State Minister for Youth, Sports and Cultural Affairs Obaidul Quader is expected to attend the discussion as the chief guest while Chairman of Bangla Academy Prof Anisuzzaman will be the special guest.

Abdul Mannan Syed will present the key-note paper and poet Belal Chowdhury will deliver the address of welcome.

## FPAB Award in Journalism introduced

The Family Planning Association of Bangladesh (FPAB) has introduced 'FPAB Award in Journalism', reports UNB.

The award will be given for investigative report, feature and general reporting on population, family planning, procreation, mother and child health care and empowerment of women published in local or national dailies or weeklies.

The report may be in both Bangla and English languages. The competitor must be a Bangladeshi citizen and their reports need to have been published between July 1, 1998 to June 30, 1999.

Interested journalists have been requested to send five copies of their reports along with publication date, name of newspaper, two copies passport size photograph and brief resume to Senior Programme Officer, FPAB, 2 Naya Paltan by Nov 20.

A panel of jury will select the candidate for the award and its decision will be final, said a press release.

## Govt to introduce fish bank soon, says Rab

Fisheries Minister A S M Abdur Rab yesterday said the government would soon introduce fisheries village, fish bank and insurance for the welfare of fishermen, reports BSS.

"We will introduce the facilities soon to promote fish production and marketing giving priorities to the real fishermen," an official press release quoted him as saying while opening a two-day workshop on water resources management at the IDB Bhaban here.

He added that there was no alternative to increase fish production in open and closed water bodies if "we want to ensure the desired growth rate to eight per cent in the sector" under private and combined initiatives on participatory basis.

State Minister for Land Rashed Mosharraf also spoke at the function organised by Fisheries Department, International Centre for Living Aquatic Resources Management and Ford Foundation.

The minister said the regulations against using "draft nets" would be strictly enforced to prevent destruction of fish fry and egg carrying fishes.

## 'Steps taken to repair underground telephone cables'

Steps have been taken for repair on emergency basis the underground cables to restore the telephone lines, reports UNB.

A press release of the T&T Board yesterday said some 250 telephones went out of order in RK Mission Road, Maniknagar and Motijheel commercial areas due to faults in underground cables.

Another 135 telephones have gone out of order in Banani Bazaar and adjacent areas due to partial fault in cables. Regretting inconvenience to the subscribers, the Board hoped that the telephones would be restored soon after necessary repair work.

## JS body reviews curriculum of 11 agriculture institutes

The Parliamentary Standing Committee on Agriculture Ministry meeting yesterday stressed on coordinated arrangement for improvement and expansion of agriculture education, reports UNB.

The committee reviewed curriculum of 11 agriculture institutes of the country, including Bangladesh Agriculture Institute, Patuakhali Agriculture College and Hajee Mohammad Danesh Agriculture College, in turning out skilled manpower with knowledge of modern methods, for development of agriculture.

Presided over by Dr T I M Fazle Rabbi, the meeting was attended by Food and Agriculture Minister Begum Matia Chowdhury, M Anisul Chowdhury, M Emdadul Huq, Abul Kalam Azad Siddiqui and Ahaj M Abdul Wahab.

They discussed and exchanged views on different aspects of Chittagong Hill Tracts including its development issues, said an official handout.

