Police attack on photojournalists condemned

Several organisations have condemned the police attack on photojournalists in the city's Paltan area on Friday. Leaders of some political parties yesterday visited the Bangladesh Photojournalists Association (BPA) and condemned the 'unprovoked' police attack. They also demanded exemplary punishment to those responsible for the attack, says a press release.

The leaders who met the photojournalists at the BPA auditorium included BNP's Abdul Mannan Bhuiyan, Toriqul Islam, Z A Khan, Abdullah Al Noman, Sadek Hossain Khoka and Mirza Abbas. Leaders of the Jamaat-e-Islami, Islami Oikya Jote, Jappa and DL were also present. Bangladesh Federal Union of Journalists (BFUJ) also condemned the police attack.

In a joint statement, BFUJ president Abul Kalam Azad and secretary general Akhtar Ahmed Khan and DUJ president Altaf Mahmud and general secretary Abdul Jalil Bhuiyan said the police launched the attack when the journalists were carrying out their profession duty. The leaders warned that they would launch a tough movement if the persons responsible are not punished and such brutal acts are not stopped.

The Committee to Protect Journalists (CPJ) has also expressed deep concern over the police attack on photojournalists.

Smuggled Indian blades seized in Ctg

CHITTAGONG, Oct 23: Chittagong Metropolitan Police (CMP) seized 25 cartons Indian blades worth Taka five lakh and four trucks in the city today, reports BSS.

Acting on a tip-off, a special team of Double Mooring thana searched four onion-loaded trucks at Madarbari and found the Super Max brand blades in 25 cartons concealed under the onion sacks. The blades were brought by black marketeers, police suspect.

996 arrested during combing operation

A total of 996 people were arrested and two illegal arms were seized on the 184th day of the countrywide combing operation by the Bangladesh Rifles, Police and Ansar forces, reports BSS.

The combined forces arrested 534 wanted accused from across the country, including four metropolitan areas. They also arrested 460 others on different charges during the operation.

1000 doctors to be appointed this fiscal

More than 1,000 doctors will be appointed in the current financial year. This is aimed at providing better healthcare facilities to the people of the country, reports BSS.

Health and Family Welfare Minister Salahuddin Yusuf said this while inaugurating the national conference of the employees of Bangladesh health department in the ICM auditorium yesterday.

The minister said the government is implementing a project to provide modern equipment to the hospitals across the country to facilitate modern treatment.

He said the government is working relentlessly to solve different problems of the field level health workers. "The successful implementation of the government's health programmes depends on these 76,000 health workers," he added.

He lauded the role of the field level workers during the natural disasters like floods and cyclones.

Kazi Sirajul Islam, MP, Director of Health of Dhaka division, Dr Kazi Syed Ahmed, among others, spoke on the occasion with Mohammad Anwar Hossain in the chair.

DU incidents on Oct 13, 14: Probe body formed

A 10-member inquiry committee has been formed to identify those responsible for 'unwarranted incidents' on Dhaka University campus on October 13 and 14, a DU press release said yesterday, reports UNB. More than two dozen students were injured as opposition-backed student organisations clashed with police and pro-Awami League Chhatra League during student's strike in the University on the two days.

Formed with DU syndicate member Mohammad Ali as convenor and proctor Dr A K M Nurunnabi as member secretary, the committee will also make recommendations for taking punitive measures against those responsible. Other members of the committee are Prof Abdul Momin Chowdhury, Prof R I M Aminur Rashid, Prof A F M Yusuf Haider and Adv A F M Mesbahuddin and deans of Social Science faculty Prof M Asaduzzaman and of Business Studies faculty Prof Abul Hashem and DU registrar Muhammad Selim and controller of examination Shah M Habibur Rahman.

Those who are aware of the incidents of the two days have been requested to submit written information to the member secretary of the committee or DU registrar by October 30.
