AL govt will have to quit by Dec: BNP

Putting the country under a shutdown demanding resignation of the government, BNP yesterday said this 'failed' regime would be ousted by the people power within December, reports UNB.

Leaders of the former ruling party spoke of the timeframe for steering their one-point movement to its goal at a rally during yesterday's dawn-to-dusk hartal enforced by the BNP-led opposition alliance.

"Days are not far off... this government will have to step down by next December. So the current movement will have to be intensified," said city BNP convenor Sadek Hossain Khoka MP.

Presiding over the gathering in front of the party central office at Nayapaltan, Khoka called for raising BNP activists in every household and strengthening party front organizations to advance the movement to its logical end.

Asking the party followers not to engage in confrontation with police, the city BNP chief said their movement is not against the policemen rather against "Awami terrorists" and government.

BNP standing committee member Dr Khondokar Mosharraf Hossain MP said the people of entire Bangladesh would besiege Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina to compel her to bow out.

He said Bangladeshis living across the world raised their voice against the government. They (Bangladeshi expatriates) showed black flags to Hasina wherever she went in foreign countries.

MK Anwar MP told the gathering that the Prime Minister and the Speaker should resign for "violating" the Constitution.

The government wanted to steal two BNP lawmakers — Swapan and Alamuddin — but the attempt was foiled by the Supreme Court orders, he said referring to the disposal of floor-crossing case.

Fazlur Rahman Patal MP said this government would no longer be able to keep BNP activists in prison.

Among others who also addressed the meeting were Maj Gen (ret'd) ZA Khan, Lt Gen (ret'd) Mahbubur Rahman, Amanullah Aman MP, Nazimuddin Alam MP, Prof Shahidul Islam MP, Ehsanul Huq Milon MP and Dr Mohammad Ali MP.

Bomb attack on bus: 1 killed, 5 injured

One person was killed and at least five others injured when a number of bombs were hurled inside a bus carrying members of Tablig Jamaat near city's Kalyanpur bus stand late Wednesday night.

The dead was identified as Mukul, 26, son of Farhad, a resident of Naogaon, police and hospital sources said.

Mohammadpur police also arrested one man — identified as Shamim, 24, from near the bus stand during the hartal hours yesterday and recovered a bomb from him.

Police suspect that Shamim had been involved in the bomb attack on the bus that resulted in the death of Mukul.

Police and hospital sources said that unidentified attackers hurled bombs inside the bus, that was carrying the Tablig Jamaat members from Gabtali bus terminal area, at about 10 pm on Wednesday.

Six passengers were injured in the explosion. They were admitted to the nearby Suhrawardi Hospital. As Mukul's condition deteriorated he was shifted to Dhaka Medical College Hospital where the on duty doctors declared him dead.

A case was filed with Mohammadpur thana in this regard yesterday.

Train derailed at Fatullah, none hurt

Four compartments of a Dhaka-bound passenger train from Narayanganj were derailed near Fatullah railway station yesterday morning.

None was injured in the incident that took place at about 9:45 am, said railway officials adding that the incident was caused due to 'technical fault' and it was not related to 'hartal activities'.

Asked to explain the technical fault a source at the Bangladesh Railway Department said, "The condition of the track is not up to normal standards and needs immediate renovation".

The bogies were removed from the track and the line restored by 2:00 pm.

Officials said that a total of nine pairs of train operate along Dhaka-Narayanganj route every day. The railway authorities had earlier leased out the commercial operation of the trains along the route to private companies.

Two killed on Dhaka-Ctg highway

COMILLA, Oct 21: A speeding truck dashed a microbus from behind at Nimshar in Burichang thana on Dhaka-Chittagong highway late night Wednesday killing two people and injuring another three, reports UNB.

One of the victims was identified as Khorsed Alam. The injured were admitted to Comilla Sadar Hospital.

Police said microbus passengers Khorsed and an unidentified youth died on the spot at 2 am when the Dhaka-bound microbus from Barura fell into the roadside ditch being hit by a truck from back-side.

A case was filed with Burichang police in this connection.

JP (M-M) rallies tomorrow

Jatiya Party (M-M) will hold rallies in the capital and at district and upazila headquarters on October 23 to mark the 'Upazila Day', reports BSS.

In the capital, the JP will hold a rally at Muktangan at 3 pm on Saturday. Central leaders, Dhaka city leaders and leaders of the front organisations have been requested to attend the rally.

Additional Secretary General of the party Monirul Huq Chowdhury asked the Upazila and district leaders to hold rallies and other programmes to observe the day in their respective areas.

Future hartals will be resisted: CCC Mayor

CHITTAGONG, Oct 21: As BNP-led opposition alliance again called a daylong hartal in greater Chittagong on Sunday next, City Mayor ABM Mohiuddin Chowdhury spoke of resisting any sorts of hartal in the port city in future, reports UNB.

"In future, any kind of opposition-called hartal will be resisted. If necessary, I will take to the street," he declared from a public meeting organised by City Awami League at Laldighir Maidan yesterday.

The meeting was held amid television as BNP-led opposition alliance had also called a meeting at the same venue at the same time. Police were seen guarding the meeting venue.

Earlier, in a bid to avert trouble, police obstructed the opposition activists at various points on their to the maidan.

Three people sustained bullet wounds when unknown assailants opened fire from the eastern side of the maidan during the meeting.

Witnesses said four rounds of gunshot were fired from Jail-road just after former MP Nurul Alam Chowdhury finished his speech at 4:47 pm.

Addressing the rally, the Mayor said the Awami League government would not be removed from power by creating anarchy, terrorism and killing.

"We will help the city people keep open their shops, offices, and ply vehicles on the street," he said adding that as peoples' representative he cannot remain in mum when the opposition is pushing the country towards ruin.

Applications are invited for admission into the BBA program (session 1999-2000). Applicants are required to sit for an Admission Test which will be held at 10: A.M. on Friday, November 26, 1999.

Qualifications: A higher secondary certificate in Science, Arts, Commerce or other fields or its equivalent is the basic educational requirement. Minimum points for being eligible to apply is 5 (five) calculated on the following basis:

Certificates	1st Divn.	2nd Divn.
SSC or its equivalent	3	2
HSC or its equivalent	3	2

Students who have passed at least 5 (five) papers in G C E 'O' level and 2 (two) papers of 'A' level may also apply provided they have 5 points. Points for 'O' level and 'A' level are calculated on a 4-point scale (A=4, B=3, C=2, D=1). Method of computing points for the purpose of admission is given below:

GCE Exams.	Equivalent Divisions	
	First Division	Second Division
'O' Level	CGPA > = 3.0	1.5 < = CGPA < 3.0
'A' Level	CGPA > = 2.5	1.5 < = CGPA < 2.5

For all other foreign certificates, equivalence will be determined by the Institute.

Selection: Candidates will be selected for interview on the basis of their standing in the admission test. Final selection for admission will be made on the basis of marks obtained by the applicant in the admission test and in the interview.

A student having a minimum score of 1200 (with a minimum of 400 in verbal) in SAT may not take the BBA admission test (written) administered by the Institute. But all the students must appear for an interview as a part of the admission requirements.
