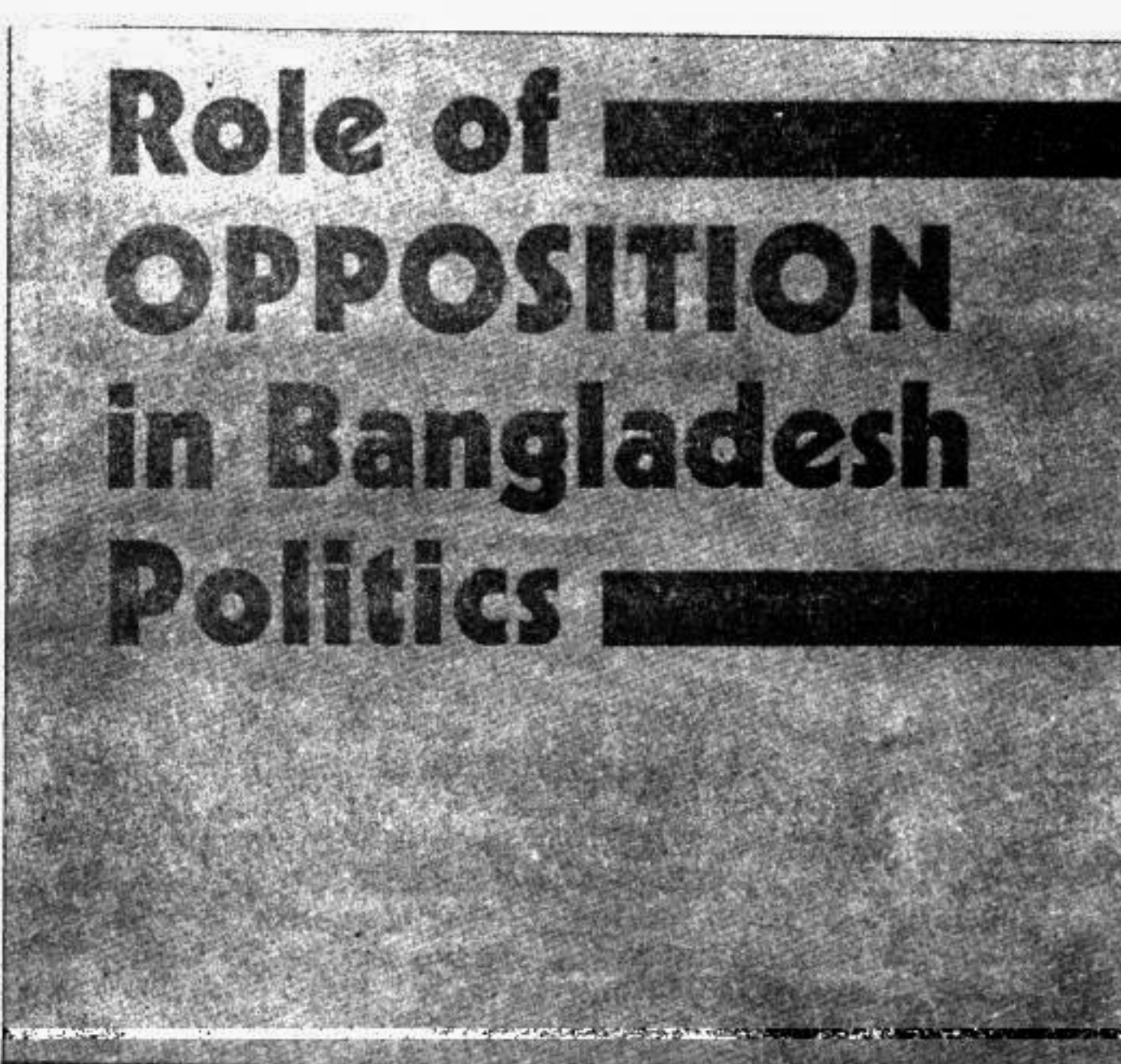
CHOICE, WELFARE