Clinton waives sanctions on US bank lending to India

NEW DELHI, Oct 30: Indian Finance Minister Yashwant Sinha said yesterday that he was happy good sense had prevailed, and most of the sanctions imposed by the United States for the country's nuclear tests had been waived, reports Reuters.

President Bill Clinton on Wednesday waived economic sanctions on India allowing US commercial bank lending to continue, and loans by the Export-Import Bank.

"We are happy good sense has prevailed upon them and they have decided to waive most of the sanctions," Sinha told lawmakers in the lower house of parliament.

Toyota to make passenger cars in China

TOKYO, Oct 30: Toyota Motor Corp plans to set up a joint venture with a state-run company in China to begin passenger car production there. The Nihon Kaizai Shimbun reported Saturday, says AP.

Under a production proposal by Toyota and China's Staterun Tianjin Automotive Industrial (Group) Co. Japan's top automaker will first transfer its technology for subcompact cars to the Chinese company, the reports said.

Joint production would begin later, the financial daily said, adding that the Chinese government could approve the plan as early as this year and Tianjin Automotive could begin using Toyota's technology next

Tianjin Automotive will likely produce subcompacts based on the platform used for Toyota's 1-litre Vitz. The Chinese company is expected to roll out 100,000-150,000 vehicles annually, the report said.

If subcompact production at Tianjin Automotive goes smoothly, the two firms will set up a 50-50 venture, building production lines in plants provided by the Chinese firm. The joint venture contract will run for 30 years.

Floods reduce Mexican oil production

VILLAHERMOSA, Mexico, Oct 30: Devastating floods in the southeastern Gulf state of Tabasco have forced Mexico's. state-owned oil monopoly to suspend production in two oil fields, resulting in the loss of 30,000 barrels, or \$ 600,000 worth of oil each day for the past eight days, reports AP.
The floods, which have

prompted the evacuation of thousands of residents and threatened to inundate the state capital of Villahermosa, af fected production at nine wells in the Samaria and Caparroso oil fields of Petroleos Mexicanos, or Pemex, Carlos Morales Gil, assistant manager of Pemex Exploration and Production, said Friday.

Gold goes down amid weaker demand, silver shines

LONDON, Oct 30: Gold prices slipped again this week, falling back through the 300 dollars an ounce threshold in volatile technical trading amid weaker demand, particularly, in Asia,

says AFP. An ounce of the precious metal was fetching 298.25 dollars on Friday afternoon on the London Bullion Market, down from 303.75 dollars last week, but up from a midweek low point of 290 dollars.

"It's still very much the backwarding and forwarding that we observed in recent weeks," said Paribas analyst Michael Coulson referring to the unravelling of hedged positions that has created turbulence on the gold market. "The market is still very volatile."

Most analysts nonetheless remain optimistic and believe that the gold price will remain firm in coming weeks. The gold market has been

Local Market

Last week, the local foreign exchange market was active and the demand for dollar was steady. Although dollar demand has risen a little, it is not very significant.

The market was still long in dollar because of inward remittances sent by the overseas Bangladeshis and donor agencies. As a result, in the interbank market last week dollar traded in a range of BDT 49.480 to BDT 49.500. Cash US dollar traded in the higher range of BDT 51.600 and BDT 51.80.

The demand for call money was steady and the rate fluctuated between 6.0 to 7.0 per cent during the week. Bangladesh Bank accepted Treasury Bills worth of BDT 6900 million of which BDT 6345 million for 28 days at an average rate of 6.74 per cent, BDT 5 million for 91 days at 7.00 per cent, BDT 260 million for 182 days at 7.81 per cent, BDT 230 million for 364 days at 8.15 per cent and BDT 60 million at an average of 8.89 per cent for 2 years. **International Market**

In the international markets, euro clawed 1/3 cents on Monday from its lowest levels in nearly two weeks, hit at the end of the week before last. The traders squared their positions, but analysts said that the European currency had to remain solidly above \$ 1.06 level to prove that a firming trend is in

Meanwhile, dollar was traded in tight ranges against yen at the 105-yen level. In the beginning of the week in absence of any major macro economic data, the market was concentrating on technical levels to assess the outlook of the US currency against yen. In other places, euro had leaped to its peak of nearly onemonth high against the Swiss franc. The move came after Swiss parliamentary elections on Sunday which saw the anti-EU, right wing SVP party making stunning gains. But some market players questioned the impact of election results.

In the middle of the week, dollar weakened to one-week lows against yen and traded below 105-yen level on Tuesday after an overnight sell-off in the US stocks led to renewed worries that foreign investors quitting US asset markets could sell dollar.

The yen's gain against the dollar was spilled into euro/yen pushing the 11-nation European currency to three-week low at 1.12 yen level. Meanwhile, Euro hugged the mid \$1.06 amid growing speculation that interest rates in the 11-nation Euro zone would be raised as early as November. The market was of the opinion that since rate expectations were already rife, euro would not be able to make much headway across the board ahead of the release of key Euro zone M3 money supply figures. which along with inflation trends will be key factor the European Central Bank would consider at its policy board

In the later part of the week, euro stemmed its gains against dollar and yen as robust euro zone money supply data rekindled expectations that European Central Bank would raise its interest rates soon. The euro dwindles to a one-month low against yen, but it bounced back against yen on rumour of the central bank intervention and drew more broad-based strength from Euro zone's September money supply figures.