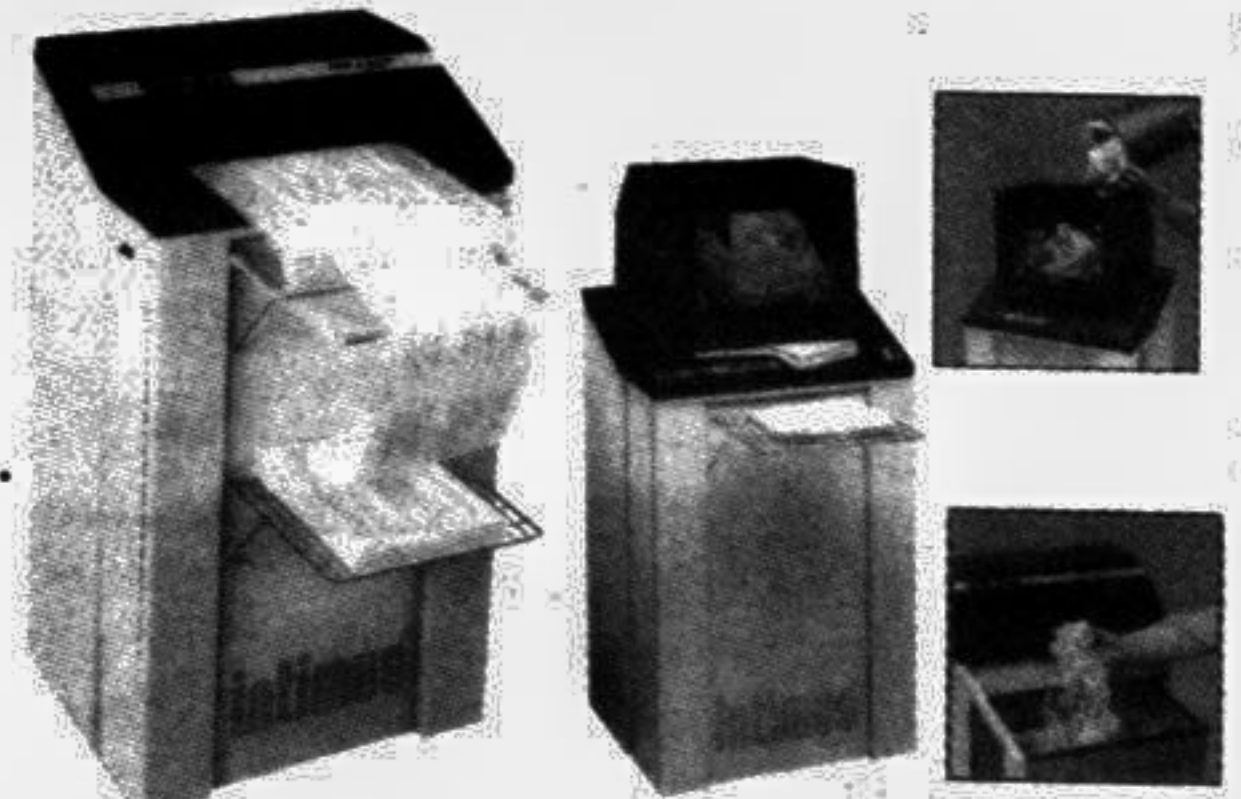

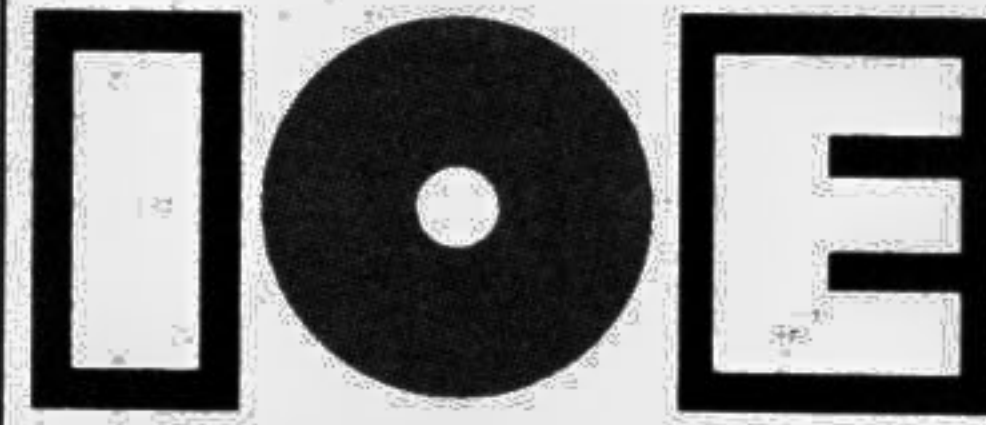

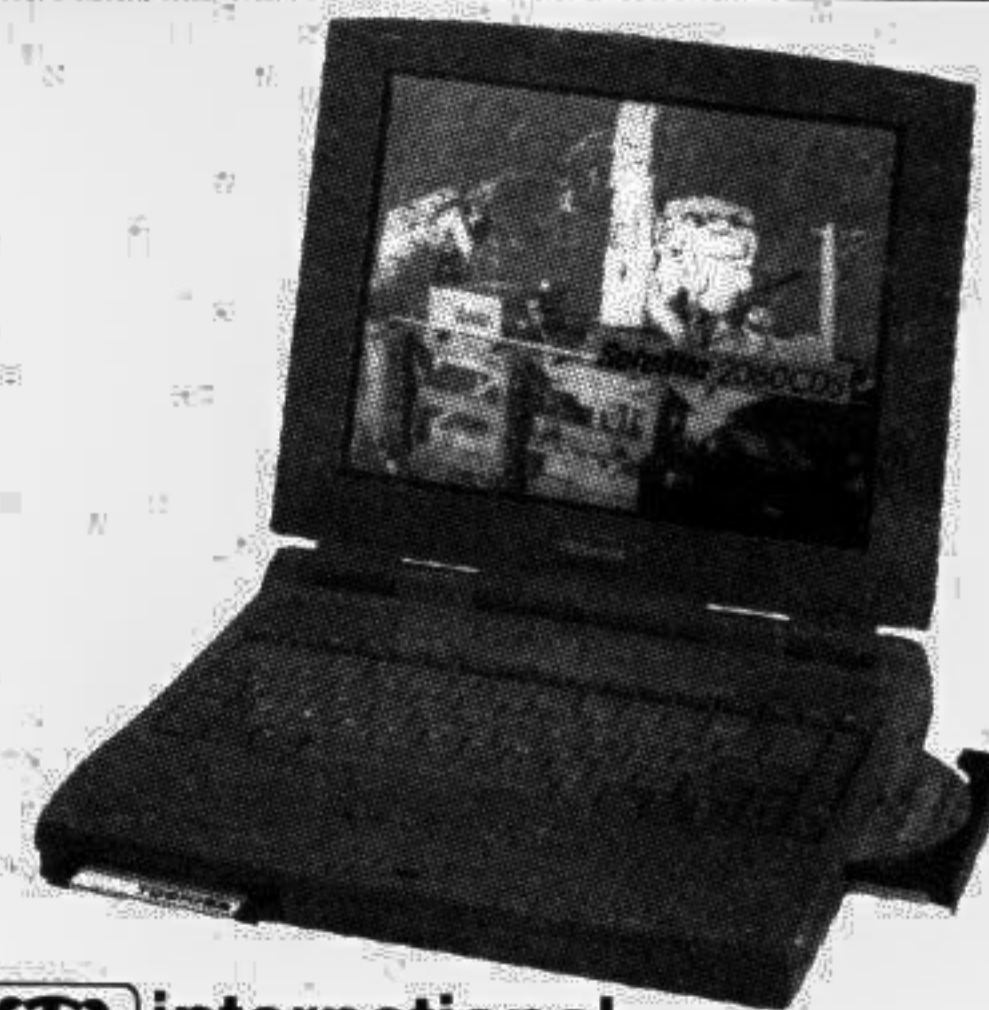
