## PM pays tributes to Moijuddin

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina paid tribute to the late parliament member Shaheed Moijuddin on the occasion of his 15th death anniversary today, reports BSS.

In a message, the Prime Minister recalled the outstanding contribution of Shaheed Moijuddin who was companion of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman and convenor of Agartala conspiratorial case conducting committee.

The Prime Minister said terrorists killed the talented politician Moijuddin on September 27, 1984 when he was leading a peaceful procession in Kali-ganj. The death of Moijuddin unveiled the mask of state patronised terrorism of anti-liberation and conspiratorial forces.

Moijuddin was respected by all for his firm conviction and moral courage. The Prime Minister said and prayed for the departed soul. Let the ideology of Moijuddin remain ever shining in our spirit, she said.

## Postage stamp to be released

Another report adds: Bangladesh Post Office will issue a commemorative postage stamp valued Tk 2.00 denomination on Shaheed Mohammad Moizuddin today, a postal department press release said yesterday.

A first day cover valued Tk 6.00 will also be issued and a special cancellor will be used. The stamp and first day cover will be sold from all head post offices including four GPOs of Bangladesh. The commemorative postage stamp will subsequently be sold from all post offices including the Extra Departmental ones.

## Different bodies greet Hasina

Different chamber and social organisations yesterday felicitated Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina on her receiving the UNESCO's prestigious Felix Houphouet-Boigny peace prize, reports BSS.

Bangladesh Chamber of Industries (BCI) acting president A K Azad, in a statement, said the international award reflects the deep commitment for peace, political wisdom and far-sightedness of Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina. The whole nation takes pride as she received the award, he added.

The BCI leader said giving this award to the prime minister is an international recognition to permanent peace initiative in Chittagong Hill Tracts which ended two decades of insurgency in the region.

Mujib Darsan Bastabayan Parishad (MDBP) hailed the prime minister for achieving such a prestigious award for her sincere efforts to restore peace in the CHT region.

Narayanganj Chamber of Commerce and Industry, in a statement, termed the UNESCO award to Sheikh Hasina as a 'glorious' achievement for Bangladesh and said the prestigious peace prize is a recognition to the relentless peace efforts launched by the prime minister of a democratic government.

## Minister contradicts press reports

Water Resources Ministry yesterday contradicted reports published in a section of the Press that several Bangladeshi rivers were being renamed and 'indianised', reports BSS.

'No proposal for changing the name of any river is pending with the government and no such initiative has been taken either,' an official handout said.

## Encadrement of 1,362 docs under BCS health cadre underway

Encadrement of 1,362 non-cadre government doctors in BCS Health Cadre is under active consideration of the government, reports UNB.

Health and Family Welfare Minister Salah Uddin Yusuf made the announcement yesterday while addressing as chief guest a rally of the non-cadre government doctors. The Non-cadre Government Doctors Association organised the meeting at the BMA Bhaban.

The minister also told the physicians that the government planned to provide an MBBS doctor in each union health clinic across the country.

After assuming power, the present government did a lot for the development of health sector, which had not been possible during the last 21 years," he said.

Mentioning different steps taken by the government he said the government recruited 4,000 nurses, 1,500 doctors and created 3,000 new posts for doctors.

The Health Minister called upon the doctors to work with utmost sincerity in mitigating the sufferings of patients.

Presided over by convenor of the Association Dr Gulzer Hossain, the function was also addressed, among others, by secretary general of BMA Dr Mustafa Jalal Mohiuddin, joint secretary Dr Badiuzzaman Bhuiyan and Treasurer Dr Sharifuddin Ahmad.

In observance of the day, Bangladesh Shishu Academy will organise discussions and cultural functions in the city and at district and thana headquarters.

## MP's death condoled

Leaders of different organisations yesterday condoled the death of A K M Shamsul Haque, a parliamentarian from Pakundia and Hossainpur constituency of Kishoreganj, reports BSS.

In a separate message of condolence, Water Resources Minister Abdur Razzak recalled the brilliant role of Haque who also served as the political coordinator and recruiting officer in sector-3 during the war of liberation in 1971.

He said in his death the country lost a patriotic politician and a committed social worker.

The minister expressed deep sympathy for the members of the bereaved family and prayed for the eternal peace of the departed soul.

State Minister for Textiles A K M Zahangir Hossain expressed his profound shock and deep sympathy at the death of freedom fighter A K M Shamsul Haque.

Zahangir paying tributes to the parliamentarian said he served the people and society with devotion. Describing him as a very honest man of high moral values Hossain expressed his profound sympathy to the members of the bereaved family.

Meanwhile, a meeting of the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Ministry of Water Resources with committee chairman Abdul Momin in the chair also condoled the death.

Before concluding the meeting the committee observed one minute silence and offered *munajat* for the eternal peace of the departed soul.

## DU student held on charge of extortion

A student of Dhaka University was arrested from Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) in the early hours of Saturday for trying to extort money.

He was identified as Mofazzal Hossain Masud, a resident student of room no 510 of Mohsin Hall of the university.

Ranna police said Masud was arrested after he allegedly snatched a mobile telephone set from one Nurul Islam Razu who went to DMCH to see Azizur Rahman, a patient. Masud allegedly had demanded Tk 5000 from Nurul on Friday and asked him to bring the money to the hospital on following day.

Relatives of Aziz caught Masud and handed him over to police when he went to collect the money on Saturday evening, police added.

Police said that Masud was sent to jail yesterday morning. A case was filed with the thana in this connection.
