The National University (NU) has changed the dates of the examinations scheduled for November 8.

Meanwhile, the Degree (Pass Course) examinations under the National University will begin from November 28.

Opposition enforcing hartals to destroy democracy: Zillur

Awami League General Secretary Zillur Rahman repudiated the Opposition for taking a 'fascist' stand against people's democratic expectations in the name of boycotting parliament and local elections, reports UNB.

The four-party alliance led by BNP is enforcing hartals and unleashing terrorist acts in order to destroy the country's sound political and democratic process," he said.

The ruling party leader and LGRD and Cooperatives Minister made the observations while addressing a meeting at Rajnagar Technical College ground in Kishoreganj yesterday.

Presided over by Bhairab Thana Awami League President Mohammad Sayedullah Mia, the meeting was also addressed by its General Secretary Sirajuddin Ahmed and local leaders, says an official hand-out.

Zillur Rahman suspected ulterior motives behind the Opposition's staunch stand what he said they were creating anarchy in the country not for cancellation of elections to three city corporations and Upazilla Parishads rather for protecting the killers of November 3 Jail killing case

and the August 15 killing of Bangabandhu and his family members.

"They are hatching conspiracy to snatch people's rights... who had tried to reestablish Pakistani idealism after taking a stand against the spirit of Liberation War," the Minister told the audience.

Continuing his tirade against the recalcitrant Opposition parties, who are spearheading an out-governments movement, he alleged they had destroyed the country's economy, robbed all fundamental rights and established autocratic rule by capturing power illegally for last 21 years."

The Minister said the present government in its three and a half years of rule imple-

mented massive development schemes for welfare of the people, which could no governments do in 21 years.

In this regard, he mentioned a number of development programmes, including ashrayan project for homeless, khas land distribution among the landless, introduction of old-age allowance, social-security allowance for the women deserted by husbands, establishment of Employment Bank for unemployed youths.

Earlier, the Minister laid foundation-stones of the new building of Gorakanda Aftab Uloom Madrasah and Mujib High School and inaugurated the office of Bangabandhu Council and newly constructed Shimulakandi College.

Kidnapping of schoolboys

DU student bodies demand arrest of those involved

Ganotantrik Chhatra Oikya (GCO), a conglomerate of some left-leaning student organisations condemned the kidnapping of two schoolboys and their confinement on the Dhaka University campus and demanded immediate arrest and punishment of the persons involved in the incident.

In a statement yesterday, the GCO leaders said that the kidnappers were staying in different DU halls.

"But both the DU authorities and police are playing a mysterious role by maintaining silence and not arresting the culprits," they regretted.

They alleged that a certain

quarter of DU authorities and police were patronising the kidnappers for petty personal and political interests.

Samajtantrik Chhatra Front (SCF) also condemned the incident and demanded arrest and punishment of the kidnappers. The SCF leaders also urged DU authorities to make the dormitories free from outsiders, terrorists and kidnappers.

Unidentified youths kidnapped two schoolboys from the city's Dhanmondi area on Tuesday afternoon and took them to DU campus. The two children were released after a ransom of Tk 1.35 lakh was paid.

Iqbal Ansari Khan (Henry) died in Bangkok on October 30 and was buried at Banani graveyard on November 2.

Police team to attend Interpol confce in Seoul

Resentment over non-withdrawal of hartal on Kali Puja

The leaders urged the government to take necessary steps for smooth holding of *Shyama Puja* on November 7.

The Parishad also demanded that the government consider reconstruction of the Ramna Kali Mandir and Ma Anandamoyi Ashram along with the on going construction process of Bijoy Complex.

Ramna Kali Mandir and Ma Anandamoyi Ashram situated in the then Race Course were demolished by the occupation army during the country's Liberation War.

The Parishad leaders also demanded construction of a memorial plaque for the martyrs who were killed during the mass upsurge on March 27 in 71.

The meeting in a resolution decided to observe a mass hunger strike and formation of human-chain on March 27 to press home their demand.
