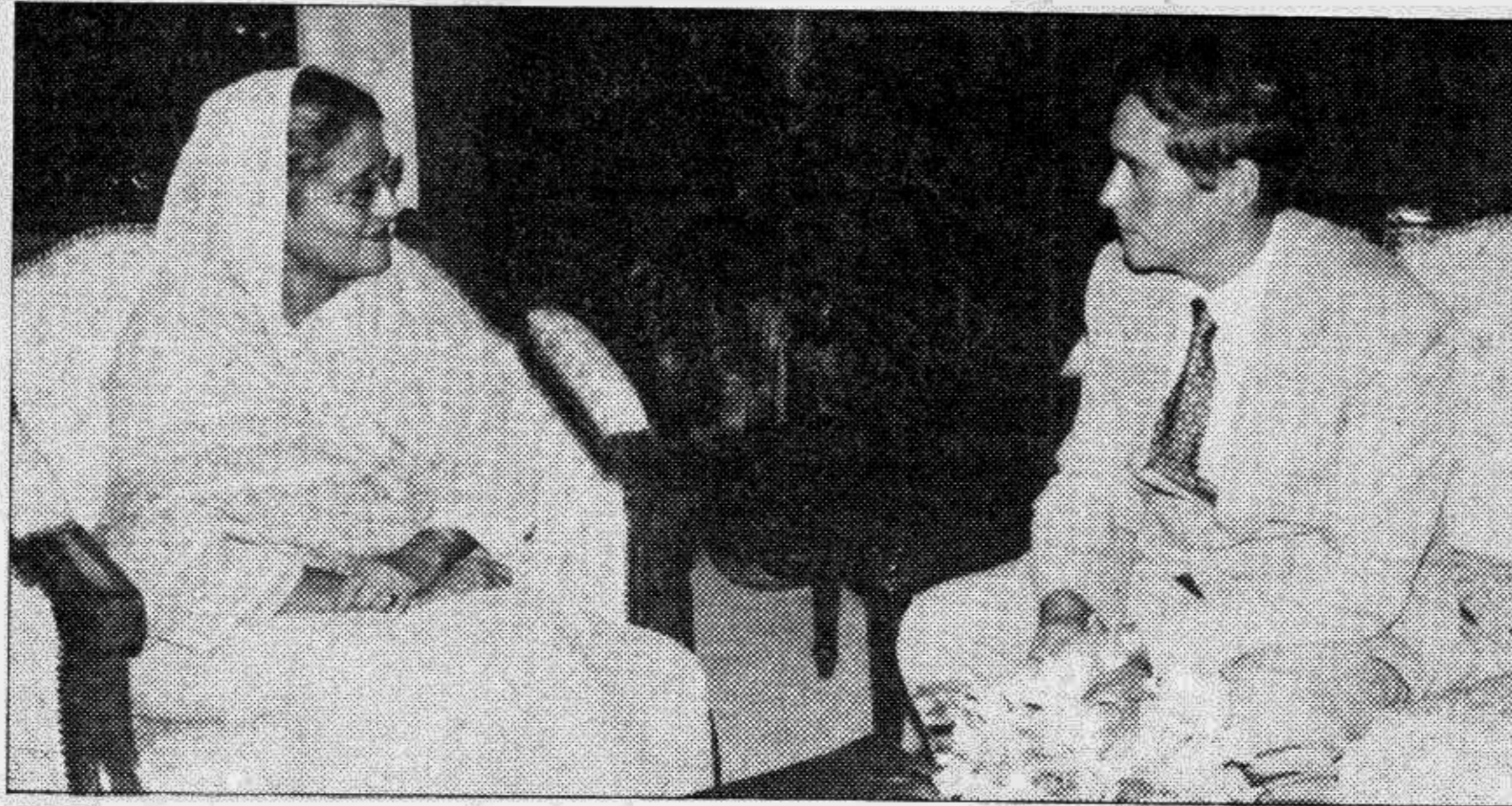

## JCD threatens to launch movement

Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) leaders yesterday announced that they will bring out a procession today in protest of Home Minister Nasim's recent remarks at the Parliament regarding High Court and to demand cancellation of the draft Public Security Act '99, which they termed a 'black act'.

