Child rights week '99 begins

Observance of Child Rights Week-1999, began throughout the country yesterday with a call to ensure the rights and privileges of all children irrespective of caste and creeds. Minister of State for Women and Children Affairs, Prof. Zinnatunnesa Talukder inaugurated the week-long programme at Osmani Memorial Hall here this morning, reports BSS.

Chairman of the Parliamentary Standing Committee on the Ministry of Women and Children Affairs, Dr. M. S. Akbar, MP, Women and Children Affairs Secretary Dr. Tahmina Hossain, UNICEF Representative Jun Kukita and child speaker Sharmin spoke on the occasion. Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina in a message, read out at the inaugural function, directed the Ministry of Education and Primary and Mass Education Divisions to draft guidelines to bring an end to brutal physical punishment to the children.

The State Minister formally released the National Plan of Action for children on the occasion. She said that the Father of the Nation, Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman had entrusted the nation with the responsibility of protecting, nursing and developing the children through enacting the children laws in 1974.

The present government, she said, has taken massive programme for the proper growth of latent talents of children. Listing the programmes, the State Minister said the government was implementing a Taka 16 crore project funded by the UNICEF for increasing awareness and increasing information and documentation.

Besides, initiative for another project involving an expenditure of Taka 23 crore has been taken to strengthen and expand the activities of the Shishu Academy, she said.

The State Minister said the government has also taken up a

Taka 11 crore project for expanding the activities of the Shishu Academy in 30 more thanas.

She said the government has also taken up a Taka 13 crore multi-sectoral project with the financial assistance of Norway to stop trafficking of children.

The UNICEF representative, Mr. Kukita complimented the government on the release of the national action plan on children and on the theme of the current year's Child Rights Week, "Violence against Domestic Child Labour" and "Corporal Punishment."

Later, the State Minister gave away prizes among the participants in different international competitions.

The Minister was presiding over a meeting of Dhaka District Relief Coordination Committee at the conference room of Deputy Commissioner's office.

Detailed discussions were held on test relief projects, VGD and special VGF programmes taken up for the maintenance of rural infrastructures in Dohar, Nawabganj, Keraniganj, Savar, Dhamrai and Tejgaon circle.

The meeting also discussed different development projects taken in these areas in the field of communication, agriculture, interest-free loan project and law an order.

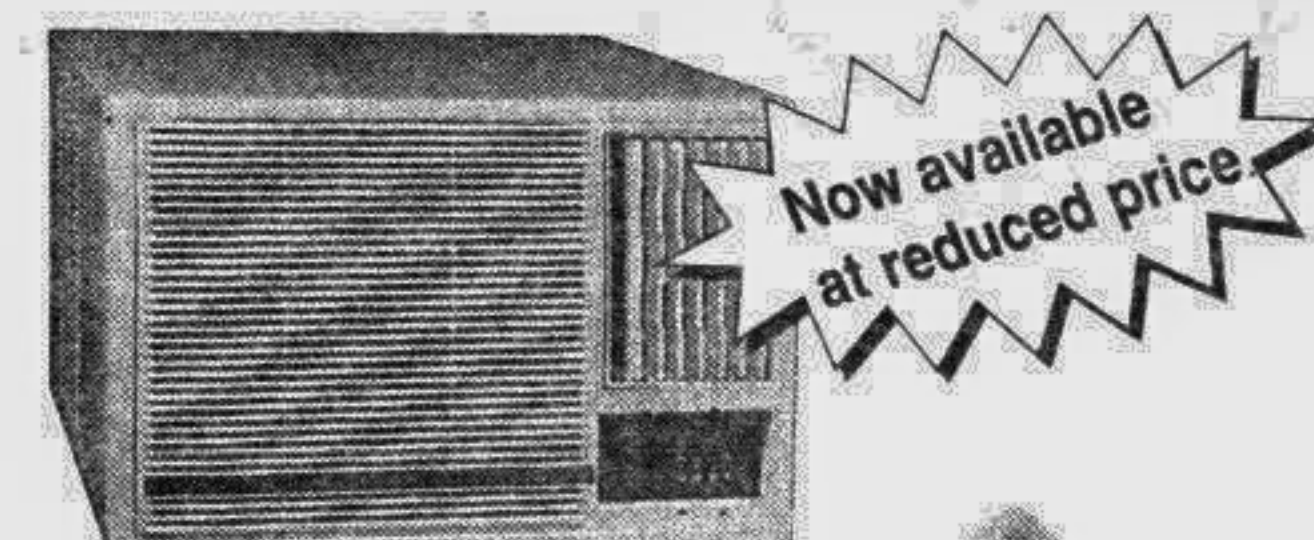
The Minister directed the concerned officials to work for speedy implementation of development projects in the areas.

He underlined the need for strengthening media campaign for creating public awareness to stop the use of polythene and making large scale use of the environment-friendly jute.

