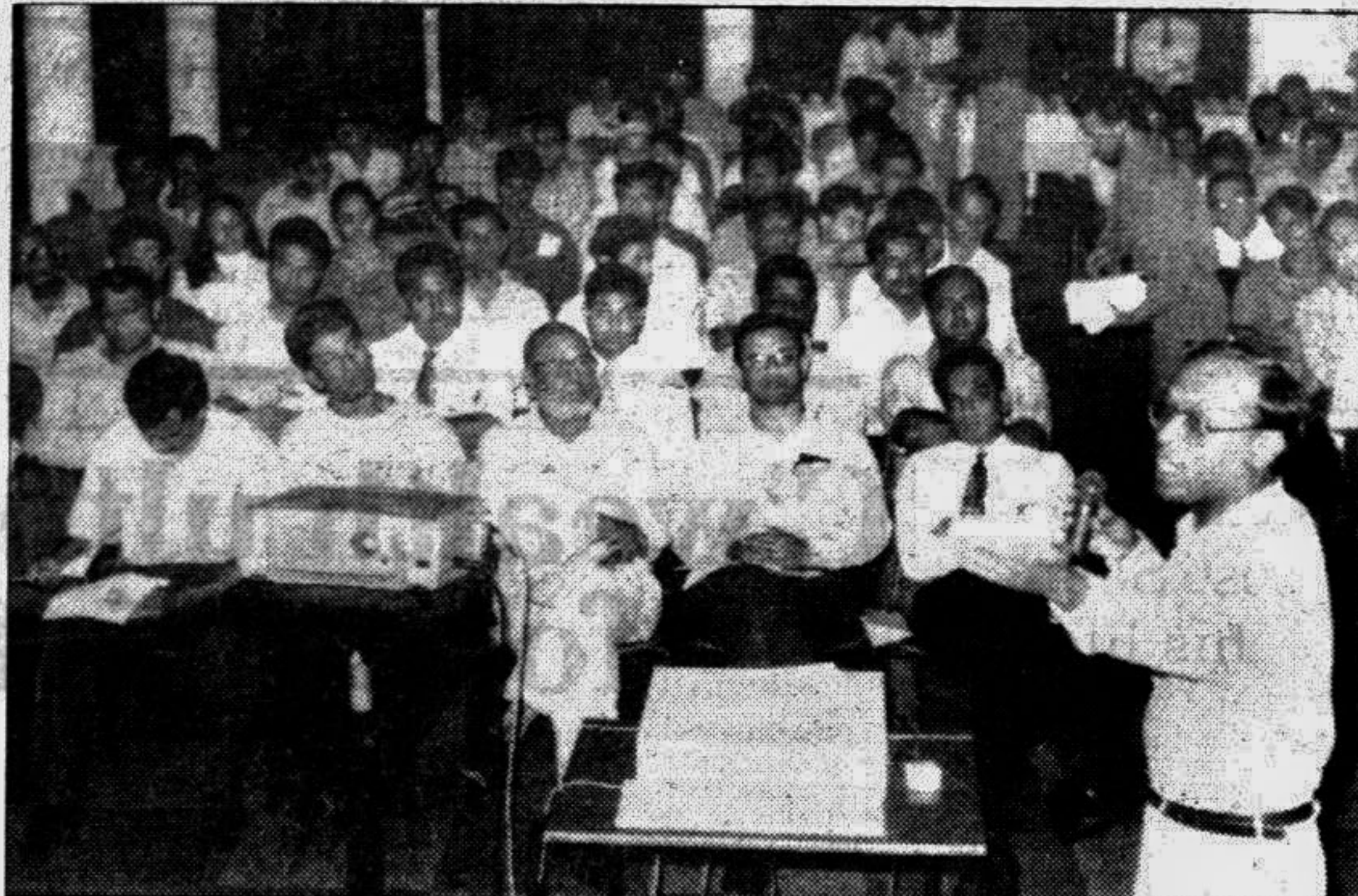

Obituary

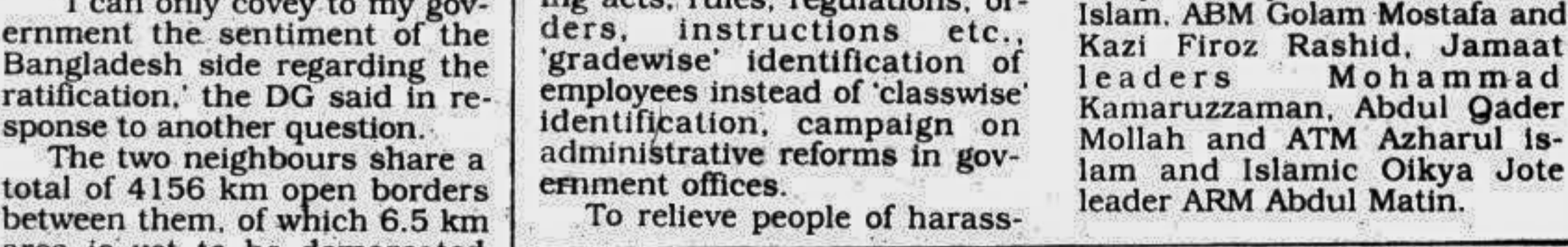

Later his body was sent to his village home in Ramganj in Sonargaon thana of Narayanganj district for funeral. Siddiqui also alleged that the DC violated rules in distributing symbols among Jatiya Party candidates also. "There is no controversy over the fact that plough is the election symbol of the JP," Siddiqui said. "Since there was two candidates from two factions of the JP, he has to allocate plough to any of the two candidates he thinks deserving. But he did not have any scope to deprive both the JP candidates of the symbol."
