Signing of Int'l Criminal Court law hailed

Different human rights and social organisations yesterday congratulated the government for signing the Statute of International Criminal Court, re-ports BSS.

"We think that Bangladesh, by signing the Statute of International Criminal Court, has given support to the international law in principle," leaders of the organisations said in a joint statement yesterday.

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina signed the Statute of International Criminal Court on September 17 in New York. Earlier, she announced her decision to sign the law in the Hague in May this year.

The human rights leaders hoped that Bangladesh, as a member of International Criminal Court, would actively participate in different steps regarding the establishment of the court.

An International Criminal Court will be set up permanently after ratification of the law by at least 60 countries.

The rights activists also urged the government to ratify the law soon.



The government is going to sign an agreement with a US company to stop forgery in exporting readymade garments from the country, reports UNB.

Export Promotion Bureau and GE Information Service, Inc. will sign the Electronic Visa Information System (EVIS) agreement at the EPB office here at 11:30 am today.

Bangladesh Garment Manufacturers and Exporters Association (BGMEA) worked for the agreement that will eliminate the much-talked-about quota forgery in exporting readymade garments.

US Ambassador John C Holzman, Commerce Secretary Sayed Alamgir Farrouk Chowdhury and BGMEA President Anisur Rahman Sinha will be present at the signing ceremony.

Shantu Larma's father dead

Chitto Kishore Larma, father of Chittagong Hill Tracts Regional Council (CHTRC) Chairman Jyotirindra Bodhipriya Larma alias Shantu Larma died at Khagrachhari yesterday. He was 90, reports BSS.

Chitto Kishore breathed his last at Khagrachhari Sadar Hospital yesterday morning due to old age complications. Kishore, a social worker was also the father of former founder president of Parbatya Chittagong Jonoshanghat Samity Manobendra Narayan Larma. He left his family life and became Buddhist monk in 1969.

He left behind his only living son Shantu Larma and daughter Jyotiprava Larma, a renowned artist and a host of admirers to mourn his death.
