FM for concerted action to face global warming

Foreign Minister Abdus Samad Azad yesterday called for urgent and committed global action to face global warming which is threatening the existence of small island states, reports BSS from New

The threat of global warming and consequent sea-level rise; the ravage of natural disasters ranging from cyclone to volcanic eruptions; the contamination of fresh water resources; the rapid loss of biodiversity are some of the problems that need urgent attention and committed global action." Bangladesh Foreign Minister told the UN General Assembly

Tuesday. Azad was speaking at the 22nd special session of UNGA on review and appraisal of im-plementation of the programme of action for the sustainable development of small island states (SIS)

While proposing concerted global action for the benefit of SIS, the foreign minister expressed his concern at the reduction in the flow of aid to these states, Besides decrease in aid flow, the preferential treatment to trade of small island states is vanishing. thereby throwing their vulner-

able economies into particu-larly difficult circumstances. Azad said there had been net decline in assistance to SIS from 2.36 billion US dollars in 1994 to 1.96 billion dollars in

The Foreign Minister said that because of geographical reasons, Small Island Developing States are more predisposed to natural and other forms of disasters. Many problems that the SIDS now face, or looms ahead of them, have a global dimension. Azad pointed out.

He said no state or even group of states can deal with those problems adequately and added that in many cases the small islands are the sufferers of the adverse conditions created by unsustainable activities in which they do contribute. The Global Environmental Facility should be made more responsive to their (SIDS) needs.