JCD also threatened to launch a massive movement throughout the country to 'unseat' the government if it does not stop 'repression' on the opposition and if the arrested were not released immediately.

The leaders said this at a procession they brought out on the Dhaka University campus in protest of recent attack on Daily Janakantha office and arrest of BNP leader Anwar Zahid. They also held a rally at the *Aperajeo Bangla* on the campus at noon.

Addressing the rally JCD leaders blamed Awami League and its wing Jubo League for the attack on the Janakantha office and said, "it was a part of their blueprint of conspiracy to tarnish image of opposition to the countrymen."

Presiding over the rally JCD president Habib-un-Nabi Sohel said, "ruling Awami League is trying to curb the opposition's democratic movement by repression and arresting our leaders and activists in a undemocratic process."

They also accused the government of conspiring to sell

out the country to India in the name of transshipment and said, "we will rather die than allow India to use corridor through our country."

They also urged the student community to be united to root out 'terrorists' and 'drug traders' from different residential halls and the university campus.

They demanded immediate release of all arrested leaders and activists including BNP leader Anwar Zahid and its DU unit general secretary Mostafizul Islam Mamun.

Among others, Monjur Elahi, Mozaffar Hossain Zakir, Hasan Zakir, Tuhin, Manir Hossain, ABM Mosharaf Hossain, Sultan Salauddin Taku, Nurul Islam Khan and Asaduzzaman Asad also addressed the rally.

## CU classes likely to resume by mid-September

CHITTAGONG, Sept 8: Classes of the Chittagong University (CU) are likely to resume by mid-September.

The student organisations and the Liaison Committee through series of meetings have reached a consensus to reopen the university by September 16, chairman of the committee and Dean of the Arts Faculty Dr Imran Hossain told BSS in an interview.

The four-member Liaison Committee formed by the University to pave the way for immediate reopening of the university completed meetings with different student organisations on Tuesday.

The committee will submit its report with some recommendations to the Syndicate by next two days and the Syndicate will fix the date to reopen the university.

The Syndicate of Chittagong University was compelled to close down the classes and ask the students to vacate the dormitories on August 14 last following an untoward incident on the campus between two rival groups of a student organisation on August 13.

### INVITATION FOR PREQUALIFICATION TO BID

This invitation for prequalification to bid follows the general procurement notice for this project that appeared in the 16 August issue of *Development Business*.

SSA Bangladesh Limited intends to apply for a loan from the Infrastructure Development Company Limited (IDCOL) to develop a containerized cargo handling facility at Patenga Point near Chittagong, Bangladesh. IDCOL is a company under Government of Bangladesh created to manage an IDA credit to facilitate private sector participation in Development projects. It is intended that the proceeds of the loan will be applied to part payment for goods, works, and related services to be procured under this project, following International Competitive bidding procedures. The project will include the following components:

- Contract I: Design/build dredging, reclamation, temporary and permanent drainage, quay wall, and roadway with permanent surface.
  - Contract II: Design/build container yard pavement; storm drainage system; maintenance and repair facilities; cafeteria; warehouse; office buildings; living quarters; gas turbine power plant and electrical distribution system; potable and fire water supply; sanitary sewage treatment system; fuel storage and distribution system; voice and data communication systems; and permanent roadway surfacing.
- Build owner-designed wharf

The invitations to bid are expected to be issued in October 1999. Award of the contracts is expected to be in March 2000. The construction period is 24 months.

Specific procurement notices for contracts to be bid under the World Bank's international competitive bidding (ICB) procedures will be announced, as they become available, in *Development Business* and in local (Dhaka) newspapers.

Procurement of contracts financed by this loan will be conducted through the procedures specified in the World Bank's *Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits*, January 1995 (revised January and August 1996, September 1997, and January 1999) and is open to firms and voluntarily formed joint ventures from eligible source countries as defined in the guidelines.

The *Standard Prequalification Form for Contractors*, published by the International Federation of Consulting Engineers (FIDIC), will form the basis of the prequalification document. Interested eligible bidders will be required to demonstrate experience on a minimum of three projects of similar size, structure and complexity completed successfully within the last 10 years.
