Trial of war criminals demanded

Speakers at a seminar Wednesday reiterated the demand for trial of war criminals of 1971 and urged all not to give any more leverage to the fundamentalists who had collaborated with Pakistan occupation forces, reports BSS.

Journalist-writer Shahriar Kabir presented the keynote paper at the seminar organised by the War of Liberation and Bangladesh Research Institute of Jatiya Biswabidyalaya. Prof Muntasir Mamoon and Prof Salahuddin discussed the keynote paper. National Professor Kabir Chowdhury presided.

In his keynote paper, 'Genocide and Rape in 1971: Contemporary Document Based on Some Rare Findings and Documents on the War of Liberation', Shahriar Kabir said, 'It is unfortunate that the nation has to demand trial of the war criminals after long 28 years.'

'Political leaders can avoid, prolong or some of them can even wage a movement to stem the holding of the trial of war criminals on different excuses, but the people who had lost their near and dear ones in the war would never forgive the criminals,' he said.

Prof Salahuddin Ahmed said the collaborators and killers of 1971 are strong and united as no government could take any measure for their trial. Even no government has asked Pakistan for an apology for the crimes in 1971, he said.

Prof Muntasir Mamoon said only the heroic victory was acclaimed in the recorded history of the War of Liberation, but the trauma of thousand of torture victims has not been properly mirrored in many documents. He said the fundamentalist forces are thriving on the lacunae of history. This institute will do the necessary to plug the gap, he added.

Prof Kabir Chowdhury said the institute was set up to add voice to the demand for the trial of war criminals of 1971.

Nasim seeks Thai help in curbing arms smuggling, drug trafficking

Home and Post and Telecommunications Minister Mohammad Nasim sought co-operation from Thailand in combating the drug trafficking and arms smuggling problems in Bangladesh, reports UNB.

There has been a growing problem of drug trafficking and illegal arms smuggling in Bangladesh, he said during a meeting with Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Interior of Thailand Maj Gen Sanan Kajornprasart in Bangkok on Wednesday.

According to a message received in the city, Nasim also requested the Thai government to arrange a training programme for Bangladesh police personnel in Thailand.

Recalling the excellent bilateral relations between the two countries, Nasim expressed deep appreciation and gratitude for the signing of the Extradition Treaty between the two countries.

The Thai minister said there were some minor issues that could be resolved in spirit of co-operation and said that immigrants from Bangladesh sometimes entered Thailand illegally on their way to Malaysia and their capture and detention at the border points sometimes creates problem for Thailand.

Thailand would always co-operate in this matter with Bangladesh for early resolution of the problem, he mentioned.

Regarding the Bangladesh minister's request to look into the proposed agreement on exemption of visa for diplomatic and official passports for early consideration, the Thai minister said he would coordinate with the authorities in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs for expediting the same.

Nasim also met Minister for Transport and Communication of Thailand Suthep Thaugsuban. During the meeting the two ministers ex-

changed views on matters relating to co-operation in the telecommunications sector between Bangladesh and Thailand.

The minister invited Thai entrepreneurs to invest in the telecommunications sector in Bangladesh and informed him of the liberal investment policies of the government. The Thai minister also expressed keen interest for further co-operation in the sector and assured him of all-out assistance in this regard.

The minister was accompanied by Nazmul Ahsan Chowdhury, Secretary, Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications.