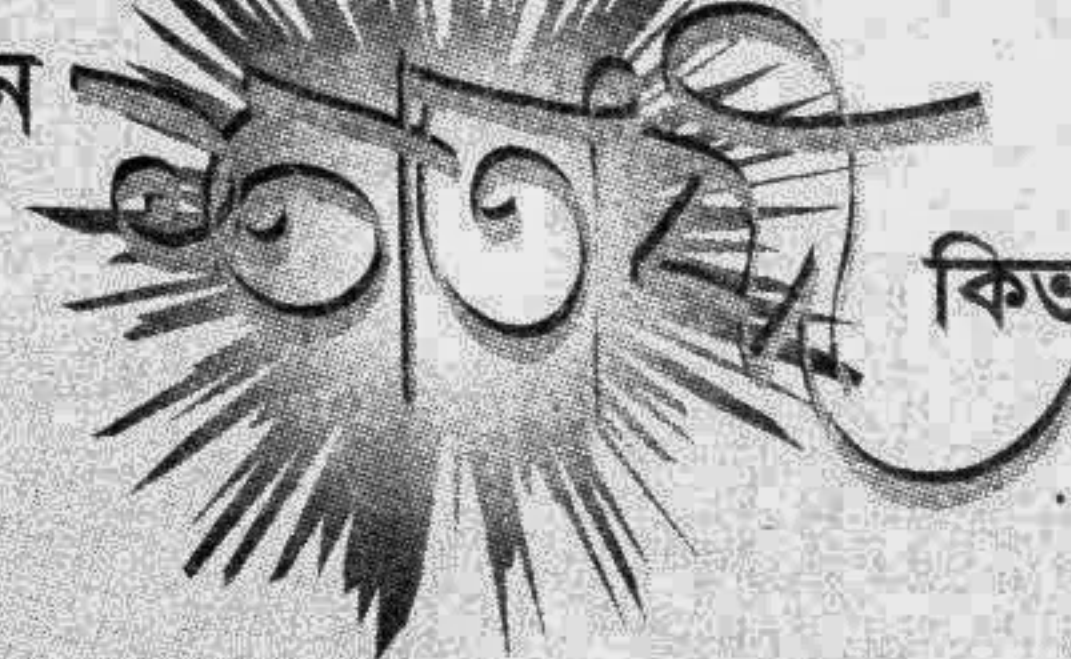

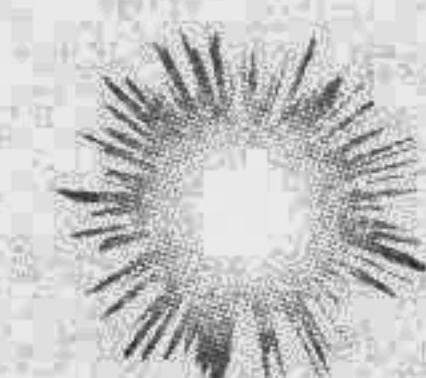

1. PROJECT COORDINATOR/Human Resources Development Expert

This Position requires:

Senior level experience in project administration preference given to those who have previously worked on gender issues and significant expertise in the areas of capacity and skill building of human resources. The post is for two-years. It is to coordinate the activities of the Policy Leadership and Advocacy Unit (PLAU) and strengthen the capacity of government counterpart staff including Joint, Deputy and Assistant Chiefs. The Project Coordinator will report to the Canadian Long-term Advisor in the Project Office.

The PLAU Project Coordinator will be responsible for:

- Program Management -providing technical and managerial inputs to ensure promotion and delivery of projects activities within and outside government; including work-plan preparation, implementation and monitoring.
- Human Resource Development -facilitating training and capacity building strategy for the MWCA along with a professional development of GOB Unit Staff.
- Personnel Management -coordinating the work of the Institutional Analyst, Policy Analyst and Communication Specialist.
- Liaison with the MWCA, GOB officials and foreign/local technical assistance projects and programs, and civil society groups.
- Project Management -assisting the Canadian Technical Assistant with the development of sub-projects under the Responsive Programming Mechanism.

Qualifications Required:-

- A Master's Degree or equivalent plus 15 to 20 years related experience.
- Extensive experience in managing and facilitating change within an institutional setting.
- Extensive experience in project management and administration.
- A solid understanding of, professional experience in and commitment to working in the field of gender equality issues in Bangladesh.

Job Period: 2 Years

2. JOINT CHIEF / Project Director:-

This position is to manage the Policy Leadership and Advocacy Unit (PLAU) working with the technical assistance of the Project Coordinator reporting directly to the Secretary MWCA. The salary is fixed by the GOB, and the position is permanent.

This Position Requires:-

12-18 years' experience in the field of development with proven ability in strategic planning and human resource management, and experience in gender with minimum Master's Degree (no third class).

The Joint Chief/Project Director will be responsible for:

- working with Program Coordinator, PLAU.
- Jointly overseeing running of the project, including coordination between MWCA and counterpart professionals; and promotion and delivery of project activities within and outside MWCA.
- management and administration of GOB counterpart funds to support project activities and assisting MWCA with the routine work related to the responsibilities and operations of the PLAU.
- analysing organizational/institutional inputs to assist in reconsideration of mandate of MWCA and reallocation of business.
- jointly developing with Coordinator HRD capacity building strategy.
- jointly overseeing strategies for promoting communication within and outside MWCA.
- jointly developing mechanisms and strategies for linkages and consultations with other GOB agencies and civil society groups and organizations.
- chairing Program Implementation Committee.
- reporting to GOB.

Qualifications Required:

- familiarity with GOB's procedures and operations.
- strategic planning within public sector with demonstrated capacity to mainstream gender equity issues into decision-making (i.e. tasks such as: identification of priority issues areas among many competing interests, allocation of staff and resources to priority issues, etc.).
- human resource management-including development of HRD structure, job descriptions.
- demonstrated experience in leadership of team with mixed technical backgrounds.
- communication skills proven.
- policy analysis capacity on gender issues.
