Of Rickshaw Paintings and Painters

Alliance Francaise brings the skilled hands behind rickshaw paintings to world of fine arts

An exhibition of paintings on rickshaws and Baby-taxis opened at the Alliance Francaise de Dhaka yesterday. The exhibition has been arranged in order to foster recognition of the rickshaw and baby-taxi painters as folk artists.

Obaidul Qader, State Minister for Sports, Youth and Culture inaugurated the exhibition yesterday as the chief guest.

Some 500 pieces of art by 83 artists are on display at the show. The paintings on display capture different aspects of life in our country. Some show scenes from life in the village depicting beautiful scenes from rural Bengal. These include pictures of ponds, huts, trees, crop fields and rural people at work. There are yet others that show scenes from popular movies, these seem to be the more contemporary and concentrate on

the faces and figures of actors and actresses of the cine world.

Another popular theme is different monuments of the country including such places as the Sangsab Bhaban, the National Mausoleum and important mosques. Yet another favourite with the painters is simple art in which flowers, geometrical figures and traditional art forms come to life. Paintings of animals also are prominent in many of the paintings. Mythical figures and fairy tales are another theme used by many of the painters to make their compositions unique.

The artists use bright and bold colours in their work and these make their compositions more attractive and catchy to the eye.

Alliance Francaise has made a directory of the artists whose works they have collected. At the end of the 3-week long exhibition, the paintings will be handed over to the National Museum who will put

the paintings on display at its folk art section on a permanent basis.

The current exhibition is more about the painters than the paintings. The show is part of a project undertaken by Alliance Francaise de Dhaka on ways to capture and preserve the Heritage of Bangladesh. As part of the series of programme they will hold a competition on wood-carving very soon.

The endeavour on Alliance Francaise's part to seek recognition of these artists of the country who go largely ignored and unrecognised, is a very commendable one. Life in present Dhaka is unimaginable without rickshaws and rickshaws unimaginable without the colourful illustrations on their back. Therefore if Dhaka be a city of rickshaws, then the artists putting their hard work to decorate them has to be recognised with respect — not for anything but for the value of their art.

Alka's Intimate Palette

Alka Mathur's ten-day long solo painting show opens

IT was probably Paul Klee who said, "Painting is like a child's game." The playful mood that one experiences with while looking at Alka Mathur's works that are being exhibited at Gallery 21 is an emphatic reminder of the Kleeque revelation.

lation.

Stepping into her show means one will be greeted with a rich variety of works done in mixed media, pastel and water-colour.

Watercolour is her recent passion. Alka says, "My immediate nature always vibrates in me. I have never tried water-

colour before coming to Bangladesh. The soggy and watery nature has made my work more fluid than before."

Born in Rajasthan she has grown up in the world of bright and colourful ghaghras, yellow safas, and with a keen sense of decoration. Her works joyfully portray a fantasy world — a world that has been brought to life from the pages of Rajasthani folk-tales.

Alka travels a lot. Her journeys are the journeys of a kid who is as if experiencing the world through the window of a moving train.

Alka has no intention of unveiling any concealed truth of the nature nor she is a pantheist who seeks divinity in nature. If she has anything to say it is a simple message that see-

ing is enjoying and she wants to share her enjoyment with her audience.

But did frequent travelling and staying away from home instill a sense of displacement in her? We don't know. But a few works which feature double-paintings, one small work upon a larger one, do suggest that Alka has been trying to construct a mental space with a given space. Indian poet Sudeep Sen, who writes in English, expresses this sense of displacement, beautifully thus:

"I am going home once again from another home,
escaping the wave of reality into another one."

She loves to work on small canvas primarily because she is a very intimate artist, as if she wants to talk to her audience in a one-to-one basis.



Channel i Makes Its Debut

Impress Telefilms launches country's first digital satellite channel

WITH Impress Telefilms Ltd introducing Channel i, glitz and glamour is likely to be poured to our otherwise dull entertainment palate. The first digital channel of Bangladesh promises crystal clear picture and good sound quality to tune with the time. Channel i broadcast covers almost all regions of the four continents: Asia, Africa, Australia and Europe. The expedition will begin through the satellite AP Star/2-R and will be telecast from Singapore.

The logo of the channel with green background and red circle in the middle represents our national flag. The letter 'i' in the red circle stands for the first letter of Impress Telefilms Ltd. The eye shaped logo suggests the visual media.

Animator Rammya Rahim designed the logo. He has also done other animation and special effects for the channel. The title song for the Channel i has been composed by Ayub Bacchu.

Initially Channel i will start with an 8-hour long schedule which will be repeated three times daily. In a press conference on Sept 29 it was said that the standard menu of the channel would be: drama serials, entertainment shows, documentary and educational packages, special shows on movies, talk shows, music videos, game shows, special programmes for women and children and many others. Renowned presenters like Abdulla Abu Sayed, Sayed Shamim Haq and directors Nasiruddin Yusuf, Humayun Ahmed, Saidul Anam Tutul, Emdadul Haq Milan, Abul Hayat, Humayun Faridi, Sayed Borhan Kabir, Kabari Sarwar, Ringo and many others have already made programmes for i.


The channel also expressed their hopes to present some of the big screen superstars like Razzak, Alamgir and Ditti along with regular presence of mini screen stars like Towkier Ahmed and Bipasha Hayat. Singer Runa Layla and Sabina Yasmin have already started working with i.

With Galpa Theke Neya for i writer Sayed Shamsul Haq is about to make a comeback to the visual media for the first time since 1980s. There is good news for movie buffs also, Channel i is going to screen some award-winning short-films and some rare Bengali movies which have not been aired on any channels before.

Channel i will also introduce a number of Fillers created by Ridwan Rashid Ringo. To imbibe people with patriotic ideals and sensitize them about social issues these Fillers will be screened between the programmes regularly.

We selected a very few show hosts from around five thousand young men and women — said Faridur Reza Sagar while speaking to the press at Channel i at the press conference at the Liberation War Museum on Wednesday. He also said, 'All programmes has to go on air after they are being censored'. Also present at the occasion Shaikh Seraj said, 'We had a meeting with almost all the cable operators around the country and provided them with free digital receivers so that the channel can be viewed throughout the country.'

were previewed at the occasion, which indeed proved their use of improved technology. Through the press conference they also gave the press an idea of what is about to take the mini-screen world from Oct 1. Two music videos were also shown on the occasion, one of which was by Ark, a local musical band.