AND MEASUREMENT

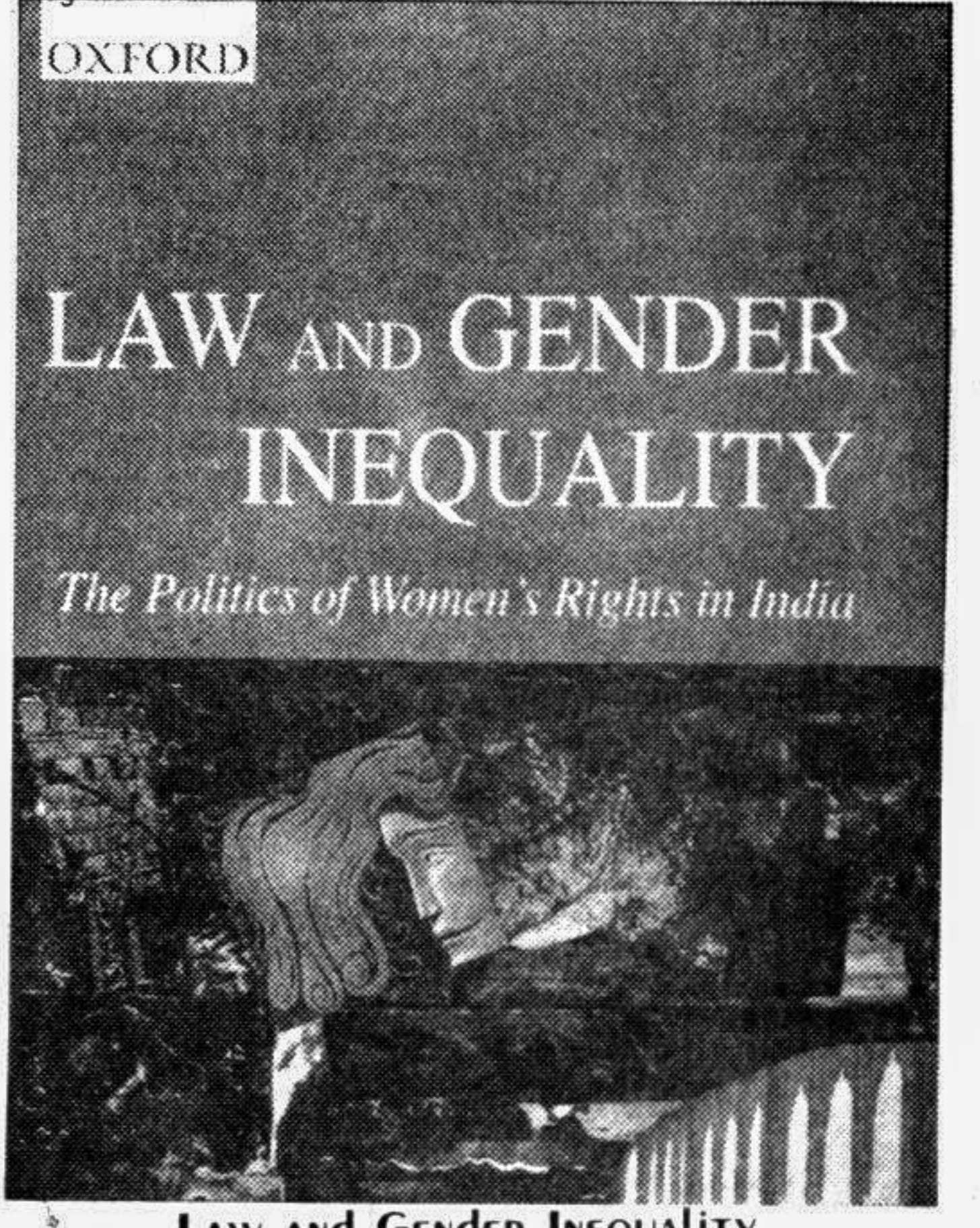
