

Miners lift rail blockade in southern Poland

WARSAW: Oct 22: Threatened with police intervention, hundreds of coal miners from the Solidarity trade union ended a two-day blockade of trains Friday that was prompted by anger over layoffs and mine closures, reports AP.

Most victims in the clashes on Saparua island in the central Malukus on Wednesday and Thursday were shot by security forces, the state Antara news agency said.

Antara said the clashes had continued until early Friday. Police on the island could not be reached for comment.

Earlier the Republika daily said five people had been killed and five others injured in the violence.

Maluku police chief Colonel Bugis Saman said the security forces had moved to contain the violence, Republika said.

Maluku province, known as the spice islands, have been rocked by bloody sectarian clashes since the beginning of the year.

Peruvian troops sent to catch Shining Path leader 'dead or alive'

LIMA: Oct 22 : The UN has issued a "dead or alive" order to capture Shining Path leader "Comrade Alipio", increasing to 3,000 the number of soldiers on his trail, officials said yesterday, reports AFP.

The Defence Ministry said in the last 24 hours a specialized unit of 1,000 men was ordered to track down the leader of the Maoist guerrilla army.

On October 2 Alipio's forces ambushed soldiers, bringing down a helicopter and killing five, according to the military.

The soldiers were sent to join the manhunt at Mazamari military base, 300 kilometers (186 miles) east of Lima, on orders from Peru's President Alberto Fujimori to "wipe out the remains of terrorism" in the Andean country, officials said.

Extradition of Bin Laden ruled out

US ready to work with Taliban to end terrorist networks

WASHINGTON: Oct 22: United States, which is seeking extradition of international terrorist mastermind Osama Bin Laden from Afghanistan, has said it is prepared to work with the Taliban militia to end terrorist networks in the war-torn country, reports PTI.

We are prepared to work with the Taliban to end Afghanistan's terrorist networks, Assistant Secretary of State Karl F Inderfurth said at a bereavement subcommittee of the House International Relations Committee Wednesday.

Enumerating how US would cooperate with Taliban, Inderfurth said Washington would be willing to make arrangements at the border to take charge of Osama bin Laden to have him tried.
