Applications in prescribed form are hereby invited from the bonafide citizens of Bangladesh desiring to participate in the Admission Test for admission in the Under-graduate courses of this University for the session 1999-2000. Candidates who have passed H.S.C examination or its equivalent in 1998 and 1999 are eligible to apply, subject to fulfilment of other conditions.

### IN THE FACULTIES OF ENGINEERING, CIVIL ENGINEERING, MECHANICAL ENGINEERING, ELECTRICAL AND ELECTRONIC ENGINEERING, AND ARCHITECTURE AND PLANNING

#### ELIGIBILITY FOR SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FOR THE ADMISSION TEST

- Candidates must have passed SSC/Dakhl examination of any Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education/Madrasa Education Board of Bangladesh or its equivalent examination from any foreign education board and obtained at least 50% marks on the average or equivalent grades.
- Candidates must have passed HSC/Alim examination of any Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education/Madrasa Education Board of Bangladesh and obtained at least 60% marks on the average in the subjects of Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry, and minimum of 50% marks in each of these three subjects separately, or its equivalent examination from any foreign education board and obtained at least equivalent grades in the above mentioned subjects.
- A merit list on the basis of the marks of Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry only of the HSC/Alim examination or the equivalent grades in these subjects will be prepared out of which only the first 4500 (four thousand and five hundred) candidates will be allowed to take part in the Admission Test. All candidates securing the 4500th (four thousand five hundredth) position having equal marks, will also be allowed to take part in the Admission Test. Moreover, all tribal candidates having minimum requirements and candidates from foreign education boards who obtained at least equivalent grade are eligible for the Admission Test.

#### SUBJECTS OF ADMISSION TEST FOR 4-YEAR COURSE IN ENGINEERING DEPARTMENTS AND URBAN & REGIONAL PLANNING DEPARTMENT, AND 5-YEAR COURSE IN ARCHITECTURE DEPARTMENT

The Admission Test shall be based on the course curricula of Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and English (Functional including Comprehension) of the Boards of Intermediate and Secondary Education of Bangladesh for the year 1999. In addition, candidates seeking admission for Architecture Department will have to appear in the Free-hand Drawing Test.

There will be one Admission Test for different departments under the five faculties in the following two groups "Ka" and "Kha".

Group "Ka" Engineering Departments and Urban & Regional Planning Department

Group "Kha" Architecture Department

Admission Test under each group will be of a total of 600 marks. Subjects and subject-wise distribution of marks are given in the table below:

Candidates seeking admission in both the groups "Ka" and "Kha", shall sit for examination in all the subjects [Module A - Chemistry, Module B - Mathematics, Physics and English (Functional including Comprehension) and Module C - Free-hand Drawing].

#### NUMBER OF SEATS

The total number of seats in B.Sc. Engineering, Bachelor of Urban & Regional Planning and B. Arch courses under the five faculties is 725, of which 3 (three) seats in Engineering and 1 (one) seat in Architecture are reserved for the candidates from Chittagong Hill Tracts and other tribal areas of Bangladesh.

#### FOR ALL FACULTIES

Candidates from tribal areas must submit certificates from the Principal of the college from which they passed HSC examination and the Chairman of local Pourashava/Zilla Parishad or Union Parishad and tribal chief, and must indicate in the Application Form that they belong to a tribe. Candidates for these reserved seats must also fulfil the minimum qualification requirements for the Test. There will be no separate Admission Test for the reserved seats of tribal candidates.

#### PROCEDURE FOR SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS (FOR ALL FACULTIES)

Application Form and Prospectus mentioning Admission Test procedure for each group may be obtained directly from the Registrar's office on payment of the required amount in cash mentioned below or by sending Pay Order/Bank Draft of the required amount in favour of Bangladesh University of Engineering & Technology (drawn on Sonali Bank in any branch in Dhaka city) along with a 255 x 115 mm (10 x 4 1/4 inch) SELF-ADDRESSED envelope bearing postage stamp of Tk. 10/- (Taka Ten) only.

## BFUJ, DUJ to hold protest rally today

Bangladesh Federal Union of Journalists (BFUJ) and Dhaka Union of Journalists (DUJ) will hold a rally at 11 am today to protest the recent police attack on photojournalists.

The decision in this regard was taken at a joint meeting of the BFUJ and DUJ.

Chaired by BFUJ president Amanullah Kabir, the meeting condemned the Friday's police attack and demanded exemplary punishment of those responsible for the incident.

The protest rally will be held at the office of the Bangladesh Photojournalists' Association in the city.

A procession will be brought out after the rally.

The meeting also expressed concern over the recent attack on the Barisal Press Club by the miscreants.

Meanwhile, all members of Bangladesh Photojournalists' Association (BPJA) will wear black badges for 12 hours today throughout the country to protest the police attack on them, said a press release yesterday.

## Prof Nuruddin country chief of AMIC

Prof QAIM Nuruddin of the Department of Mass Communication and Journalism of Dhaka University has been appointed Country Representative of the Asian Media Information and Communication Centre, reports UNB.

A non-governmental professional organization based in Singapore, AMIC is a major communication-resource centre devoted to promoting effective media practices through sharing practical skills and expertise for fostering socio-economic development in the Asia-Pacific region.

It has a network of country representatives throughout the region who help AMIC in identifying and specifying communication needs of the member states, both on theoretical and practical levels, and coordinate its activities in their respective countries.

Prof Nuruddin is the senior-most teacher in journalism faculty in the country and has been involved with communication education since 1962.

He was a Scholar-in-Residence at the Southern Illinois University of Carbondale, USA, under Fulbright programme.

## Tributes paid to Dr Ibrahim

Justice Muhammad Habibur Rahman, former chief advisor of the caretaker government, yesterday said at least 1.2 billion people across the world are yet to get modern treatment facilities amid all wonders of modern science and revolution in the health sector, reports BSS.

Quoting a report of Medicines Sans Frontiers (Doctors without Borders), he said that out of 1,223 compound medicines produced during 1975 to 1997, only 11 items were earmarked for tropical diseases.

Justice Rahman was delivering his memorial lecture on Dr Muhammad Ibrahim, hosted by BIRDEM Officers' Club to mark the 10th death anniversary of Professor Muhammad Ibrahim in the BIRDEM auditorium here. President of BIRDEM Officers' club Dr A K Mia presided over the session.

Speaker Humayun Rasheed Chowdhury, Dr A K Azad Khan, Dr CM Delwar Rana and general secretary of the club Mrs Maksud Selim, among others, attended the lecture.

Paying rich tribute to Dr Muhammad Ibrahim, Justice Habibur Rahman said, the doctors of the country should replicate the works of the great physician who contributed enormously to the field of medical education, service to the poor and medical administration.
