Inviting project proposals for funding

The Bangladesh Freedom Foundation is seeking funding proposals to support projects that will address concerns of fundamental freedoms of the citizens of Bangladesh. The main programmatic focus of the Foundation is on freedom from poverty, freedom from ignorance and freedom from oppression.

Priority will be given to projects aimed at coping with challenges of:

- empowerment, socio-economic entitlement, and uplift of the citizens with emphasis on disadvantaged women, youth, children and minorities;
- optimum and sustainable health services, with special emphasis on maternal and child health;
- human development and capacity building geared to self-help and entrepreneurship especially among the youth;
- good governance, accountability and transparency in various levels; and
- habitable and sustainable ecology and environment.

To qualify for funding, the projects should be innovative, and able to catalyze and strengthen civic initiatives and citizens' participation. An ideal proposal should:

- provide a brief write-up within about 1000 words describing objectives, target area & population, rationale, work plan & schedule, expected outcome and a tentative budget;
- describe how the project will involve citizens and strengthen their role;
- include follow-up ideas and methods for sustainability; and
- enclose a profile of the organization; short description of a few recent or on-going projects, if any; list of Board of Trustees/Directors, key executive & professional staff; and copy of a most recent annual report.

Only short-listed proposals will be considered for follow up consultations for funding. The closing date is November 10, 1999.

BCL condemns bomb attack in Khulna

Leaders of BCL condemned the bomb attack on praying devotees at a mosque in Khulna and demanded exemplary punishment of the persons responsible for the incident.

In a statement yesterday, BCL president Bahadur Bepari and general secretary Ajaykar Khokan also condemned the anti-tank mine plantation incident at the Janakantha Bhaban and demanded arrested and punishment of those responsible for the incident.

The BCL leaders urged the student community to be conscious about activities of opposition parties who were conspiring to create unrest in the country.

In another statement, DU unit of BCL president Sajjad Hossain and general secretary AKM Ajim also condemned the bomb attack and anti-tank mine plantation incidents and demanded exemplary punishment to the persons involved.

BCL, the student front of ruling party, will bring out a procession and hold a rally on the Dhaka University campus today to protest against the bomb in Khulna and plantation of anti-tank mine at the Janakantha Bhaban.

BCM nat'l confce begins today

The two-day 10th national council of left-leaning Bangladesh Chhatra Maitri (BCM) will begin on the Dhaka University campus today with a slogan to build up a strong resistance against terrorism, fundamentalism and colonialism in the country.

Renowned folk litterateur Bashir Al Helal will inaugurate the council at the Teacher Student Centre (TSC) auditorium in the morning.

This was disclosed at a press conference at Madhu's Canteen by Ziaul Haq Zia, central president of BCM, who said, "We are holding the council at a time when the country's educational institutions are occupied by the armed terrorists of ruling party".

He demanded that introduction of a scientific and modern education policy that will not discriminate anybody, at all the educational institutions of the country.

Reading out the written speech, Zia urged the DU authorities to disclose the identity of the 60 enlisted terrorists of the university and their exemplary punishment.

He consolidated his support to the movement of the students of Jahangirnagar University (JU) and demanded immediate reopening of JU and withdrawal of its increased admission fees.

All thana health complexes to get X-ray machines in phases

A meeting of Parliamentary Standing Committee on the Health and Family Welfare Ministry was held in the city yesterday with its Chairman Dr Kazi Abu Yusuf in the chair, reports BSS.

The meeting also discussed issues relating to improved healthcare for the rural people.

The meeting was informed that X-ray machines would be given to all thana health complexes in phases. About 283 X-ray machines have been provided for thana health complexes and another 33 new machines will be procured.

The meeting also underlined the need for strengthening ambulance service at district headquarters and thana health complexes.

Committee members including Health and Family Welfare Minister Salahuddin Yusuf, State Minister for Health and Family Welfare Prof Dr M Amanullah, Dr Dewan Mohammad Salahuddin and Dr Ziaul Huq Mollah attended the meeting.
