# Law on safe blood transfusion to be enacted: Yusuf

The government is contemplating enacting a law for safe said. blood transfusion and screening with a view to controlling spread of HIV/AIDS, reports

. This was disclosed by Health and Family Welfare Minister Salahuddin Yusuf at the launching ceremony of the Bangla-German Latex Company Limited, the first-ever joint venture contraceptive manufacturing factory in Bangladesh.

Addressing the function as the chief guest, the minister described Bangladesh as a highrisk country, being surrounded by already-higher HIV/AIDS infected countries of Nepal, India, Myanmar and Thailand. "This killer disease does not respect any border and we must take protective measures with increased awareness against HIV/AIDS by ensuring all pos-

Yusuf lauded the 'noble venture' of Bangla-German contraceptive factory and said this would greatly help in lowering the size of population and also protect people from infectious disease like HIV/AIDS through its produce.

"I am sure other foreign companies will come up with their projects in this sector with the local entrepreneurs to establish condom factories in Bangladesh," he said adding that price of such produce must be competitive and qualitative keeping in view the need of the people of this country.

The function was also addressed, among others, by head of the delegation of European Community Antonio B D'suza Menezes, Managing Director of the company, Quazi Mahboob






